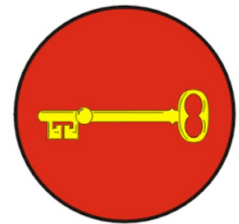

Kingdom Earl Marshal Report

Greetings Caid,

I have been seeing all kinds of single-hand weapons from broken spears, broken lances, dane axes, madus, etc. I also keep getting questions on what is legal.

I believe the time has come to make a rule set on what is legal for these kinds of weapons. I have worked with several people and have asked the Known World about what they have for rules.

The following is what I believe to be a reasonable rule set. This rule will go into effect 07/01/2023. This will provide a transition time for people to make changes to their weapons and come into compliance.


Over the next several months we will evaluate the use of these weapons. The final version of this rule will come out in the next revision of the Armored Combat Handbook.

Rule 001-2023
EFFECTIVE 07/01/2023

A weapon that's primary design or purpose is use by one hand may have thrusting tips on both ends as long as it meets the following requirements.

- The length must be between 30" and 60".
- No Thrusting tip shall be closer than 8" of the edge of the grip, hand protection or buckler if used. The measurement is taken from the top of the grip, hand protection, or buckler to the end of the thrusting tip. The 8" non-gripping zone shall be clearly marked.
- If a basket hilt, buckler or equivalent is attached it shall have no cross greater than 12" in height, width, or depth.
- If the weapon has a buckler or basket hilt, or equivalent mounted, it may not combine thrusting tips on both ends and an additional cutting edge or mass weapon head.
- No weapon may have a cutting and/or smashing surface at both ends.
- Per the Society's Weapon Standards, General rules, "No "punch weapons" or thrusting weapons that have the blade or tip more perpendicular than parallel to the grip." To ensure that the punching force is not directly behind the striking surface, a 4" offset is required from the bottom of the striking surface to the top of the grip or hand protection.

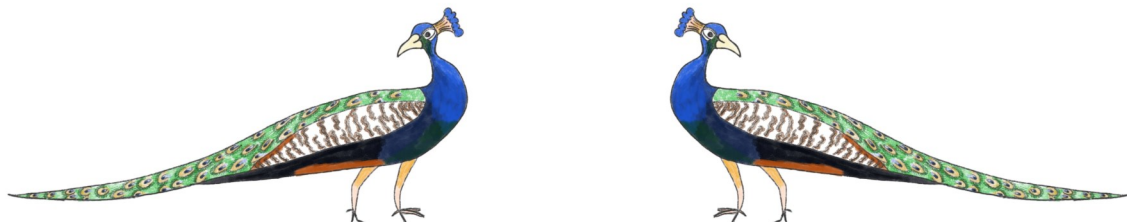
