A Royal Proclamation

Each combatant must be accompanied by an inspiration. One worthy of the throne beside them. One whose presence shall grace the lists and whose strength shall guide their champion's hand.

Declarations of intent must be made unto Their Majesties in the manner and time set forth by Kingdom law and custom.

ENTRANT INSTRUCTIONS

Please read carefully, the process for entering Crown Tourney has changed.

Letters of Intent for participating in Crown Tourney **and** Crown Entrant Information Forms for both Combatant and Consort are due **on or before October 4**. Entrants must have resided within the Kingdom of Artemisia for twelve (12) months and to have been active in the SCA for the twelve (12) months preceding the tournament. Entrants' SCA membership information must reflect their residence in Artemisia and combatants must have a current combat authorization in Artemisia. They must be at least eighteen (18) years of age, have a regular means of quick communication, dependable transportation, and sufficient income to support the Crown should they win. They must be acceptable unto the Crown of Artemisia. Each unbelted combatant must have a member of the Order of Chivalry who is willing to speak for them at the time of Crown Tournament. Additionally, each entrant must agree to remain resident of the Kingdom of Artemisia throughout their tenure and reign, to familiarize themselves with Corpora and Kingdom Law, Kingdom Financial Policy and be willing to swear on their honor that, should they win, they believe themselves competent to hold the Crown of Artemisia. Letters of Intent **may** be hand-delivered to Their Majesties and **must** be emailed to crown.list.entry@artemisia.sca.org on or before the deadline listed above, even if you have hand-delivered your letter to Their Majesties. There is a Sonic Fast food at the Eden Truck Stop as well as a sit down restaurant. Twin Falls is just 7 miles south of exit 182. The site has plenty of shade and animals are welcomed but are to be leashed at all times and cleaned up after. There are bathrooms with handicap accessibility both within the campgrounds and in the main hall. There will be a firepit behind the main hall for bardic and general enjoyment.
