## Publication Policies

Send submissions to the Kingdom Chronicler (see Regnum). All submissions IN THEIR ENTIRETY must be in the Kingdom Chronicler's possession **no later than the first of the month prior to the cover date (e.g. January 1 for the February issue)**. This includes e-mail and hardcopy submissions. Should the first fall on a Sunday or holiday, the deadline for hardcopy will be moved to the next business day; e-mail submissions will be due no later than the 1st regardless.

If you are going to be late, you must inform the Chronicler before the first

of the month so that space may be reserved. Anything arriving after the first is subject to refusal and has no guarantee of being published.

Submissions shall consist of a [1] an electronic copy, [2] an event announcement checklist which has been signed off on by the Seneschal of your group, and [3] a release form for any artwork (including maps) in the submission. **If your submission is missing any of the previous items it will potentially not be published if not resolved by midnight on the first.**

Additionally, if you wish to publish the same ad in more than one issue of The Black Star, you must resubmit your paperwork and event announcement each month UNLESS you have indicated on the first Event Ad/Seneschal Checklist that you wish the ad to run for more than one month. The Chronicler will assume that any ad received will only be used in the month it is received, unless otherwise stated on the Checklist. This is as much for our protection as it is to ensure that only the most current event information is contained in this publication. You are asked to send a half page ad to run in any month prior to your event month.

In order for "lasting business" (for example, laws and awards) to take place at an event, there must be a COMPLETE ad in the Black Star issue for the month of the event (so an August event must be in the August Black Star, and would be due July 1), UNLESS the event is in the first ten days of the month. Then the complete ad may be in the previous month's Black Star.

PDF is the (much) preferred file format for electronic submissions. Any other format MUST be discussed with the Kingdom Chronicler for acceptability. But please, just send PDF. The Kingdom Chronicler can advise free software solutions for doing so for Windows users.

Ads, releases and checklists should be sent in electronic form via e-mail if at all possible. As with all communications, please send them to [kingdom@chronicler.ansteorra.org](mailto:kingdom@chronicler.ansteorra.org).

## Express Mail Information

If you are sending your announcement by Express Mail or similar service, you MUST waive the signature requirement by signing the appropriate place on the form. This way the courier may leave the item. Otherwise, the delay in going to the Post Office to pick up your announcement may result in it not making it into The Black Star at all. In that case, you might as well not have sent it at all. So, for everyone's sake: PLEASE WAIVE THE SIGNATURE!

# Reports from the Realm



## Stellar Majesties

Greetings, mighty Ansteorra!

March brings one of the friendliest wars we have the opportunity to experience. Gulf Wars XXXI is upon us. We are looking forward to Ansteorra coming together with Trimaris and the other kingdoms of the Knowne World on the lands of Glenn Abhann for fun, camaraderie, and competition. There is so much to do, see, and experience at Gulf Wars XXXI, wonderful memories will be created that will last for years to come. Ansteorra, we march to war.

Gulf Wars is, in fact, the reason behind some recent law changes. The calendar has been reverted such that Crown Tourney and Coronation are situated so that the Heirs will be positioned to attend Pennsic. Populace of Ansteorra, this is where preparation for Gulf Wars begins, and Gulf Wars is the event that dominates the winter reign. There is no substitute for human contact in negotiations and seeking allies. Gulf Wars, too, must happen later in the winter reign, in order for Crown to have time to mobilize the kingdom, arrange to fulfill duties assigned to the kingdom by treaty, coordinate with other kingdoms about the war schedules, and so on. The logistics and timing of the current schedule, performed from the position of the Heirs, put Ansteorra at an unintended disadvantage.

However, in reverting to this schedule, We have considered that the summer heat of July is oppressive and that Heirs from a July Crown have a very short time before Pennsic. Crown Tourney is now scheduled in June, before the true summer heat begins, and this gives the Heirs an additional month to prepare. Furthermore, recognizing the burden

this places on the Heirs, We have coordinated with the Kingdom Financial Committee to allocate a dedicated fund solely to offset the costs of the Heirs' travel to Pennsic for the current year. Future years will have budgeted funds for the same purpose.

