

Random Garb that I have Learned

A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

Many women with Norse attire have a collection of tools on a ring: tweezers, ear scoop, nail cleaner... This group of tools is called a chatelaine. Used since Roman times, women (because even in ancient history women's clothing lacked POCKETS!) had a ring of tools hung from the belt for use. Starting with the 16th century Dutch, these started becoming status tools for housekeepers, a veritable Swiss army knife on a ring. The woman who carried all the various keys of the house, to pantries, drawers, cabinets, storage, was seen as the woman of the household, a status symbol. The more items on your chatelaine, the more important you are. Fashion evolved to embellish the chatelaine with other small objects in place of keys, to give the appearance of importance.

Today we in the Society task our Chatelaines with the role of unlocking the SCA for newcomers, giving them loaner garb, directions, and basic etiquette. Unsurprisingly, the symbol for the office is a key hanging down. And now you know more random carp.
