Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. This can be done by filling in the calendar event date request form on the Kingdom web page: <https://drachenwald.sca.org/events/calendar-add/>. Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web form.

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event .
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

Greetings from the Seneschal

Greetings and salutations, good gentles of Drachenwald! Two pieces of business this month:

1. I am saddened to report that the Shire of Klakavirki is now 'dormant', this action having been taken at the request of their populace. This means the branch effectively does not exist for the immediate future with respect to hosting official activities, although they can be readily re-activated when they are ready to do so. Here's hoping a short breather will do them well, and they can return even stronger than they were before!

2. I write you once again with a reminder & plea regarding kingdom events. In my time as seneschal, we've yet to receive a timely bid to host a kingdom event, and finding a host has normally taken some chasing if not wheedling. These events are critical to maintain our status as a Kingdom, and it should generally be considered an honor for a group to host them (plus a good fund-raising opportunity given the almost-guaranteed

attendance). For those not aware, Drachenwald also has a rotation scheme whereby different regions of the kingdom have priority for hosting a given event. This helps ensure (1) everyone has equal opportunity to host kingdom-level events, and (2) that the work is distributed throughout the kingdom.

So I ask our local groups to please consider hosting kingdom events when it is your regions turn - particularly if you've not done so in the past, or if it's been a while. If the prospect seems intimidating, please reach out to other groups who have hosted such events recently and I'm sure they will be happy to advise you. If you are not sure you have enough people to put on such an event, feel free to ask your neighboring groups for help! But the process is fairly simple: you simply need to prepare a bid to host the event and submit it to me; the kingdom financial committee will review it; and if approved, you are officially the host and can proceed with organizing the event.

The upcoming kingdom events and their bid due dates are always published in every DT, but a quick reminder of the current ones awaiting bids (as of the time of writing):

- Autumn Crown (9-11 October 2026) bids due 10 January 2026, Northern region has priority
- Kingdom University (6-8 November 2026) bids due 10 February 2026, anyone may host
- 12th Night Coronation (8-10 January 2027) bids due 10 April 2026, Central region has priority

Welcome to Malt War! The event features war and competition in archery, fencing, and heavy fighting.

Arrival and departure times

You may arrive at the event site starting Friday at 18:00 (6 p.m.). On Sunday, rooms must be clean and all participants must leave the site by 12:00 (noon).

Location and public transportation

Event address: Kalliopirtti camp center, Kalliopirtintie 20, 16610 Kärkölä.

The site is located 100 km north of Helsinki (1.5 hours by car), 90 km north of Helsinki airport (1 h 15 min), 120/145 km southeast of Tampere (1 h 40 min via either route). Reasonably good driving conditions can be expected, possibly icy surfaces late in the evening and early in the morning.

The nearest rail stop is Lappila, just 7.3 km/10 minutes by car from the site, pickups from there can be organized. The stop has frequent commuter train connections from both central Helsinki and Helsinki airport. Both trips take roughly 1.5 hours depending on the connection but note that on Friday you must be ready to board the first train at latest around 21:00 (9 p.m.). On Sunday, you cannot make it to the airport before 8:30 in the morning. You must have a ticket before boarding a train in Finland. The train timetables and tickets for April will become available before the end of February.

Meals

You need to eat to be able to go to war. Five substantial meals are served during the weekend: dinner on Friday, breakfast, heavy snack with coffee and feast on Saturday, breakfast on Sunday. All milk products used are low lactose/lactose free. Lacto-ovo vegetarian meals without meat nor fish can be provided, but must be booked in registration system during registration. If you have a serious food allergy or other health-related dietary limitation, contact the event stewards to

discuss arrangements. If you have to bring your own food, large fridge space will be made available.

New Cut & Thrust Combat Handbook Commentary Request

The Society Marshal, Society Rapier Marshal and Society C&T Deputy are pleased to make available for commentary the approved draft of the new Cut & Thrust Handbook. Commentary will be accepted through March 30, 2026.

This new C&T handbook is part of the ongoing modernization effort, which is updating ALL the marshal handbooks in conjunction with updates to the marshal related sections in Corpora. The goal is to better reflect the current structure, culture, and safety best practices we use today in our SCA martial activities.

One of the most significant changes is the modernized format, designed for easy online access and usability. With clearer layout, improved navigation, and consistency across all marshal handbooks, this new format makes it easier for both newcomers and experienced participants to find the information they need quickly and confidently.

The new online Cut & Thrust Combat handbook and supporting material can be found at https://society-rules.fullmesh.co.nz/index.php/Main_Page. Also available at this site:

- A PDF version of the proposed new handbook
- Cliff notes on the C&T Handbook, with a summary of the changes
- A FAQ on the overall rules moderation process, the new handbooks and format

Important Dates: Similar to the new Rapier Combat Handbook, a multi-month process is being used to improve communication and transparency. The timeline is aligned with the current ongoing Rapier Handbook commentary and approval process, so that both handbooks will enter their final form and approval at the same time.

The timeline is:

- Feb 2 thru March 30: C&T Combat Handbook is open for commentary. This version has been approved by the BoD for commentary for 60 days.
- March – April: Updates to the handbook will be developed based on the commentary.
- April 1: New handbook with updates resulting from received commentary will be submitted to the BoD for final review and approval.
- May 20: Both the new C&T and Rapier Combat handbooks will be in effect (if approved during the April BoD meeting).

Please email all commentary to marshal@sca.org and rapier@sca.org, and use the title “New C&T Handbook – commentary” in the subject line. CC'ing your Kingdom Rapier/C&T/Fencing Marshal is highly recommended.

Most of the content is shared between the Rapier and Cut and Thrust Handbooks. If you have already provided feedback on the Rapier Handbook, and your comments are not specific to cut and thrust, you do not need to send your feedback again. Commentary must be received no later than March 30, 2026.
