Greetings!

Welcome to six months of the new website! Pretty soon we won't be able to call it new any more...

With the most recent set of changes to the website, we are finally displaying photos of individuals who are serving in Kingdom-level offices. We have brought the photos from the old site, and have them recorded for most of the people who had profiles and photos there. However, there are new people, and some people have new photos. We do not have a mechanism in place to allow individuals to upload their own photos, but we do have a google form for that. Please fill out the form at <https://tinyurl.com/NSNewPhoto> and we'll get your photos uploaded. (You can also use this form to send us your heraldic device or photos of scrolls, if you don't think we

have them in our library already.)

On the topic of photos, we did also bring the library of scroll images (aka scroll 'regalia') and heraldic images from the old site. Some of those scroll images are visible in peoples' award lists on their profiles - pick a person, scroll down to their Awards, and click View Regalia to view details about the scroll and an image if we have one. We will be working with the Scribal Gallery Curator and the Signet to gather the photos of awards which they have which haven't been uploaded yet, and to input the details of scrolls which we might not have, so keep in mind that this is a work in progress. We are working on a scribal library to display the scrolls and methods of sorting them by artist so that we can show off the wealth of our artisans.

And for even more image fun, we have heraldic images from the old site. When you search for people or see their names in various places on the website, some people have their heraldic devices, We are processing through all of the heraldic content we have from the College of Heraldry and the old website to make sure that peoples' registered names, blazons, and devices are visible on the site.

This is a good opportunity to remind artists that they should fill out release forms so that we can display or not display their art as is applicable. If you go to Resources -> For Members -> Edit Persona, find Northshield Tools on the left, and click Submit Release Form, you can register photographer / videographer, model, and creative works release forms to allow us to display your photos, your scrolls, and other works

of your art that you're willing to share.

And finally, we're working with the Social Media Office to create and share brief 'how to' videos. Hopefully by the time this issue of the *Northwatch* is published we will have some available for you.

**Position Description:
CONSTABLE OF THE
CAVALRY**

The Constable of the Cavalry (CoC/KEO) is responsible for oversight of the Northshield Equestrian program.

The Constable is a lesser office and reports to the Kingdom Earl Marshal and Society Equestrian Officer. This is primarily an administrative role. The Constable is responsible for ensuring that the following duties are completed either by themselves or by a member of their staff. These duties include: Ensure consistent and reliable communication with their staff, including deputy and local marshals. Provide advice and guidance to local marshals. Provide training and support for marshals in training. Ensure proper ordering of equestrian insurance certificates. Compile quarterly reports for KEM and SEO. Maintain any relevant handbooks, resources, and other forms. Advise the Crown in all matters related to equestrian activities. The workload will vary but expect to put in an average of an hour a week.

Requirements:

Dependable email access.
Demonstrable experience in multiple aspects of equestrian activities.
Moderate proficiency with Google Docs and similar word processing applications.
Ability to clearly communicate verbally and in writing, i.e. in person and via email, phone, and in written reports.
Working knowledge of relevant procedures and processes.
Strong skills in remotely coordinating a volunteer team with diverse skill-sets.

I, Comes Decimus Marius Tacitus called Ajax, am your incoming Kingdom Rapier Marshal, this is a bit last minute transition for me, since it is now time for 1st quarter reports, so I'm a bit behind the game, but will catch up shortly. My aim for this tenure is to get everyone acquainted with the new processes the kingdom has moved to due to the Society level changes on process as well as new Rapier rule set that is currently going through Society level process. A reminder for all is that We currently do have a 2025 version of rules at the Kingdom level and everyone should reread them. At this time and if all goes well by the end of May, we could be seeing a new ruleset from Society, and we will then adjust as needed.

The KEM is looking to streamline admin processes across the board between all disciplines; this will make things much easier for all of us. The Armored side of our Marshallate has done a lion's share of work in getting processes going here at the Kingdom Level for this and so we will have a much easier time getting our rule sets up and onto the Wiki.

