Any copyrighted material by others must be accompanied by written permission from the original author(s). Please check the licence/usage terms of any clip-art used. ## Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. This can be done by filling in the calendar event date request form on the Kingdom web page: <https://drachenwald.sca.org/events/calendar-add/>. Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web form.

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event.
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

**The Malt War - Mallassota**  
**24 - 26 April 2026**  
**Humalasalola - Finland**

Welcome to Malt War! The event features war and competition in archery, fencing, and heavy fighting.

**Arrival and departure times**

You may arrive at the event site starting Friday at 18:00 (6 p.m.). On Sunday, rooms must be clean and all participants must leave the site by 12:00 (noon).

**Location and public transportation**

Event address: Kalliopirtti camp center, Kalliopirtintie 20, 16610 Kärkölä.

The site is located 100 km north of Helsinki (1.5 hours by car), 90 km north of Helsinki airport (1 h 15 min), 120/145 km southeast of Tampere (1 h 40 min via either route). Reasonably good driving conditions can be expected, possibly icy surfaces late in the evening and early in the morning.

The nearest rail stop is Lappila, just 7.3 km/10 minutes by car from the site, pickups from there can be organized. The stop has frequent commuter train connections from both central Helsinki and Helsinki airport. Both trips take roughly 1.5 hours depending on the connection but note that on Friday you must be ready to board the first train at latest around 21:00 (9 p.m.). On Sunday, you cannot make it to the airport before 8:30 in the morning. You must have a ticket before boarding a train in Finland. The train timetables and tickets for April will become available before the end of February.

**Meals**

You need to eat to be able to go to war. Five substantial meals are served during the weekend: dinner on Friday, breakfast, heavy snack with coffee and feast on Saturday, breakfast on Sunday. All milk products used are low lactose/lactose free. Lacto-ovo vegetarian meals without meat nor fish can be provided, but must be booked in registration system during registration. If you have a serious food allergy or other health-related dietary limitation, contact the event stewards to discuss arrangements. If you have to bring your own food, large fridge space will be made available.

**Site**

Kalliopirtintie 20, 16610 Kärkölä  
The event will be held at the Kalliopirtti camp center by a small lake in Kärkölä in Southern Finland. Kalliopirtti features a main building, which also includes a wood-fired sauna, as well as an outbuilding. The main building can accommodate 40 people in beds, plus an additional 10 people on

the floor. The outbuilding has beds for 10 people.

For accommodation, please bring a bottom sheet, pillowcase, and duvet cover. Blankets and pillows are provided by the site. Those sleeping on the floor must also bring their own mattress/camp bed, pillow, and blanket/sleeping bag.

**Cost**

Note. A minor pays the member rate if a guardian is a member. Non-member surcharge applies to adults who are not members and minors who don't have a member as a guardian.

Children and teens under 15 years of age must have a designated adult guardian at the event, but that person does not have to be their legal guardian if written permission is provided.
