- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event .
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

## Words of the Heirs

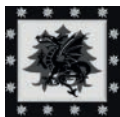
**G**reeting Drachenwald!

### Cudgel War 03 - 12 July 2026 Aarnimetsä - Finland

Cudgel War is the barony of Aarnimetsä's traditional summer camp with outdoor camping and some indoor spaces. Kavalahiti scout camp site is near Inkoo in Southern Finland, only 60 km west of the capital Helsinki. Join us for 10 days (or fewer) of various activities like martial arts, arts and sciences, courts, and of course sauna, swimming, and the white northern nights. Some indoor accommodation and meals are available, but many visitors prefer camping on the meadow or the field

#### Site

Björnvikintie 109, 10230 INKOO AS  
The event is mainly a tent camp. The medieval tents will be on the grassy area in the middle of the camp and on a nearby field. There are forest camping areas for mundane tents on the outskirts of the

camping area. The event also has indoor accommodation in cabins and a dormitory.

The site has drinkable running water and WCs in two outbuildings, but there are no facilities in the indoor accommodation buildings. The showers are in the sauna building by the beach.

The site is built on a hillside which can be challenging for people with reduced mobility. The disabled toilet is located behind the kitchen, about 200 meters from the indoor sleeping space, and the route includes a slope. The only way to get to the showers is to navigate the sauna stairs, and all the paths are gravel, not paved.

The site opens at 14:00 and closes at 12:00

#### Cost

Site fee is paid for every day you attend. On top of that, you can choose to buy meals and indoor accommodation as long as they are available

Site and meal fees are based on the participant's age in the following manner:

- Adults: 14 years and over, site fee 10,00 €/day
- Kids 4-13 year olds, site fee 7,00 €/day
- Babies and toddlers under 4 attend for free

Day visit, no meals, no accommodations, members and non-members: 10,00 €. Indoor accommodation: 6,00 €/night (same price for everyone).

Transport fee Karjaa-Kavalahiti or Kavalahiti-Karjaa, only available for visitors from other countries with advance reservation: 10,00 €/one way/person.

- Brunch, kid: 3,00 €
- Dinner, adult: 6,00 €
- Dinner, kid: 4,00 €
- Wednesday Banquet, adult: 15,00 €

## In Memory of Baroness Alfhild de Foxley



**A**lfhild was eighteen when she found the SCA, and went to her first event: Double Wars in 2006. She was full of energy and wanted to try everything, right away. With unbridled enthusiasm, she threw herself into all that the SCA had to offer: historical clothing, all textile crafts, archery, calligraphy and illumination, medieval cooking, autocrating events...yes, everything.

Alfhild's great love in the society was Arts and Sciences, and it was in this area that her commitment and work had the clearest impact on Nordmark, on Drachenwald, and on the SCA in general.

She was a person who took on responsibility: among other things, she was Signet clerk for Nordmark and arranged Nordmark's scriptorium several times. Later, she also came to arrange Drachenwald events, such as Kingdom University, both in person, and online. She was deputy university chancellor for Drachenwald, with responsibility for the Online Kingdom University for several years. One of her last projects was the TriKingdom University Online, which she was also the initiator of. Since 2023 she was also my apprentice, and a good apprentice sister to first Branna and then Petronilla.

Her perception of the SCA was international; she made friends, and collaborated with people both in other parts of Drachenwald and in other kingdoms. She lectured at online events such as the Known World Scribal

Symposium and the Kingdom of Atlantia's Online University, and her research on medieval ink earned the respect of all who heard her lectures and participated in her classes. Together with Kytte of the Lake from Ireland, she held online scribal meetings on Thursdays, and she was always ready to teach everything that had to do with illumination and calligraphy to new people.

Like many young people, Alfhild moved around a lot and thus came to be part of, and contribute to, several different groups in Nordmark, but it was in Gotvik that she found her home and it was here that her impact was greatest. She made us more involved in SCA outside Nordmark, she taught her many skills and she was the autocrat at a large number of events.

She did all this while her illnesses were getting worse, while she lived with a chronic pain and fatigue that most of us can't even imagine. She did it out of love: Because Alfhild loved Gotvik, loved Nordmark, Drachenwald and SCA and she loved the Dream!

But Alfhild was also Mattias', Baron Matti's, beloved wife, and an important person in the lives of his four children, a good friend to me and to others, also outside SCA. She is irreplaceable, and deeply, deeply missed.

