





Before I go, may I direct you to the Kingdom Library? There are updated Event forms, and the Steward's Handbook saw a small revision in February, as did several Exchequer forms and handbooks.



It's been a very interesting couple of years for everyone. I am very grateful to Ealdormere's Exchequers, for continuing to get the job done when we were isolated, unable to hold meetings and events, making it difficult to be connected to Society. The continuity they provided kept the Kingdom of Ealdormere going as a legal entity, able to get the ball rolling again with a minimum of extra paperwork.

I've really enjoyed being the Kingdom Exchequer, and would recommend the position to anyone who likes spreadsheets and finds tracking the details fascinating. Kingdom Exchequer may be the least "public facing" of the Privy Council positions, but without someone to track the money, the Kingdom would not be able to meet its financial and reporting obligations.



Speaking of Deputies, I will be looking for a deputy interested in becoming the next Kingdom Exchequer in fairly short order - this is a two year position and by this time next year I hope to have a Deputy in place. Ealdormere has new submissions forms! They may be found at <https://ecoheralds.weebly.com/forms--reporting.html>. (Scroll down to the bottom to see the forms). You will notice that these are fillable PDF forms that allow any image files for armory to be posted right in. A few fields that are no longer in use, including date of birth and gender of the submitter, have been removed. Also please note that the line for the submitter's modern name now reads "modern name" rather than "legal name." There is no requirement that submitters need to use their legal name (unless claiming the legal name allowance for registering an SCA name). Whatever everyone calls you is fine.



Speaking of submissions, we are in the process of making submissions permanently free of charge in Ealdormere. However, we are coming up to the time at which we would inquire as to whether a local group would like to sponsor these registrations by donating to the Kingdom Heraldic fund. Previous donors include the Canton of Bryniau Tywynogg, the Barony of Rising Waters, and the Barony of Ben Dunfirth. Having no-cost submissions has helped us avoid a lot of paperwork and the pain of collecting money from each submitter, plus it's removed barriers to name and armory registration. If you are a local group (or a household or other group) who would be interested in sponsoring submissions, please contact me.

Hearty congratulations are due to Baroness Sciath, OL, Trillium Emerita, and new vigilant to the Order of the Pelican. (OK, I'm biased on this one :-). Wondering what happened in Court? 

Seeking SCA Demo Volunteers!

On Tues., Aug 8 (2 pm onward) the Perth Co. museum hosts delegates visiting from various cities and towns named Stratford around the world for a one day convention. See attached flyer for details on the Stratfords of the World group.

Yes, this date does conflict with Pennsic. But we're hoping that even a small, keen group of (ideally but not strictly) late-period enthusiasts, who are not going to war, would be interested in joining the demo.

The theme this year is (naturally?) "Shakespeare and his time". The museum would be delighted if anyone from Ealdormere would consider coming along and bringing all the Elizabethan (or late-ish) period flair and activities, show and tell, rapier/fighting, etc. we care to muster.

Our part of the demo is restricted to outdoors only, because all the convention stuff takes place inside. But they have lovely, expansive grounds in the shadow of a Victorian century home (the front part of the museum) and even highway-view fields for getting drive-by spectators along Highway 8. There are walking trails and little groves out back and a small pond that would make a lovely background for "activity stations" or similar. It may be possible to negotiate nominal, enclosed fire outside for demo cooking or other "hot" activities, if desired. Our part will happen rain or shine, so we'll need to plan accordingly.

Dafydd and I are willing to coordinate SCA participation in this demo. If you'd like to volunteer your time please contact us. We will also post regular reminders as we approach the date.
