Publication Policies

Send submissions to the Kingdom Chronicler (see Regnum). All submissions IN THEIR ENTIRETY must be in the Kingdom Chronicler's possession **no later than the first of the month prior to the cover date (e.g. January 1 for the February issue)**. This includes e-mail and hardcopy submissions. Should the first fall on a Sunday or holiday, the deadline for hardcopy will be moved to the next business day; e-mail submissions will be due no later than the 1st regardless.

If you are going to be late, you must inform the Chronicler before the first of the month so that space may be reserved. Anything arriving after the

first is subject to refusal and has no guarantee of being published.

Submissions shall consist of a [1] an electronic copy, [2] an event announcement checklist which has been signed off on by the Seneschal of your group, and [3] a release form for any artwork (including maps) in the submission. **If your submission is missing any of the previous items it will potentially not be published if not resolved by midnight on the first.**

Additionally, if you wish to publish the same ad in more than one issue of The Black Star, you must resubmit your paperwork and event announcement **each month** UNLESS you have indicated on the first Event Ad/Seneschal Checklist that you wish the ad to run for more than one month. The Chronicler will assume that any ad received will only be used in the month it is received, unless otherwise stated on the Checklist. This is as much for our protection as it is to ensure that only the most current event information is contained in this publication. You are asked to send a half page ad to run in any month prior to your event month.

In order for "lasting business" (for example, laws and awards) to take place at an event, there must be a COMPLETE ad in the Black Star issue for the month of the event (so an August event must be in the August Black Star, and would be due July 1), UNLESS the event is in the first ten days of the month. Then the complete ad may be in the previous month's Black Star.

PDF is the (much) preferred file format for electronic submissions. Any other format MUST be discussed with the Kingdom Chronicler for acceptability. But please, just send PDF. The Kingdom Chronicler can advise free software solutions for doing so for Windows users.

Ads, releases and checklists should be sent in electronic form via e-mail if at all possible. As with all communications, please send them to kingdom@chronicler.ansteorra.org.

Express Mail Information

If you are sending your announcement by Express Mail or similar service, you MUST waive the signature requirement by signing the appropriate place on the form. This way the courier may leave the item. Otherwise, the delay in going to the Post Office to pick up your announcement may result in it not making it into The Black Star at all. In that case, you might as well not have sent it at all. So, for everyone's sake: PLEASE WAIVE THE SIGNATURE!

That entails making sure all the technical elements of the event are set up, collecting and assigning volunteers to be Hosts for rooms, and working with the Class Coordinator to ensure the schedule remains as up-to-date as possible. I have a detailed Doc that outlines tasks and am happy to share with anyone interested.

New Society Webmin Handbook, notable changes: You heard it here first! A new version of the

Society Webminister's Handbook has been released as well as updated release forms. You can find the link in the SCA Resource Library or by direct link below.

1. EVERY Webminister and Deputy MUST familiarize themselves with the new handbook.

2. I'll highlight some notable elements:

- This handbook applies to any online presence of the SCA that is not expressly assigned to offices outside of the Webministry

- It recommends each Kingdom implement a Data Policy. Ansteorra does not currently have one (that I am aware of), so this will be at the top of my upcoming To-Dos

- All official services must have multiple people with administrative access, for our websites this is covered by local admin access and Kingdom/ER access to sites. I'll be reviewing our other infrastructure to ensure that we have multiple admin access.

- Copyright and Disclaimers are still required for all sites, so I'll be doing a review of all our Wordpress domains to ensure compliance

Check out the changes and don't hesitate to email if you have questions or suggestions. I'm already working with Heirsirkona Kolfinna of Namron to build a landing page for the Med Fair Demo and am collaborating with our Kingdom Hospitaler and Kingdom Social Media Officer to build out our support for large, Kingdom-wide, or annual demos.

Known issues: I am aware of several issues that I am working to fix across our sites

* Updates to the Chivalry website were messed up after a backend update. I've hunted out the glaring errors and still have some backend bugs to fix.

* There is an accessibility issue/readability issue on the Marshal Reporting page where grey text isn't easily distinguishable from the background. I'll be making changes to fix that that ASAP.

* The main navigation menu for ansteorra.org does not expand on mobile in the same way it does on desktop -- this means site visitors on mobile have to make more clicks to find desired pages. I'll be working on updates to the mobile layout to improve the navigation menu.

Quarterly Report Summary: Thank you to all of my Webministers who submitted their *first-ever* quarterly report in January! I am happy to report that there were no major issues brought to my attention and that overall our webmins are in a good place and performing routine maintenance on sites. I received several questions from Webmins in their reports and reached out to multiple individuals directly via email or video call to troubleshoot, advise, or just check in at their request.

The next Webminister Quarterly Report will be due on April 15th 2023.
