# Random Carp that I have learned

Which weighs more, a pound of feathers or a pound of gold? It's actually a pound of feathers, though an ounce of gold weighs more than an ounce of feathers. Most imperial mass measurements are ounces and pounds based on the avoirdupois system, which is 28.35g = 1 oz, and 16 ounces to the pound, which is 454g. The avoirdupois system, coming from the Anglo-Norman French *avoir de peis* which became *avoir du pois* (literally "goods of weight") became popular as regional differences in the Roman *libre* (lb) developed problems after the early Crusades stimulated trade across Europe around 1300.

Troy weights take their name from the French market town of Troyes from at least the 9th century. A troy ounce is heavier than an avoirdupois ounce, at 31.1g, but the troy pound (no longer used) is lighter than the avoirdupois, at 12 ounces to the pound, 373g. The British coinage system took to using troy ounces to measure coinage starting in the early 15th century, leading to the same for all gold and silver, and the United States has followed suit. The apothecaries also used troy ounces for medicines. Today, larger amounts of gold or silver are measured in large values of troy ounces or in kg, and modern medicine moved completely to the metric system. So, if you intend to open a modern medieval apothecary shop, keep your troy weights so you can measure out your medicinal Random Carp.