# Curia decision

After consulting two Curias (on May 19th and May 28th 2025), Their Royal Majesties, King Tuomas and King Gilbert have made the following changes to the Kingdom Law.

## CHANGE 1 – ADDITION OF DEIB OFFICER AS GREAT OFFICER OF THE KINGDOM

5.01.1 The Great Officers of the Kingdom of Drachenwald are as follows:

- Kingdom Seneschal
- Kingdom Herald (Schwarzdrachen)
- Kingdom Earl Marshal
- Kingdom Minister of Arts and Sciences
- Kingdom Chancellor of the Exchequer
- Kingdom Chronicler
- Kingdom Signet Clerk
- Kingdom Web Minister
- Kingdom Chatelaine
- Kingdom DEIB (Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging) Officer*

5.04.1.1 The terms of office for Kingdom officers begin on the following dates:

- The Monday after Twelfth Night Coronation (on odd numbered years Gregorian)
  - University Chancellor
  - Web Minister
- The Monday after Midsummer Coronation (on odd numbered years Gregorian)
  - Seneschal
  - Chronicler
  - Social Media Officer
  - Marshal of Fence
- The Monday after Twelfth Night Coronation (even numbered years Gregorian)
  - Minister of Arts and Sciences
  - Earl Marshal
  - Signet Clerk
  - Chatelaine
- The Monday after Midsummer Coronation (even numbered years Gregorian)
  - Herald
  - Chancellor of the Exchequer
  - Captain-General of Archers
  - *DEIB Officer*

*5.06.10 DEIB Officer (Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging)*

*5.06.10.1 Shall develop, implement, and maintain a kingdom-wide DEIB strategy.*

*5.06.10.2 Shall advise the Crown, Kingdom officers, and local groups on DEIB issues, including reviewing policies for inclusivity.*

*5.06.10.3 Shall deliver or promote training to improve understanding of inclusion issues.*

*5.06.10.4 Shall monitor, report, and respond to concerns related to discrimination, bias, or harassment.*

*5.06.10.5 Shall actively work to ensure all members have equal access to opportunities and feel valued.*

*5.06.10.6 Shall work with the Society DEIB Officer, other kingdom officers (such as Chatelaines), and local groups to align efforts.*

## CHANGE 2 – CLARIFICATION TO ARBITRATION PROCEDURES

12.02.1.2.4.2 The Crown and the Kingdom Seneschal will send a list of three potential arbitrators to the involved parties within thirty days of receipt of the Petition. The Crown and the Kingdom Seneschal will take language and regional familiarity into consideration when selecting the initial group of potential arbitrators.

12.02.1.2.4.2.1 The Kingdom Seneschal will be responsible for *identifying at least 3 potential arbitrators appropriate to the situation and approved by the Crown.* ~~maintaining a pool of potential arbitrators.~~

12.02.1.2.4.2.2 Any arbitrator may disqualify him/herself from participation at any time without prejudice.

12.02.1.2.4.2.3 All arbitrators must volunteer in writing, be at least 21 years of age, be a paid member of the SCA, be a resident of Drachenwald for at least one year, and be armigerous.

12.02.1.2.4.3 Under the supervision of the Kingdom Seneschal the parties may, if they wish, eliminate one arbitrator each until one arbitrator is left. If an arbitrator is not agreed upon within thirty days, the Crown will select one of the identified candidates. ~~from the pool.~~

12.02.1.2.4.2.4 *All arbitrators must agree to keep the details of the Petition(s) and any subsequent discussions or investigations in confidence, sharing such information only with the affected parties, the Kingdom Seneschal, and the Crown – as well as any civil authorities as applicable.*

## CHANGE 3 – GLOSSARY UPDATES

1:05 Definitions of some terms used in Drachenwald law

1:05.1 Written, in writing: communications sent either by postal mail or electronic mail:

### GLOSSARY

In this document, the following terms, listed in alphabetical order, are used with the meanings given below:

**Affiliate:** *An official organization formally recognized in a modern (civil) jurisdiction, and with a signed affiliation agreement with SCA Inc, that holds them to be equivalent to SCA Inc within that jurisdiction. The most common example is membership reciprocity, in that an Affiliate member is considered to be an SCA member and vice versa.*

**Arbitrator:** *An independent and unbiased individual accepted by two disputing parties, responsible for investigating and attempting to resolve that dispute.*

**Armigerous award:** An award that can convey Arms by Award, Grant, or Patent.

**Board:** The Board of Directors of the SCA, Inc.

**By-Laws:** The By-Laws of the SCA, Inc., or its equivalent in an affiliated organization.

**Consort:** The person for whom the combatant fights in a Royal List.

**Coronet:** The Sovereign and Consort of a Principality, acting together.

**Corpora:** The policies governing historical re-creation within the Society, and those policies applicable to the entire Society.

