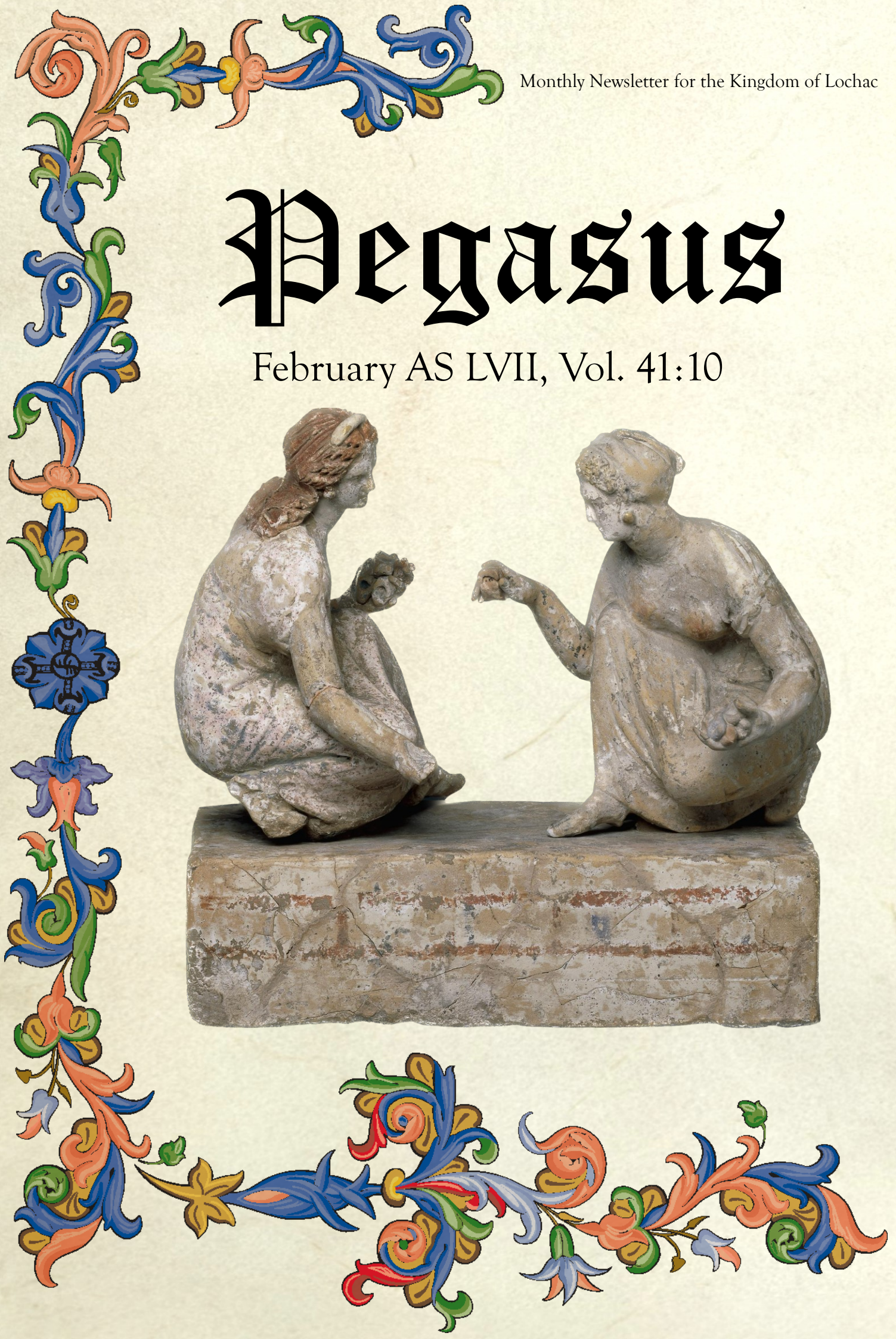

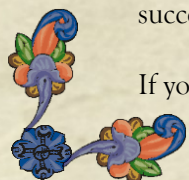
Stewarding Festival is a unique experience - whilst there are similarities to stewarding other events, there are also some very large differences.

You do not need to be from Rowany to Steward Festival, but if you are not you will need a Baronial member to be Rowany Liaison as part of your team.

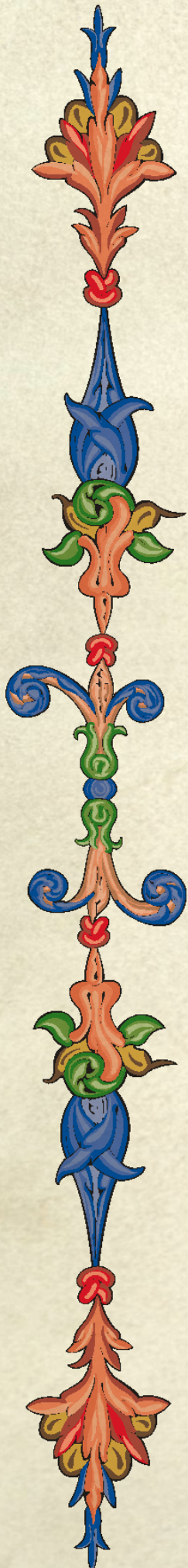

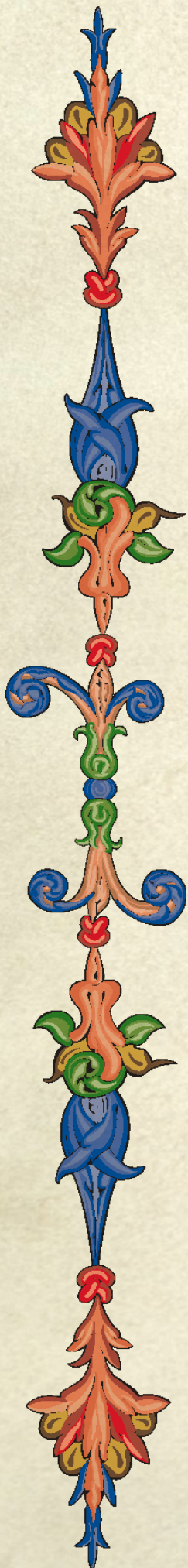
