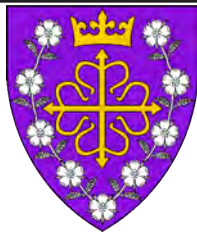

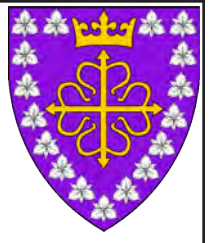
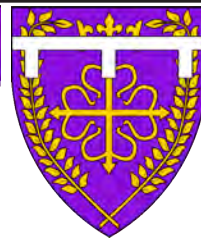

VIII. Great and Lesser Officers of the Kingdom

VIII. 104 – Great and Lesser Officers are required to place a call for applications for their positions in the Kingdom newsletter, no less than 2 months prior to the expiration of their Warrant to find suitable applicants.

Appendix I. The Order of Precedence and the Order of March of the Kingdom of Calontir.

AI.102 - The following recognition conveys no position in the Order of Precedence:

Addition to AI.102:

THE CONSORT'S PILLARS OF DISTINCTION.

As the Patron of all gentle and courteous behavior, the Sovereign Consort of Calontir may, at their own discretion, bestow upon some few individuals (not groups) The Consorts Pillar of Distinction. This recognition may be given only six times during any one reign and only once in each of the following categories:

(1) Unto the individual who has shown the highest of chivalric behavior;

(2) Unto the individual who has best exemplified gentle and courteous behavior;

(3) Unto the individual who best exemplifies the ideals and goals of our Society.

(4) Unto the individual who fosters knowledge and growth of others;

(5) Unto the individual who is a constant source of revelry and merriment;

(6) Unto the individual who spreads the word fame of Calontir to the Knowne World.

The Sovereign Consort may bestow any or all of these recognitions as desired. The Sovereign Consort may bestow upon those individuals a badge of the Sovereign Consort's own initials entwined with a rose, constructed as the Sovereign Consort desires. The recipient may place the initials 'C.P.D.' after their name and other denotations of rank, if said recipient desires. Individuals may be so honored by more than one Sovereign Consort, at Their Majesty's discretion.

Amongst the following awards: the King's Favor, The Queen's Endorsement of Distinction, and Consort's Pillars of Distinction, Their Majesties must pick only two of the three to hand out in Their Reign.

Arabella Isidora del Sol. Name and device. Argent, on a sun gules a phoenix Or, a bordure compony Or and azure.

Balli i Ubbaholl. Name and device. Per pale Or and sable, on a bend a dragon passant counterchanged.

Balli i Ubbaholl. Badge. (Fieldless) A brown squirrel proper winged maintaining a valknut Or.

There is a step from core practice for the use of a valknut.

Deirdre inghean Cormaic. Name and device. Azure, a willow tree argent and an orle argent lozengy azure.

Edmund Parsy. Name and device. Azure, a pall argent semy of hearts palewise gules.

Gabhan mac Aedain. Reblazon of device. Per fess argent and sable, in base a wyvern erect with one foot raised, wings displayed, and tail nowed argent.

Issabell Saint Charles. Device change. Or, four fleurs-de-lys in cross bases to center, in chief a coronet flory azure, a bordure azure semy-de-lys argent.

Istvan of Mag Mor. Name (see RETURNS for device).

Mag Mor is the registered name of an SCA branch.

Jacquette DeBrackeleire. Device change. Or chaussé, a human breast gules distilling three gouttes argent.

Jane Augusta Sinclair. Badge. Azure, an elephant rampant proper within a four-lobed quadrangle cornice Or.

Jóhann Steinarsson. Heraldic title Walker Herald.

Ketill Karlsson. Device change. Or, a wyvern erect with one leg raised contourny sable, a bordure indented gules.

Kolfinna Valdísardóttir. Name and device. Per pale purple and sable, a chevron fracted Or.

Marcus Octavius Valentinus. Name.

Matthias Worcestershire. Badge. Azure, in fess two mascles interlaced, overall a fess Or.

Miyazaki Atsutaka. Badge for Thomas Foulmoth. Per fess vert and gules, a moth argent charged with in fess two mullets voided and interlaced sable and a cockatrice argent.

Morwenna ferch Dafydd. Reblazon of device. Argent semy of dandelions in profile Or slipped and leaved vert, a wooden A-frame plumb-line proper.

Rayna Stensdottir. Name.

This name combines a Ukrainian given name and a Swedish byname, an acceptable lingual mix per SENA

The submitter grants blanket permission to conflict with any name that is not identical to their name.

The submitter grants blanket permission to conflict for any armory that is not identical to their device.

Ubbe Hr{oe}reksson. Blanket permission to conflict with badge. Vert, in bend sinister two wolf's heads coupé contourny argent.

Vény Andriðardóttir. Name (see PENDS for device).

William of Friedrichsburg. Reblazon of device. Per fess Or and vert, two wyverns sejant respectant, each with one foot raised gules, a bordure embattled counterchanged.

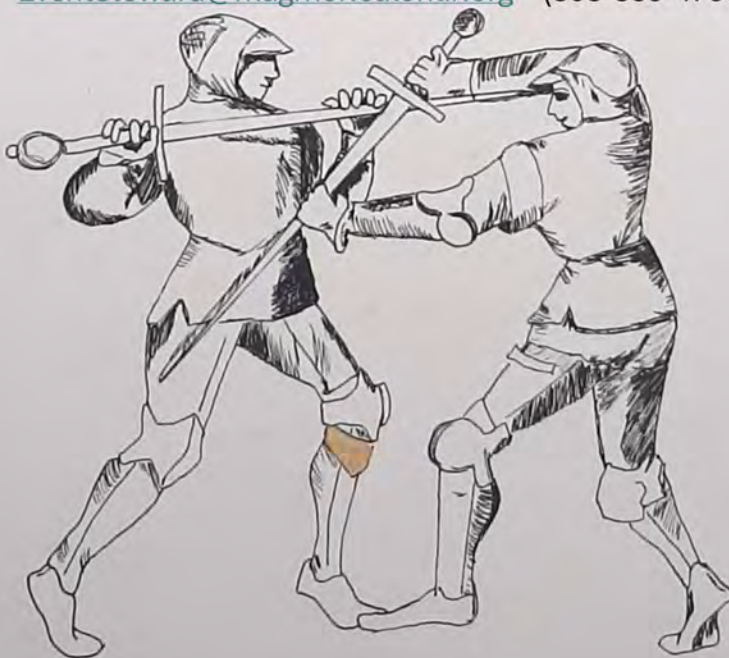

Event Flyer Guidelines

For Their Majesties to hold Court and for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in The Mews. Failure to do so means that the Crown cannot hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer, confirm your event with the Reeve. The Mews WILL NOT publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: <https://www.calontir.org/calendar/>

Editable: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. Work with the Social Media Officer for flyers that may be posted on social media.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1st of the month THREE MONTHS PRIOR to your event. *For Example:* If the event is in November, the flyer must be received by August 1st for the September Mews. Refer to the Calendar at the front of the Mews.

If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period. The deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!

Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

1. Name of the sponsoring group or groups
2. Day, month, and year of the event
3. Site open & close times for populace
4. Location of the event—the name of the event site, and full address.
5. Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event Steward, including contact phone and email (Needed for emergencies or issues arise)
6. Details of Registration—Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

For Example:

Adult Event Registration: \$25
Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20
Youth (6-17) \$5
Children 5 & Under: FREE
