Submission Guidelines

The deadline for the Dragon's Tale is the 25th of the month that is two months before the issue date (e.g., the December issue deadline is 25 October). Submissions for the Dragon's Tale should be sent to chronicler@drachenwald.sca.org. Material should be sent in MS Word, RTF or plain text. Send photographs and artwork as separate files. Note that event announcements will be standardised in format. Original work (articles, photographs, artwork) must be accompanied by a permission form <http://www.drachenwald.sca.org/sites/default/files/permission.pdf> or the equivalent words in an email. Any copyrighted material by others must be accompanied by written permission from the original author(s). Please check the licence/usage terms of any clip-art used. The Dragon's Tale is set using Scribus 1.6.2 with Garamond, Arial, Arial Narrow, Lucida Handwriting and UBW Chancery typefaces in various sizes. The Dragon's Tale logo is in Tyrfinng Demo typeface.

Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. This can be done by filling in the calendar event date request form on the Kingdom web page: <https://drachenwald.sca.org/events/calendar-add/>. Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web form.

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event .
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

The site is Ahtela youth camping center. The site has been previously successfully

used for several SCA events including Coronation and Crown Tourney.

The site is spread over a forest near the sea. We'll be using all buildings on site. The site is in our exclusive use. There are few neighbours and no services (gas stations, shops, etc.) in the immediate area.

Ahtela is a typical youth camping centre in the sense that activities will take place in different buildings and therefore one will have to do some walking outdoors to get to places, regardless of the weather. We recommend that all guests bring good outdoor shoes that are suitable for walking in Finnish winter weather. The roads between the buildings are sand/gravel and very well lit even during the night time. Maintenance of the roads is taken care of by a hired care keeper. There's some trekking up/downhill, but the slopes are not very steep. We do try to limit on-site driving as much as possible during the event. But if one cannot walk the distance, it is possible to drive by car almost door-to-door between accommodation and feast hall. Most buildings are not handicapped accessible.

There is the main hall building that will have space for 120 for the feast. Courts will also be held in the main hall. There is a smaller hall for 40 persons that will be used for classes. In the additional hall there is a large industrial style kitchen that can be used for cooking classes. These two halls have no accommodation spaces.

University classes will be held in the main hall and the small hall but accommodation buildings also have spaces that will be used for University classes. There are at least 7 areas that can hold classes simultaneously. These areas are not uniform in size which will have to be taken into consideration when submitting classes for the University. Some areas are large enough to hold 2 classes simultaneously. As the class spaces are 5-10 minute walk apart from each other this will be taken into account when planning the University schedule to allow convenient time for changing classrooms.

There are 8 accommodation buildings spread over the site. These have beds for 6-30 people each. All beds have pillows and blankets. All guests must bring bed linens and use them even if they are using a sleeping bag. There is also some crash space on the floor in some buildings. Crash space is a single mattress sized spot on the floor. If you have been assigned crash space you will need to bring your own mattress, pillow and blanket.

All buildings are modern and in good condition.