Ansteorra, war awaits! We will see you all there.

Happy March -- That means it's time to get ready for Gulf Wars!!!

Remember to get your names in at volunteer point -- every hour you volunteer at war is worth \$ to the SCA Group you designate. We'd love your donation at the Kingdom Level, but your Principality/Barony/Province/Shire/Canton/Riding/Stronghold can benefit from those volunteer hours too!!!!

I'd like to send early thanks to those groups who have and are still working with Domesday to get our report done on time. I'd love to set the record of 2 in a row!! I know Jutte is working hard to get that done, and I know she appreciates all the help she can get.

In case you missed it, you can now pay for your heraldry submissions through PayPal -- be sure you're looking for those invoices when they're sent -- we're getting lots that are cancelled for non-pay within the 72 hours.

I've had several questions recently about Family Max so I'd like to address that. The COST for a family that meets family max is set to three adult registrations (any adults in the family max equations that are not members still must pay the \$5 NMR). To qualify for NMR the family is defined by Kingdom Financial Policy as 2 adults and any number of minor children who reside in the home. This means that when kids reach the age of 18, they are no longer eligible for family max. Please make sure this is the calculation used at all events. If you need more examples of family max, please reach out to me. I'm here to help!

Thank you for all that you do for your group, your region, and your kingdom. I appreciate each and

every one of you (even if you're not an exchequer).



## Changes to Ansteorran Law Creppin II and Toryn II

*These laws were read in the final court of Creppin II and Toryn II at Coronation that occurred on January 14, 2023.*


- Updated formatting and page numbers throughout the document
- Removed Article II: Officers, Section 5: Seneschal, C.7.a.
- Added Article IV: Events, Section 2, Subsection 1, C1 – “A list of accepted combatants shall be approved by the Crown of Ansteorra”
- Added Article IV: Events, Section 5: Requirements for Entry into Crown Tournament: Section

E – Combatant and Consort must be of legal age in both Oklahoma and Texas

- Added Article IV: Events, Section 5: Requirements for Entry into Crown Tournament: Section F – Combatant and Consort must have a paid membership
- Moved Article IV: Events, Section 5: Requirements for Entry into Crown Tournament, E,F, G, H, I to G, H, I, J, K
- Removed Article IV: Events, Section 5: Requirements for Entry into Crown Tournament: Section G (old section E) 3.
- Removed Article IV: Events, Section 5: Requirements for Entry into Crown Tournament: Section G (old

section E) 8.

- Removed Article IV: Events, Section 5: Requirements for Entry into Crown Tournament: Section H (old section F) 2.
- In Article VII: Local Branches, Section 2, A, removed the wording “ten of which are subscribing members”
- In Article VII: Local Branches, Section 3, A, removed the wording “five of which are subscribing members”
- In Article VII: Local Branches, Section 7, A, removed the wording “ten of which are subscribing members”
- In Article VII: Local Branches, Section 8, A, removed the wording “five of which are subscribing members”




## Gabriel III and Sonja III

***These laws were read into the premier court of Gabriel III and Sonja III at Coronation held on January 14, 2023.***

Please note, the law changes in Article II, Section 3, Subsection 1, A, Article IV, Section 3 (currently Perpetual Events) and Article IV, Section 4 (currently Event Limits) and the additional law Article II, Section 3, Subsection 1, A 6 are suspended until further discussions can occur

