Submission Guidelines for *The Pale*

ARTICLES on period topics, history, art, puzzles, SCA life, bardic stories and the like are welcome additions to *The Pale*. A 500- to 1000-word article will usually fit in one issue; longer articles will be split into multiple parts to appear in successive issues. Submit the file in MS Word .doc format along with an SCA Creative Release form. Send the images used in the article as separate files using the format described below.

You must cite all references, quotations and sources in your article using the Chicago Manual of Style format. Sample citations are located here: www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html. Citing sources is very important to avoid accusations of plagiarism and legal action for copyright violation.

IMAGES, such as line art, calligraphy, illumination and photographs are also welcome. Scan any artwork at 300 dpi and save it at the highest quality JPG setting. Photos should also be 300 dpi, high quality JPGs. All images will appear in print as black and white, but the online version of *The Pale* is in color. Images can also be submitted as high quality TIF or PDF files. Any artwork or photography submitted to *The Pale* must have a signed SCA Creative Release or SCA Photographer Release form from the artist sent in with the work. Any person identifiable in an image must submit a signed SCA Model Release form with the art work. This is a requirement of SCA Inc. for print publication. All release forms are available at www.midrealm.org/chronicler.

EVENT PREVIEWS: A free event preview of 50 words is available to all events. The listing **MUST include the name of the event, sponsoring group, site address, date, times and event steward contact information.**

EVENT NOTICES (ads) must be published in *The Pale* for events at which any of the following occur: crown and coronet tournaments, coronations and investitures, appointment of kingdom or principality officers, presentation of awards and titles, proclamation of law, establishment or advancement of branches. **These activities cannot take place unless a complete event notice appears in *The Pale*, the Middle Kingdom newsletter, at least once before the date of the event.** The publication requirement may only be waived in extraordinary circumstances, such as a natural disaster.

Events must **already** be listed on the Middle Kingdom Calendar prior to advertising in *The Pale*, but an event listing on the Middle Kingdom Calendar does **NOT** constitute "official publication". Incipient groups must submit a scan of the sponsorship form to the Editor. Event submissions to the Kingdom Calendar should be submitted through the **online form** available on the calendar page. Any issues contact the Middle Kingdom Calendar Secretary

at calendar@midrealm.org. Middle Kingdom events receive free event ads that run in the next issue unless otherwise specified. Out-of-kingdom events and merchants pay the listed rates.

Ad templates for the quarter and half page ads are available at <http://midrealm.org/chronicler/thepale/>. All ads must be submitted to *The Pale* via e-mail attachment in DOC, PDF, JPG, or TIF format.

WITHOUT EXCEPTION, EVENT NOTICES MUST INCLUDE event name, sponsoring group, dates, times, site address, site registration, NAME (SCA & modern), email address and phone number of the event steward. Website URLs and simple driving directions to the event site are useful but not required. All clip art images in event notices must have a source listed and be used in accordance with the terms of use. **All artwork MUST include an SCA Creative Release form from the author(s) or artist(s). SCA Model Releases are required for identifiable persons in any image.** Submissions are edited for grammar, spelling, space constraints, inflammatory or explicit language and compliance with Middle Kingdom Law. Editorial decisions are final. "Letters to the Editor" are not permitted per SCA Inc. regulations.

PLEASE NOTE THAT MIDDLE KINGDOM EVENTS NO LONGER NEED TO PAY FOR ANY EVENT ADS AS OF OCTOBER 2016.

MERCHANT ADS are due on the deadlines and in the formats noted below; send payment to *The Pale* Exchequer.

Letters from the Kingdom Officers



Seneschal

Greetings from the Seneschal,

Camping season is just around the corner, or if you joined us at Gulf Wars, it started already. Whilst church halls and gyms are fun, the outdoor event season is (IMHO) the best because of its opportunity for interaction. We also have a lot of groups planning demos in the spring and summer and this is AMAZING. Let's engage with our communities and grow our groups.

Regarding Demos, please recognize that Demos are defined as activities where we interact with the non-SCA public. This can be for educational, recruitment, and/or PR purposes. We are demonstrating what we do, hence the word "demo". This means that the non-SCA public is not participating in our activities!

