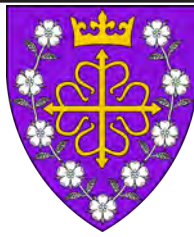

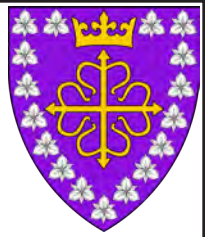

We wish to remind everyone that letters of intent are now being accepted for the Fall Crown Tournament.

The Crown Tournament shall be held on November 8th, 2025, in the Shire of the Crystal Mynes.

This tournament shall be fought bring-your-best, best two out of three.

In the Finals, it shall be best two out of three of three. Each finalist shall select a weapon form for one round. The Crown shall select shield and buckler (no larger than 18 inches) for the final round.

To be considered, fighters **MUST** be able to span their shield, and each couple must submit the following:

- Names of both Fighter and Consort
- Proof of current SCA Membership for the fighter and consort at the time of the tournament
- If membership is due to expire at any time during the reign, proof of renewal within 10 days of winning Crown Tournament will be required
- List of SCA events attended within the past 12 months
- A copy of a legal ID for the fighter and consort. Both must reside in Calontir (or Treaty) and meet the age requirements of Kingdom law.
- Statement of Intent:
Why do you wish to be Crown?
- Names of your:
 - Chamberlain
 - Head of Household
 - Scribe
 - Herald

All letters must be submitted to the Crown and Seneschal no later than October 18th, 2025.

We look forward to seeing who among the Heartland's finest shall step forward to bear the weight of Calontir's legacy.

Letters of interest to compete in Crown Tournament are due to TRMs and the Kingdom Seneschal by October 18, 2025. Below is a summary of what a letter of interest for Calontir Crown Tournament should include. Your letter can be formatted as you wish. I have seen fancy flowery prose, just the facts, and everything in between.

Requirements to vie for the honor of being Calontir Crown are found in Calontir Kingdom law and SCA Corpora and Policies. Some of the requirements allow the hosting Crown to grant exceptions.

Combatants and Consorts must be members of the SCA, be at least 19 years old, reside in Calontir over the prior 12 months (or live in close proximity to the borders - with permission from the Crown hosting

the tournament) and have been an active participant in Calontir during that time. Both the combatant and consort are asked to confirm that they have read the governing documents (Corpora, SCA Policies, and Calontir Kingdom Law). These documents are where you will find the rights and responsibilities of the Crown. A simple statement in your letter that you have read these documents is acceptable. If your letter doesn't contain the required information I will reach out to you requesting additional information or clarification.

In addition to these requirements the Crown may have other requirements specific to Their Tournament. In my years in the SCA I have seen: A&S projects for display, items to be donated to largesse, specific tournament weapons/styles, a statement of offices held, a statement of why you want to win the tournament/ what you want to do/support if you win—all things that reflect on the parts of the SCA that the couple feels are important or that they wish to highlight.

Have any questions? Read Corpora and Kingdom law and now you have lots of questions? Let me know, I'm delighted to discuss these things. I think it's interesting. Don't worry about a silly question. I have friends I ask about things too (sometimes even silly questions), because things change and what I thought it said might not be what it says now. I also re-read the documents when I get a question, because it's really too much to try to remember.

