


From the Kingdom Earl Marshal

Hey, everyone, this is your friendly, neighborhood, Kingdom Earl Marshall with a PSA and a couple of rule clarifications. First is the PSA.

As summer approaches temperatures will rise and we need to make sure that we are hydrating properly. Make sure that you know your body and listen to it. If you need to take a break, take a break. We all want to be heroes, but we should all listen to our bodies.

Now to the rules clarifications. The most recent update to the Marshall's handbook of the SCA has removed the density requirement for shields. This means that plastic shields are now legal in Meridies. However please check your equipment to make sure that you are safe. The second rule clarification comes from the Meridian Marshall's handbook. A thrusting tip must be a third contrasting color. This means you must have one color for your blade, one color for your sword, and a third, clearly different, color for the thrusting tip. While you're looking over your thrusting tips make sure that they are safe. Check them for integrity and give.

Well, that is it for me. Go out there have fun, be safe, and try not to do anything really stupid.

SCA— Positions Available

Marshal of the Society (Society Marshal)

The Marshal of the Society's area of authority is all martial and related activities practiced in the Society, both those described by the handbooks approved for the office and proposed as additions to those handbooks (experimental activities). The Marshal will work to encourage the participation of all in the Society's martial activities, and strive to expand and improve those activities for the benefit of the Society and its members.

The duties of the office include:

- ◆ Directing the Earl Marshals of the Kingdoms in matters concerning the supervision of martial and related activities at Society events
- ◆ Overseeing the manner and conduct of duties of all marshals throughout the Society
- ◆ Working to promote and improve the safety of the Society's martial activities

- ◆ Working with the Minister of Arts and Sciences to encourage research in armor, weapons, and the practice of historical martial arts

Day-to-day work of the position entails administering the marshallate activities of the Society and coordinating the activities of the Kingdom Earl Marshals, and of all Deputy Society Marshals for the individual disciplines. Reports are required to be filed quarterly to the Board summarizing the martial activities of the Society. The Society Marshal is also responsible for maintaining communications with the Kingdom Earl Marshals. Details regarding these specific activities can be found at: www.sca.org



Finally, as the calendar starts filling up, (Woo! Hoo!) I would like to remind Event Stewards of the flyer requirements and deadlines for the Popular Chivalry (please see below). Flyers must also be emailed to me using the official Seneschal's email of the hosting group.

Please keep in mind I work one month ahead of your event. It is May as I write this for the June Edition. Also, don't forget you depending on how full the PC is for a particular month, you may have the opportunity to advertise your event for 2 months!

POPULAR CHIVALRY FLYER REQUIREMENTS

SCHEDULE

Contact the Kingdom Calendar Deputy to reserve your date on the Kingdom Calendar for your event. Events not on the Official Kingdom Calendar (Extended Calendar – Google Spreadsheet) will not be published. The Group Seneschal is the only person authorized to reserve or release a date on the Kingdom Calendar. Only the Kingdom Calendar Deputy can officially confirm a date reservation or cancellation.

FREQUENCY

Kingdom Level Events will have two full page flyers, the month before and the month of the event. Local events will have one half-page flyer published the month of the event, or the month before if the event falls within the first 10 days of the month. Local stewards are encouraged to send in flyers the month before their event; if space allows, flyers will be published based on order of receipt.

SUBMITTING

Electronically submit your event flyer to chronicler@kingdom.meridies.org. Formats, in order of preference, are: PDF, DOC, PUB, JPG. Please ensure that any JPG files are at least 200dpi in order to print properly.

Publishing deadlines are **the 1st of the month preceding the publication month**. IE: items to be published in the July Popular Chivalry must be submitted before June 1st. The Kingdom Chronicler will send confirmation of receipt for all flyers and officer letters received. If you do not have a confirmation of receipt of your flyer, the Kingdom Chronicler does not have your flyer.

ART & CREATIVE WORKS

All art submitted with flyers must have permission to publish. This information should be included in the email accompanying your flyer. All original creative works, including cover or filler art, writing or photos must be accompanied by the correct release form. Flyers containing art obtained from public domain sources must submit source of art.

DESIGN

Sizes have changed slightly :
Half page: 7.5" wide by 4.5" high
Full Page: 7.5" wide by 9.5" high

All ads **MUST** contain the following information:

- Name of the event
- Name of the sponsoring group
- Date of event
- Name, email address and phone number of the event steward and reservations person (legal & SCA)
- If there is a fee, flyers must include:
"Make checks payable to: SCA, Inc/group name"
- Location of site including: site name, physical street address, city, state and zip
- Directions to the site
- Time the event opens and closes
- Prices including weekend, daytrip, child, and off-board fees

Use WHITE BACKGROUNDS and LINE DRAWING images for flyers. Grayscale or color images and dark backgrounds do not work well and may make your flyer unreadable. Do not use fonts smaller than 8 point. 9 point or larger is preferred. Chose fonts wisely. Some ornate fonts are **VERY** hard to read when reproduced.

All local events must have a \$5 fee for non-members, if there is a fee to attend the event. If there is a discounted fee for minors, then non-member minors do not pay the \$5 non-member fee. Please word your flyers so that this is understood.


