Publication Policies

Send submissions to the Kingdom Chronicler (see Regnum). All submissions IN THEIR ENTIRETY must be in the Kingdom Chronicler's possession **no later than the first of the month prior to the cover date (e.g. January 1 for the February issue)**. This includes e-mail and hardcopy submissions. Should the first fall on a Sunday or holiday, the deadline for hardcopy will be moved to the next business day; e-mail submissions will be due no later than the 1st regardless.

If you are going to be late, you must inform the Chronicler before the first of the month so that space may be reserved. Anything arriving after the

first is subject to refusal and has no guarantee of being published.

Submissions shall consist of a [1] an electronic copy, [2] an event announcement checklist which has been signed off on by the Seneschal of your group, and [3] a release form for any artwork (including maps) in the submission. **If your submission is missing any of the previous items it will potentially not be published if not resolved by midnight on the first.**

Additionally, if you wish to publish the same ad in more than one issue of The Black Star, you must resubmit your paperwork and event announcement **each month** UNLESS you have indicated on the first Event Ad/Seneschal Checklist that you wish the ad to run for more than one month. The Chronicler will assume that any ad received will only be used in the month it is received, unless otherwise stated on the Checklist. This is as much for our protection as it is to ensure that only the most current event information is contained in this publication. You are asked to send a half page ad to run in any month prior to your event month.

In order for "lasting business" (for example, laws and awards) to take place at an event, there must be a COMPLETE ad in the Black Star issue for the month of the event (so an August event must be in the August Black Star, and would be due July 1), UNLESS the event is in the first ten days of the month. Then the complete ad may be in the previous month's Black Star.

PDF is the (much) preferred file format for electronic submissions. Any other format MUST be discussed with the Kingdom Chronicler for acceptability. But please, just send PDF. The Kingdom Chronicler can advise free software solutions for doing so for Windows users.

Ads, releases and checklists should be sent in electronic form via e-mail if at all possible. As with all communications, please send them to kingdom@chronicler.ansteorra.org.

Express Mail Information

If you are sending your announcement by Express Mail or similar service, you MUST waive the signature requirement by signing the appropriate place on the form. This way the courier may leave the item. Otherwise, the delay in going to the Post Office to pick up your announcement may result in it not making it into The Black Star at all. In that case, you might as well not have sent it at all. So, for everyone's sake: PLEASE WAIVE THE SIGNATURE!

Stellar Majesties

Greetings Ansteorra,

Wow, what an incredible Gulf War! Ansteorra's jewel shone from so many facets. To highlight just a few:

An Ansteorran won War Bard.

An Ansteorran won A&S.

An Ansteorran also **won** the wood joust.

Many Ansteorrans won their bouts, in both armored and rapier fighting, in the Champions Tourney. All Ansteorrans in the Champions Tourney fought with skill, integrity, talent, honor, and panache. This year the tournament consisted of 5 fighters from our allies, 4 up and coming (AoA level or non-awarded) fighters, 3 grant level fighters, and 3 peerage level fighters in each marshal discipline (armored combat and rapier), for a total of 30 fighters.

An Ansteorran won the Ansteorran Rose Tournament. There were 140 entrants in the tournament representing almost all of the kingdoms and principalities in attendance at Gulf Wars. Ansteorra had 6 fighters, the highest number of fighters from a single kingdom/principality, in the

quarter finals.

An Ansteorran won the Meridian Rose Tournament. There were 82 fighters in the tournament, and Ansteorra had the highest number of fighters in the final 16 for the single elimination phase of the tourney. All six of the Ansteorrans in the final 16 were Centurions.

An Ansteorran won the Meridian Rose Youth Tournament.

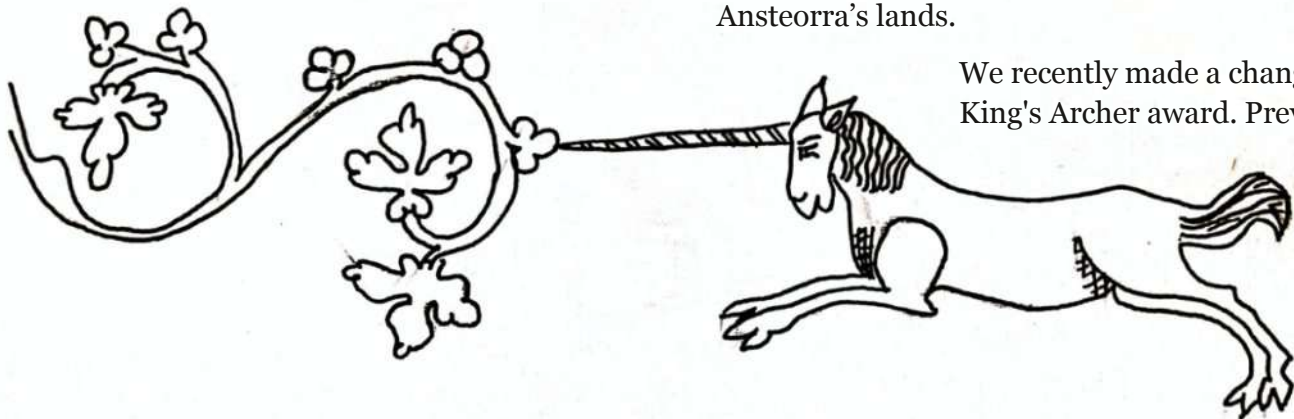
The team with Ansteorrans won the Youth Combat Melee Tournament.