If a craft involves use of tools that can reasonably cause any injury, the spectators are not to participate in the activity unless they have signed a waiver. This includes archery, siege weapon firing, and anything involving heat, hammers, sharp things, etc. It also includes "trying on" armor or handling any weapons (SCA combat weapons

or real weapons). And, a child should not be allowed to "assist" with such an activity unless they and their parent/guardian are SCA participants with a waiver on file, or the parent signs a minor waiver for their child.

If you have ANY doubt as to whether something is allowed for non-SCA, non-waiver bearing individuals, my recommendation is that you err on the side of caution and ask me. If I am not sure, I will ask corporate.

Another topic that came up recently was fundraising and social media. It is obvious why we do not allow personal Gofundme posts on the social media pages. However, the question came up what if we are fundraising for general scadians, such as for benches at Pennsic, or a hospitality tent at the archery range. So, we asked up the chain and the ruling is fairly straightforward:

- You may share a post regarding fundraising on SCA held social media outlets IF the money raised will be held and dispersed from an SCA bank account via an exchequer. For example, the decal fundraiser for the Royal Travel fund in which the money is raised and held by the kingdom exchequer and dispersed through

the standard processes would be approved. This fundraiser can be posted on SCA held social media accounts.

- You may not share a post regarding fundraising on SCA held social media outlets IF the money raised is held and dispersed by an individual person or entity outside of the SCA. For example, a raffle is being held to raise funds for the State dinner at Pennsic, and the money is being held by an individual and dispersed directly to the individuals providing the State dinner. This fundraiser can be posted on personal pages but NOT on official SCA held social media accounts.

Remember, if you have questions, let me know. If I don't have the answer, I guarantee you that I can find it (or at least ask the right people).

Middle Kingdom Event Coordinator

We are accepting resumes for the Middle Kingdom Event Coordinator position. This person is responsible for obtaining bids for Spring Crown & Kingdom A&S, Spring Coronation, Fall Coronation and Fall Crown. This person should have intermediate excel skills, the ability to network with the all the groups in the Kingdom and excellent communication skills. Experience in running events and understanding the requirements for these events are a must. We will be accepting resumes until 7 April with a decision to be made by 21 April. THE BID PROCESS FOR BECOMING MAYOR OF PENNSIC WAR

The Hosting Crowns for the Kingdoms of the East, Middle and Aethelmarc select Pennsic War Mayor for the Pennsic War that they will be hosting. The selection process starts in January TWO YEARS in advance of the Hosting Kingdom's year.

Each Kingdom hosts Pennsic on a rotation basis with one of the three kingdoms being responsible for the Pennsic War every third year.

For example: for Pennsic 49 (That was to be held in 2020 but was postponed till 2022 due to COVID 19), the Middle Kingdom Seneschal call for bids at beginning January 2018. The bid process ends on 1 May 2018, and Royalty selected the Mayor by 1 July 2018.

The goal is to select from a qualified candidate pool, the best person for the position of Pennsic Mayor, regardless of the person's Kingdom of residence.

We are currently seeking Bids for Pennsic 52, August 2025.

The Bid Process

In the Administrative Policies of the Pennsic War, Section C - The bid process states that "... Potential autocrats may request a bid packet from one of the three Kingdom Seneschals. The bid packet will include minimum bid requirements, submission deadlines, and budget actuals from previous Pennsics to assist bidders in developing a preliminary budget. The announcement calling for bids will be published in all three Kingdoms' newsletters four months prior to the bid deadline...."

Please consider this on-line document, and its related links to be the Bid Packet. If you would like a hard copy of this packet sent to you, please contact the appropriate Kingdom Seneschal and write to that person. Email requests of the described documents may also be sent upon request.

Before you begin you must be familiar with the following documents:

Pennsic Administrative Policies
Pennsic Financial Policies

You might also want to look at "So, you want to be the Mayor of Pennsic?" While it is not an official document of Pennsic of the SCA, it is a useful resource from a former Mayor of Pennsic War and will give you an in-depth list of questions you must ask yourself to see if you are ready to try to take on the management of the largest SCA event.