**Crown:** The Sovereign and Consort of a Kingdom, acting together.

**Curia:** A council of the Crown that must be consulted in order to make, delete, or amend Kingdom law: Those who hold a seat in this council are defined in this law.

*DEIB: Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging.*

**Fealty:** A reciprocal promise to be loyal to somebody and show them your support, especially a territorial ruler aka liege.

**Governing documents:** The Organizational Handbook, which contains: The Introduction, Corpora, The Articles of Incorporation of the SCA, Inc., the By-Laws of the SCA, Inc., the Corporate Policies of the SCA, Inc., and any amendments and appendices.

*Landed nobility: A generic term to refer to all persons who hold the offices of Sovereign or Consort of a Kingdom or Principality (i.e. Royalty), and Territorial Baronials.*

**Officer:** A Society member serving in an appointed office as defined in Corpora, or as an appointed deputy in such an office, or in another office as may be defined by Kingdom Law, at any level of the Society, or in the role of organizer of a Society event (commonly referred to as “event steward”, also known as “autocrat”), or as a Territorial Baron or Baroness, or as Crown or Coronet or heir to a Crown or Coronet.

*Note that officers who hold positions mandated by Corpora or Kingdom Law are considered “warranted” and must be formally recognized per procedures defined herein.*

*Other officers may be designated at the discretion of a branch or landed nobility, but are not considered “warranted” - they simply serve at the discretion of whoever appointed them.*

**Official event:** An obsolete term for a published event.

**Peerage:** Collectively, the members of the populace who hold a patent of arms. Any person holding a patent is a peer.

**Period:** The era used by the Society as the base for its re-creation activities. The Society is based on the life and culture of the landed nobility of pre-17th Century, focusing on the Middle Ages and the Renaissance.

**Published event:** A Society event that also fulfills the requirements of Section II.C of the Corpora. These are the events where all manner of court business may be conducted, *as well as Royal Lists and Curiae.*

**Quorum:** The smallest number of people who must be at a meeting before it can begin or decisions can be made.

**Redress:** To correct something that is unfair or wrong.

**Royal Heirs:** The victor in the Royal List and the victor’s consort for the period between the victory and the Coronation (Kingdom) or Investiture (Principality).

**Royal Lists:** Properly constituted armored combat tournaments to determine the successors to current royalty. They are known as “Crown Lists” for Kingdoms, and “Coronet Lists” for Principalities.

**Royal Peer:** An individual who has reigned as Sovereign or Consort of a Kingdom or a Principality is referred to as a Royal Peer.

**Royalty:** The persons who hold the offices of Sovereign or Consort of a Kingdom or Principality. The heirs to those positions are also considered royal, but Corpora uses the terms “royalty” and “reigning royalty” interchangeably, and only to refer to Sovereigns and Consorts.

**SCA, Inc. or SCA:** The Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc., a California nonprofit (or not-for-profit) corporation

~~SCA, Inc. Waiver Card: A card which indicates that a properly executed waiver is on file at the corporate office. This card may also contain membership information.~~

**Society:** The entirety of the Society for Creative Anachronism (a worldwide group of affiliated organizations).

**Society event:** An event that fulfills the requirements of Section II.A of the Corpora.

**Society member:** Membership in the Society is defined in the By-Laws of the SCA, Inc., or in the approved organizational documents of any corporation affiliated with the SCA, Inc.

**Sovereign and Consort:** The victor in the Royal List and the victor’s consort, respectively, after their Coronation or Investiture.

**Subject:** Any person who physically resides within the borders of a realm for more than half the year. Those who do not maintain a residence meeting this definition may be considered subjects of the realm where they participate most frequently, if they obtain written acknowledgment from the royalty of that realm. Those who participate in Society activities primarily in a realm other than the one where they reside may be considered subjects of that realm if they obtain written permission and acknowledgment from the royalty of both realms. Decisions of the Coronet in such matters depend upon the approval of the Crown.