- Article II, Section 2, Subsection 1, A.3 – removed “the Crown or by” and added “and confirmed by the Crown” at the end
- Article II, Corrected “Rights and Duties of the Peers and Nobility” to be a section and renumbered all subsequent sections
- Article II, Section 14 (previous Section 13), Changed wording to read “The royal family consists of those who have served as Sovereign or Consort, or as Principality Sovereign or Consort.”
- Article II, Section 16 (previous Section 15), Subsection 1, A. 3 Added “d. To give feedback on potential Regional officers, who will be responsible for appointing local officers within their lands, prior to appointment”
- Article III, Section 1, Added “C. To know the identity of and have opportunity to give feedback on candidates for local positions within the branch in which they reside.
- Article IV, Section 2, Table in J – Added Protected, Kingdom Gathering, 25%
- Article IV, Section 2, Added “K. Kingdom Gathering is not on a fixed schedule and need not be on the second weekend of the month, but must be announced a minimum of one year in advance and may not be scheduled on a weekend where any other event already exists.
- Article IV, Section 2, Subsection 1, A. 1 changed to Summer and June
- Article IV, Section 2, Subsection 1, A. 2 changed to Winter and January
- Article IV, Section 2, Subsection 1 B. changed to April and October
- Article IV, Section 2, Subsection 2 C. Changed “Kingdom Cut and Thrust Champion” to “Royal Blade”
- Article IV, Section 5, G.4 – Replaced “Affirm to have served in an administrative office of the SCA, or equivalent, for at least a total of one year, or as King’s or Queen’s Champion.” With “Affirm to have served as a warranted officer of the SCA for at least one year total, or as a warranted officer for effort equivalent to a year.”
- Article IV, Section 5, G. 10 – Changed “Give sufficient assurance that they will remain in the kingdom for the next nine months.” To “Give significant assurance that they will remain in the kingdom throughout the entirety of the following reign.
- Article IV, Section G – Renumbered
- Article VII, Moved Section 7 to 3, Moved Section 3 to 5, Moved Section 8 to 6, Moved Section 5 to 7, Moved Section 6 to 8





# Principality of Vindheim Law Changes

## **Added**

4.2.7. A list of accepted combatants shall be approved by the Coronet of Vindheim and then sent to the Crown of Ansteorra to review. Should any entrants be found unacceptable, the party denying the entrants (whether that be Crown or Coronet) shall communicate their decision to that entrant. After approval by the Coronet and the Crown of Ansteorra, the list of combatants will be made public via all currently

maintained social media platforms and the principality email list at least 1 week prior to the date of the Tournament. In this communication, the Coronet shall also announce the format for the coming Tournament.

## **Added**

### 8. SMOKING

8.1. Smoking/Vaping is prohibited in all areas, inside and out, in which members of the populace must be present in order to participate in any aspect of an event. This shall include any area they must pass through, or in close proximity to, in order to reach these areas. This is not intended to restrict smoking in private encampments or areas designated by the event staff for the express purpose of Smoking/Vaping. Whenever possible, the Event Steward shall be responsible for defining a designated smoking area, as convenient as is reasonably possible.

## **Removed**

4.1.2. Coronet Tournament locations shall be selected using the priority bid system described in Sections 4.2.5 and 4.2.6.

4.1.5. A branch that has not held a Coronet event in as many times as there are eligible branches may submit a bid that asserts priority. In the case of multiple priority bids, the branch that has not held a Coronet event in the longest time shall receive higher priority. A priority bid that meets the standards set forth in these Laws shall be strongly considered in preference to any other bid. The final decision for the winning bid shall rest with the Principality Financial Committee. Groups below the level of Barony and Province shall receive priority for bids ahead of Baronies and Provinces.

4.1.6. For purposes of priority, new groups shall be counted as if they held the Coronet event immediately prior to their establishment. In the case that this creates a tie for priority, the event, if acceptable to the Principality Financial Committee, shall be awarded to the new group.

Previous Section Updated With:

4.1.3. The following points shall be considered with regard to bids:

4.1.3. 1 Any group within the Principality that meets Society, Kingdom, and Principality Law for hosting a fighting event may place a bid.

4.1.3. 2. Bids, once accepted, can only be changed by a majority vote of the Principality Financial Committee, except as may be necessary to meet Society, Kingdom, or Principality law.

4.1.3. 3. The Principality Financial Committee is encouraged to choose acceptable bids from smaller or newer groups.

4.1.3. 4. The Principality Financial Committee is encouraged to choose acceptable bids in such a manner as to spread the event location and hosting group around the principality.