Ansteorra Chili Night was a great success. Something in the ballpark of 55 gallons of chili was happily consumed.

The Knowne World Party, hosted by Ansteorra, was a wonderfully fun, social experience. We received praise from our Royal Cousins, many of them, stating Ansteorra's hospitality is EPIC.

Gulf Wars wasn't the only event on our calendar in March. There was also Commander's Crucible in the Stronghold of Hellsgate on March 25th. So much talent and fun was witnessed, we were excited to share the day with those who truly enjoy supporting each other. Laughter could be heard rolling over the gentle hills of Belton, Texas. It was a perfect way to spend a post Gulf Wars weekend, back in Ansteorra's lands.

We recently made a change to the King's Archer award. Previously it



was for target and combat archery. Now, the definition recognizes achievements in all missile weapons. After some discussion with members of the missile community, representing multiple disciplines, the name has been kept the same. This is in line with the Arc d'Or, whose definition was similarly expanded a few years ago.

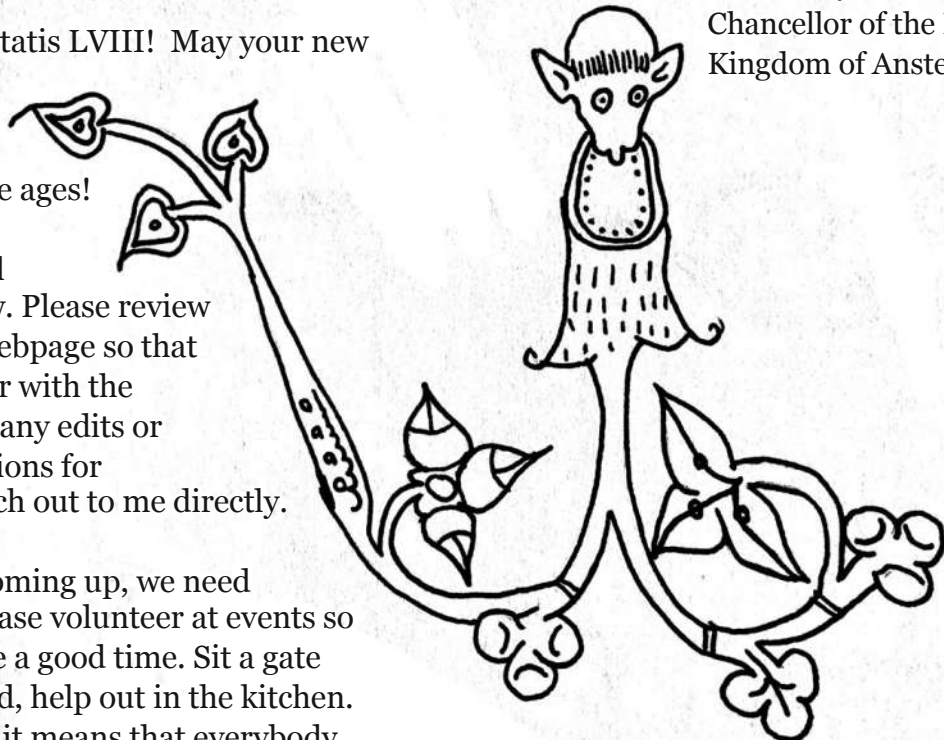

webpage, and 2) an example layout of that same content. My hope is that this will be useful for webminister, event stewards, local leadership, and anyone who has a hand in running an event and wants to make sure the information gets out there! This isn't a comprehensive list, but it covers most of the main info that folks look for on an event webpage, so use it as a guide or inspiration!

Duties range from encouraging classes in the various art mediums used to create insignia (weaving, metal work, etc.) as well as educating the populace on the correct heraldic design used in the designated Kingdom format (medallions, ribbons, etc.).
