

Did you know that most heralds are not naturally loud? Voice projection, the art of being heard across a room or field without hurting the voice by shouting, is a learned and practiced skill. Some tips on how to get started can be found at <https://heraldry.sca.org/voice/vocaltech.html>, and there are video resources, perhaps try "How To Project Your Voice When Acting" https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=5SC_u2KEI1M.

If you can take (or run!) an in-person class, that is even better. Once you have the basics down, it's just practice. Rowany Festival approaches, and the campsite news announcements are a fantastic and very friendly opportunity to do so!

Do you have an aspect of Heraldry you would like yourself or others to know more about? Let me know.

Congratulations to the following gentles on their successful registrations:

* **Eva von Danzig**. Augmentation of arms. Per bend sinister rayonny gules and ermine, in bend two squirrels respectant counterchanged, for augmentation quartered second and third with in first and fourth quarterly azure and argent, on a cross gules four mullets of six points argent.

* **Isidro Garcia de Montoya**. Device. Quarterly azure and argent, a monkey rampant Or maintaining a sword proper.

* **Lykos of Lesbos**. Name and device. Per bend vert and sable, a wolf rampant and in base two swords in saltire argent. Nice cant on a given name meaning "wolf"!

* **Maria Giovanna Guarnieri**. Name. Nice Florentine Italian name from 1427!

* **Morris Morse Morley Morecocke**. Device. Pean, in fess three billhooks argent.

* **Natalia Webb**. Name and Device.

Per chevron enarched sable and argent, in saltire a needle sable threaded purpure and a spool of thread sable threaded purpure, on a chief argent two pithons glissant wings displayed respectant gules.

* **Sven of Saint Olaf**. Name and device.

Or, on a chevron between three martlets azure three crescents palewise Or. Nice device!

* **Uriangkhai-yin Cirina Soqor**. Name.

Remember that Heraldry is an Art, a Science and also a Service. Do you have a local herald doing something excellent or constant? Recommend them to their Majesties, your local Coronets, or myself; as they ought to be recognised.

- ◆ Developing appropriate resources to support the first aid role





Night of the Wandering Minstrel at Rowany Festival!

Greetings Lochac,

It's the news you've all been waiting for:
The Night of the Wandering Minstrel is back this
Festival!

WHAT is it?

The Night of the Wandering Minstrel is an evening
when campsites across Festival welcome wander-
ing performers to their fires. It's a wonderful
evening for performers and audiences alike!

WHEN is it?

On the Sunday night of Festival, from 8pm to noise
curfew. (Performers are reminded to be mindful
of neighbouring campsites as the evening gets lat-
ter, especially if their performances tend to be
loud.)

WHERE is it?

At campsites that have opted in! Performers will
ONLY visit campsites that opt in by placing a blue
light somewhere easily visible from the road. This
year, you can make it easier for performers to find
you by marking your gathering place with a blue
sticker on a large map of site that will be hung in
the Tavern. A4 copies of the map will be available
for performers to mark up and carry with them as
they roam.

WHO is performing?

You, if you want to! Whether you've been looking
for an opportunity to perform all night, or you
need the nudge to stand up in front of a few
friendly fires, everyone is welcome as a roaming
performer. You can even find a group of friends
to roam and perform with.

Is it a COMPETITION?

Only for performers who want it to be. As we did
last year, there will be a prize presented to the
performer who performs at the most locations. If
you would like to compete for this prize, collect a

signature from an audience member at each place
you perform, on the back of your map or another
piece of paper, and drop off your signature sheet
at the big Tavern map the next morning.

WHAT NEXT?

If you want to perform, take a look at your reper-
toire, and think about the pieces you'd like to
bring to people's fires.

If you want to be an audience, talk to your
campsite! Decide whether you'd like to welcome
performers to your gathering place, and if so, look
around for a blue light you can use as a signal. (If
you're going with the cellophane method, remem-
ber that it works best on a WHITE light. Yellow
light cancels out the blue.)




