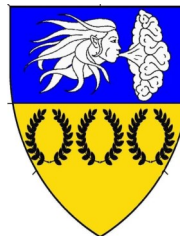

Coming from Boise and points north/west: Take I-84E to Simco Rd / exit 74. Go south on Simco Rd for 20 miles to ID 167. Turn right onto ID 167, go one-half mile and turn left onto Strike Dam Cutoff Rd. Go approx. 7.5 miles to North park campground (just before you get to CJ Strike Dam.)

Coming from SLC and points east: Take I-84W to Cold Springs Rd / exit 114 at Hammett, ID. Turn left onto Cold Springs Rd, cross I-84 and turn right onto Old US 30. Take Old US 30 for 2 miles, then turn left onto ID 78. Continue for 16 miles, then turn left onto ID 51 / ID 78. Go 7 miles, then shift right to stay on ID 78. Go 9 more miles, then turn right onto River Rd. Go 0.75 miles and turn right onto Black Sands Rd. Go 0.5 miles and turn left onto Strike Dam Cutoff Rd.

After getting to CJ Strike area: Do NOT turn at the North Park/Air Force Rec Area sign; turn at the second North Park exit. Also, do not turn into the Scout Camp area just south of the North Park signs.

Site Specifics: Marginal disability access (mown grass). Pets allowed on leash. The site has water and limited shade. Fires are allowed in designated firepits only. The site is wet, but please police your trash and use those mugs.

Apparently, what you wore in 15th century France could make you a famously scandalous fashion statement... or get you burned at the stake. Agnès Sorel was the first officially recognized royal mistress, in her case to Charles VII of France in the early-mid 15th century. Her presence at the Royal Court was soon felt as she was attributed with bringing the King out of a protracted depression, and generated scandal at court with her fashion statement of low cut gowns with a single breast bared. This (surprisingly enough) caught on in the fashion circles of the Royal Court. The Archbishop of Reims attempted to counsel the King to correct “front openings through which one sees the [mammaries] of women.”

In contrast, during the same time, was Joan of Arc. She also knew King Charles (though not in the same way), and when captured by the Burgundians in 1430 was brought up on heresy charges related to cross-dressing. Cross-dressing was considered heresy, and was a capital crime for a repeat offense. Joan, while imprisoned, maintained hosen, boots, and tunic that could be fastened to one another to protect her from “those who would take her by force” since a dress did not offer such protection. We all know how the stacked jury viewed the heroine and future Saint. A year after her capture, Joan was tied to a tall pillar in Rouen and set alight.

So consider your fashion sense when choosing your 15th century outfit. It could be daring and scandalous... it could be fatal. And now you know more random carp.