As stated before, the Crowns of the Hosting Kingdom appoint the Mayors. This is done upon recommendation of the Seneschals of the East, Middle and Æthelmarc,

The Bid deadline is 1 May of any year. The Seneschals have 30 days to review the bids received and advise Their Majesties. Their Majesties have until 1 July 2023 to make a decision.

Your bid must contain the following, at a minimum:

[These requirements are from the Administrative Documents which govern how Pennsic War is administered.]

1. SCA and modern name and contact information for the following:
 - o Mayor
 - o Emergency Deputy
 - o Key department heads, with descriptions of previous Pennsic staff experience and/or other relevant experience
2. Resume (SCA and modern) of autocrat, including previous Pennsic staff experience and/or other relevant experience.
3. Statement of why you wish to organize Pennsic and what qualifications you bring to the project.
4. Letters of intent from each key department head confirming their agreement to be on the autocrat's staff in that

position.

5. A draft preliminary budget, including proposed fee schedule, projected attendance, estimated gross revenue, estimated expenses, and any budget areas that are expected to change significantly (due to special projects, anniversary years, etc.). The hosting Kingdom Seneschal will help by providing budget actuals and non-cash asset inventories from previous Pennsics.
6. Any new projects, activities, or changes in procedures/operations proposed for the war.

This may sound daunting, but let's explore each item.

1. This is about you and your emergency deputy and any confirmed division or department heads you have. It is understood that it is difficult to ask over 100 people to commit to an event almost three years in advance. However, for yourself and the person who will have to take over for you in an emergency it is needed. You and he/she must be willing to commit to this. Full information must be provided as this will be used to create warrants, should you be successful in your bid.
Please see below for more information about your Division and Department heads.
2. Tell us who you are and what you have done in the SCA and in the Modern World.
3. Yes... WHY? Why do you want to devote your life to this project?
There is no right or wrong answer to this question, however writing "I think it would be really cool to ride around in a golf cart and tell people what to do", may not be your best choice of response.
4. This is required because in the past people often found out they were on someone's bid and had not been asked if they were willing to be. This eliminates the surprise factor. It also eliminates a bidder from "just putting names down" to make their bids look good.
 - o *The letter needs only contain the person's willingness to work for the bidder. It may be as simple as: "I [Name of person], agree to work for [Name of the Bidder] in any capacity needed, should [Name of Bidder] be successful in becoming the Autocrat/Mayor of Pennsic [insert Pennsic number]. [Signed - Or - Email confirmation with full headers]*
5. The Budget for Pennsic War is formidable. At last look it was over \$280,000.00. You, as Mayor, would be responsible for dealing with all aspects of the budget. You must work with the Pennsic Financial Committee. You must work with the Pennsic Exchequer. You must work with Division and Department heads to ensure the estimated expenses of each area are met. Items to help you:
 - The Pennsic Financial Policy. You must be familiar with this document and be willing to follow it to the letter.
 - As required by the Admin Policies, you must submit a sample budget with your bid. Here is a scaled down version of the Pennsic 35 Budget (Excel file).
 - Copies of previous actual budgets for Pennsic Wars are available from one of the three Kingdom Exchequers or Seneschals
 - o *Please note that this is the approved layout of the budget used for the last 3 years and for the foreseeable future. As you can see it is extensive. If you have questions or need help in creating a sample budget, Viscount Edward Zifran of Gendy, has assisted previous and future Mayors in creating and maintaining their budgets. Email him at gendy@panix.org.*
6. Here is where you are able to talk about any new concepts or plans you might have for "your war". This is where you may further explain why you feel you would be the right person for this position.

Once you have created and assembled the information required for your bid you must submit it to:

Submitting the Bid

- The Crown and Heirs of the Hosting Kingdom. Which for 2025 year is the Middle Kingdom. [Because of coronation schedules, the deciding Crown of the Hosting Kingdom will be whoever is Crown on 1 May of the year in question.]
