### March Crown Youth Activities From Edward LeKerve

Good gentles of the West, I seek assistance in an endeavor of great importance. As we are holding regular events, it has been noticed children are attending in numbers greater than we've seen in some time. At the same time out kingdom office of the Chancellor Minor (that's Page School Chancellor to you old timers) is vacant. I am not in a position to pick up the office, but I have committed to organizing youth activities for **March Crown Tournament, March 24-26**. I have the support of the Kingdom Seneschale in this. I have no intention of doing this alone. I may be crazy, but I'm not stupid. I'll need some help.


The Page School (I know it has another name, I just don't care for it) exists to provide enrichment activities for children attending events. These activities vary as widely as the greater scope of our society. I have observed that what children want to do largely parallels what adults want to do in our Current Middle Ages. Children have nimble minds and nimble fingers and are capable of doing most of the arts and sciences we partake in, at least on an introductory basis. I have always been fond of projects that teach the children pastimes they can continue back at camp, preventing the declaration of "I'm so bored!".

Here's the plan. Youth combat will be happening at Crown, and I will coordinate times with the organizers. Page school classes can take one of two formats. I have a class for everyone all at once to make flying tops. I've done this before, and I can handle a dozen or so children in class. The other format is to offer two, three or four classes at the same time and split the children into smaller groups. This prevents overwhelming our volunteer teachers. I would like to offer some other classes in either of the two formats. Here are a few ideas. Any introductory typical SCA skill, including but not limited to games, calligraphy, painting, embroidery, sewing, dancing, list paging, cooking, spinning, singing.

I have an idea for a youth oriented archery activity, which I will coordinate with the range staff. You all should have expected this.

Other non-craft classes can include stargazing, story or poetry recitals, singalongs, scavenger hunts (I may do one for Crown).

The children for these activities vary in age from about 5 to 15. It is strongly recommended parents or other adults attend with younger children if there is any question whether the child can behave themselves or handle the class work.



Attend the Words of His Highness, Prince Neil!

We are looking forward to finding Heirs that will carry on the customs and traditions of this, the Original Principality of the First Kingdom. For all those that would contend for Our Thrones, if you are members in good standing where both the combatant and inspiration reside within Our Lands, We trust that you have the understanding and capabilities to be our Heirs. No Letter of Intent is required.

For those that reside outside this realm, either combatant and/or inspiration, We ask you each to provide Us, by March 20th, a Letter of Intent, detailing your claims to these Lands and how you intend to ensure proper service to Our People.

The roads via I-80 Auburn CA to Cool CA and H-50 from Placerville to Georgetown can be challenging if drivers are not confident hauling horses through twisty roads. Easiest Haul directions below are advised.

### Easiest Haul Directions to Dru Barner Equestrian Campground Bottle Hill Rd Georgetown CA 95634

From Sacramento go East Bound US 50 to Shingle Springs

Exit 37 for South Shingle Rd

Left at South Shingle, go over US 50.

Next right at North Shingle Road, go 4 miles.

North Shingle Rd becomes Lotus Road (at Green Valley Road intersection)

Continue down Lotus Road (6.8 miles) to Highway 49.

Left onto Highway 49 (for 0.5 miles)

Right on Marshal Road, go 9 miles

Right on Main Street, Georgetown CA

Go down Main Street though Georgetown

Main Street becomes Wentworth Springs Road when leaving Georgetown.

Go 7.4 miles on Wentworth Springs to Rowdy Rd-Take Rowdy Road (.3 miles) to the Sharp Right for Bottle Hill BYPASS

Go 0.7 miles on Bottle Hill Bypass. Go left on Bottle Hill Road (0.3 miles) to Dru Barner Campground and follow the SCA signs



Send UNFORMATTED ( no bolding, no tabs, no fancy fonts) event copy to [communications@westkingdom.org](mailto:communications@westkingdom.org) as the text of an email. Event copy will be published for the month of the event and the month prior. Event Copy cannot exceed 350 words. Request event dates with the **Kingdom Calendar Deputy** before submitting copy. If your event is not approved to be on the Kingdom calendar your event copy will not be published, and the event will not be an official event. Deadline is 5pm the FIRST DAY of the month BEFORE the cover date (i.e. February 1 for the March issue). **OR EARLIER IF YOU HAVE IT READY!** Event copy will be published earlier if there is space, so please send it when it is available.

### **Event Stewards and Seneschals: What to include in your Event Copy**

Corporate and Kingdom policies require event copy to include the following information: **Date** (day, month, year); **Time** the event opens and closes; **Site Registration**; **Name** of the sponsoring branch; **Location** (i.e. name, address, town, directions) of site; **Event Steward** (only one) LEGAL and SCA names, email and phone; **Approval** by seneschal (copy will only be accepted from the Seneschal). Event copy that does not contain all of the above will not be published in *The Page*.

**NOTE: Your event date MUST be approved by the Kingdom Calendar Deputy BEFORE you submit event copy!**  
(<http://westkingdom.org/contentcalendar-policy>) Coronets, Investitures, Events where Crowns, Coronet or Landed Barons/Baronesses give awards or transact other business of lasting effect to the SCA must also appear.

Any event sponsored by an official SCA branch and advertised to the members of that branch in The Page or branch newsletter is covered by SCA insurance. Please Note: If you want you event copy to be put on the Kingdom Website, you must notify the Communications team at [communications@westkingdom.org](mailto:communications@westkingdom.org). All Page copy sent to [communications@westkingdom.org](mailto:communications@westkingdom.org) will be seen and added to The Page, the Kingdom website and Facebook pages. If you have a webpage for the event or a Facebook event link, please send the link along with your Page copy. There is no size limit to web copy for events.

**Your event must be in the Kingdom newsletter for any court business and awards to be valid.**

IMPORTANT NOTE: If your event date is not on the Kingdom Calendar, your event cannot be published in The Page. Calendar deadline is the 15th of the month TWO months prior to your event.