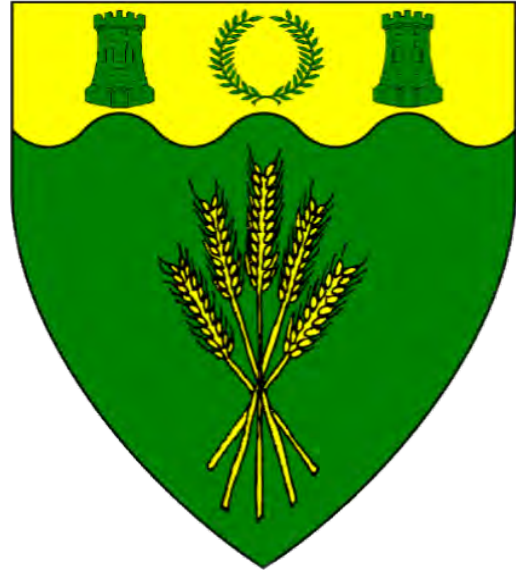

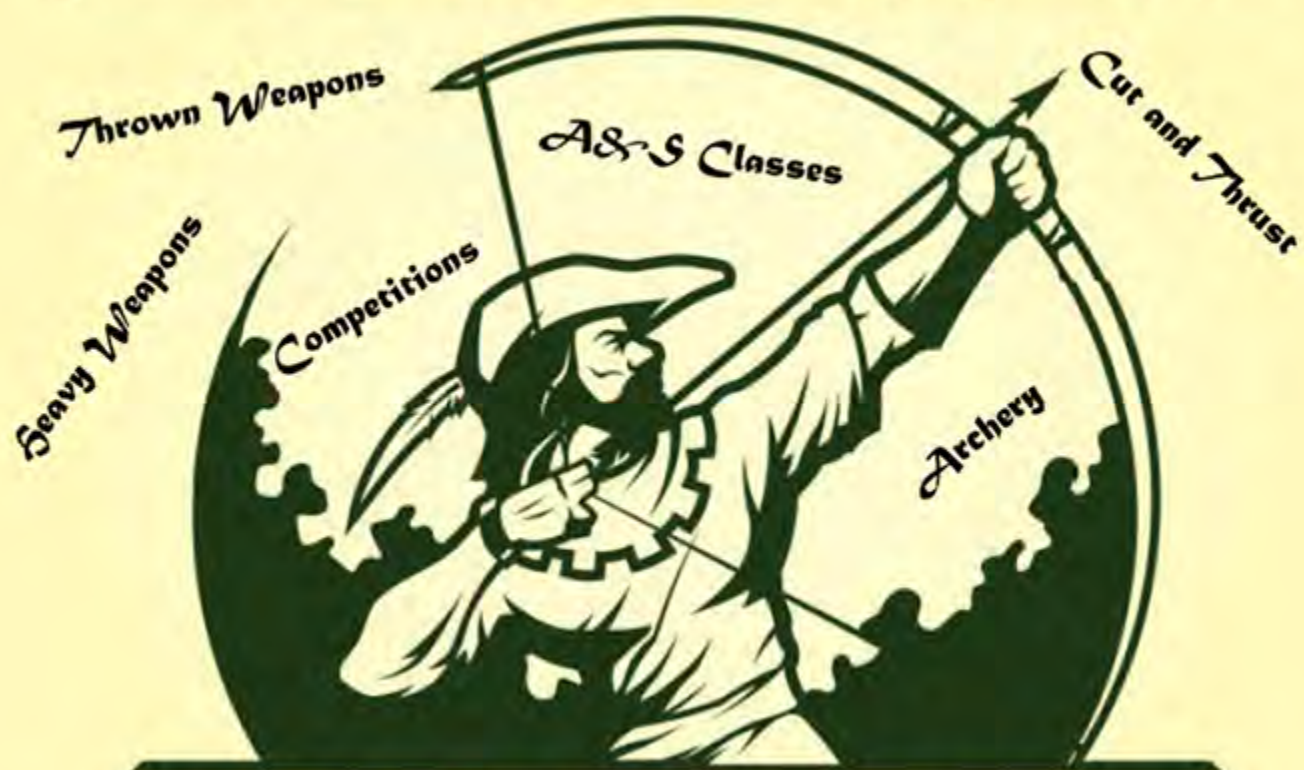

Event Flyer Guidelines

For Their Majesties to hold Court and for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in The Mews. Failure to do so means that the Crown cannot hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer, confirm your event with the Reeve. The Mews WILL NOT publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: <https://www.calontir.org/calendar/>

Editable: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. Work with the Social Media Officer for flyers that may be posted on social media.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1st of the month THREE MONTHS PRIOR to your event. *For Example:* If the event is in November, the flyer must be received by August 1st for the September Mews. Refer to the Calendar at the front of the Mews.

If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period. The deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!

Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

1. Name of the sponsoring group or groups
2. Day, month, and year of the event
3. Site open & close times for populace
4. Location of the event—the name of the event site, and full address.
5. Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event Steward, including contact phone and email (Needed for emergencies or issues arise)
6. Details of Registration—Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

For Example:

Adult Event Registration: \$25

Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20

Youth (6-17) \$5

Children 5 & Under: FREE
