Send submissions to the Kingdom Chronicler (see Regnum). All submissions **IN THEIR ENTIRETY** must be in the Kingdom Chronicler's possession no later than the first of the month prior to the cover date (e.g. January 1 for the February issue). This includes e-mail and hardcopy submissions. Should the first fall on a Sunday or holiday, the deadline for hardcopy will be moved to the next business day; e-mail submissions will be due no later than the 1st regardless.

If you are going to be late, you must inform the Chronicler before the first of the month so that space may be reserved. Anything arriving after the first is subject to refusal and has no guarantee of being published.

Submissions shall consist of a [1] an electronic copy, [2] an event announcement checklist which has been signed off on by the Seneschal of your group, and [3] a release form for any artwork (including maps) in the submission. If your submission is missing any of the previous items it will potentially not be published if not resolved by midnight on the first.

PDF is the preferred file format for submissions. Any other format **MUST** be discussed with the Kingdom Chronicler for acceptability.

Every act of kindness – a word of welcome, a loaned tunic, a listening ear – helps our Kingdom shine brighter.

Let us ensure that every gentle, new or seasoned, finds a place to belong beneath Ansteorra's banner.

Bringing DEIB into our medieval world

As members of a medieval reenactment society, we share a passion for history, craft, performance, community and authenticity. But we also know the real world – and our future – demands more than costume and armour. It demands a community built on respect, belonging and openness. That's where the ideas of **Diversity**, **Equity** and **Inclusion** and **Belonging** (DEIB) become not just nice-to-have, but central to our success and vitality.

What do we mean by DEIB?

Diversity: the presence of a variety of people – different

backgrounds, identities, experiences, abilities, perspectives. Equity: ensuring fair access, opportunity and support so everyone can participate and thrive – recognising that some will need different support.

Inclusion: creating an environment where people feel welcome, valued, and able to contribute.

Belonging: creating an environment where everyone feels a sense of belonging, not being thrust out to the edge of the group.

Why it matters for our society

1. **Stronger creativity & authenticity**

A more diverse membership brings more ideas, skills and perspectives – which helps us re-create history in richer, more thoughtful ways. Research shows that when inclusion is present, diversity leads to greater creativity.

In our context: different cultural backgrounds might deepen understanding of medieval trade networks, migration, craft traditions or cross-cultural contacts.

2. **Wider membership & growth**

By cultivating an inclusive, welcoming environment, we open the doors to more people – who may bring energy, skills, enthusiasm and fresh ideas.

This means more members, more events, more varied programming – all helping our society thrive.

3. **Better community-health & retention**

Everyone wants to feel respected and safe. When people feel excluded or overlooked, it harms morale, participation, and the sense of fun. Equity means recognising historical or social barriers and doing what we can to remove them.

By being inclusive, we make our events and meeting nights more sustainable: fewer drop-outs, more returning participants, more investment in shared endeavour.

4. **Living our values**

As reenactors we often speak of honour, chivalry, community, craftsmanship, historical respect. DEIB gives us a framework to make those ideals live in our membership and actions.

In short: embedding DEIB is an expression of being the community we aspire to be.

5. **Future-proofing our society**

The world around us – demographics, interest groups, cultural expectations – is changing. Being alert to equity and inclusion helps ensure we don't become stale, closed off or accessible only to a narrow slice. By taking DEIB seriously, we prepare for new generations of members and evolving community standards.

How we can successfully practice DEIB in our medieval reenactment society.

Make sure our welcome and outreach materials speak broadly: include images/voices of different genders, ages, abilities, backgrounds.

Evaluate whether our event programming, meeting times, access (transportation, cost, equipment) might inadvertently exclude some people. E.g., provide mentoring for newcomers, or loan tunics/harnesses to lower entry barriers.
Foster a culture of respect: encourage members to call out (or help correct) behaviour that's exclusionary or unwelcoming. As one DEIB resource says: "Our job ... isn't to judge other members but to be clear on what actions are acceptable."
Offer inclusive roles: ensure leadership, appearances, performances are open to all, and consider whether hidden biases might limit participation (for example, "You must have previous experience to join the court" may exclude eager newcomers).

Provide training or awareness-raising: simple sessions or conversations about implicit bias, accessibility, inclusive language, different lived experiences help.

Monitor and reflect: Keep asking, "Who is missing? Whose voices aren't we hearing? What barriers remain?" Make adjustments.

Celebrate diversity within reenactment: part of historical reconstruction is acknowledging the richness of medieval societies – contact, trade, diversity of cultures, craftsmanship across borders. This aligns well with DEIB.

In this, the "current Middle Ages," the principles of diversity, equity, inclusion, accessibility, and belonging are the practical application of the chivalric virtues!