My Team and I do very much hope when the new rules land, we can get those out and distributed quickly, but I'm pragmatic and understand that Murphy always must interfere. I'd like to announce that the Emergency Kingdom Rapier Marshal office will be filled by Master Gabriel Kjotvason. His experience and knowledge of technical documents will greatly help to mitigate the bothersome

Murphy and help mitigate his influence.

At a recent event, there were multiple helms that needed adjustments to fit into the 2023 rules. Combatants should remember to review 4A-B if they have camail or aventail and add padding as necessary.

In particular, this section is referenced below:

12.4.5 Neck

Your neck, including your larynx, cervical vertebrae, and first thoracic vertebra must be covered by one or a combination of the following and must stay covered during typical combat situations, including turning your head, lifting your chin, etc.:

- 1) Your helm
- 2) A gorget of rigid material
- 3) A collar of 11/64 inch (4.4 mm) or 11 oz thick stiff leather lined with a minimum of 1/4 inch (6 mm) of close cell foam or equivalent padding.
- 4) A mail or 11/64 inch (4.4 mm) or 11 oz thick stiff leather camail or aventail that hangs or drapes to absorb the force of a blow.

A. If your camail or aventail is likely to come into contact with your larynx, cervical vertebrae, or first thoracic vertebra during combat, that section must be padded with a minimum of 1/4 inch (6 mm) of closed cell foam or equivalent padding.

B. It is strongly recommended that you wear at least 11/64 inch (4.4 mm) or 11 oz thick stiff leather with 1/4 inch (6 mm) of closed cell foam or equivalent padding under mail.



Substantive Law Changes for Commentary

The following substantive law changes are open for commentary until 20 May 2026.

Pursuant to Kingdom Law I-700, "Should the majority of the quorum of the Stallari Council believe a change to statutory law to be substantive, the Crown must publish the proposed law change in the Northwatch and allow one month from publication for comment before proceeding."

These changes were determined to be substantive by Stallari on 6/13/2025.

SCA Corporate Announcements

New Cut & Thrust Combat Handbook Commentary Request

The Society Marshal, Society Rapier Marshal and Society C&T Deputy are pleased to make available for commentary the approved draft of the new Cut & Thrust Handbook. Commentary will be accepted through March 30, 2026.

This new C&T handbook is part of the ongoing modernization effort, which is updating ALL the marshal handbooks in conjunction with updates to the marshal

related sections in Corpora. The goal is to better reflect the current structure, culture, and safety best practices we use today in our SCA martial activities.

One of the most significant changes is the modernized format, designed for easy online access and usability. With clearer layout, improved navigation, and consistency across all marshal handbooks, this new format makes it easier for both newcomers and experienced participants to find the information they need quickly and confidently.

The new online Cut & Thrust Combat handbook and supporting material can be found at https://society-rules.fullmesh.co.nz/index.php/Main_Page.

Also available at this site:

- A PDF version of the proposed new handbook
- Cliff notes on the C&T Handbook, with a summary of the changes
- A FAQ on the overall rules moderation process, the new handbooks and format

Important Dates: Similar to the new Rapier Combat Handbook, a multi-month process is being used to improve communication and transparency. The timeline is aligned with the current ongoing Rapier Handbook commentary and approval process, so that both handbooks will enter their final form and approval at the same time.

The timeline is:

- Feb 2 thru March 30: C&T Combat Handbook is open for commentary. This version has been approved by the BoD for commentary for 60 days.
- March – April: Updates to the handbook will be

developed based on the commentary.

– April 1: New handbook with updates resulting from received commentary will be submitted to the BoD for final review and approval.

– May 20: Both the new C&T and Rapier Combat handbooks will be in effect (if approved during the April BoD meeting).

Please email all commentary to marshal@sca.org and rapier@sca.org, and use the title “New C&T Handbook – commentary” in the subject line. CC’ing your Kingdom Rapier/C&T/Fencing Marshal is highly recommended.

Most of the content is shared between the Rapier and Cut and Thrust Handbooks. If you have already provided feedback on the Rapier Handbook, and your comments are not specific to cut and thrust, you do not need to send your feedback again.

Commentary must be received no later than March 30, 2026.

to the smith of their trust.


When his last day darkened
