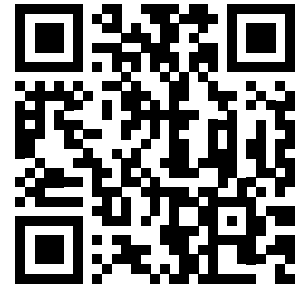

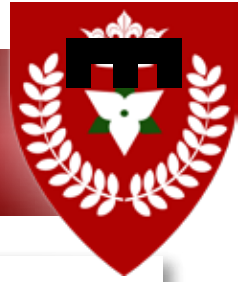

PROPOSED LAW CHANGES

ARTICLE III - Succession of the Crown

III-301 Those who shall preside over the Crown Tourney as Sovereign and Consort, may choose to waive the entrance requirements as set out in Articles III-503, III-504, III-600, and III-700, for ~~any all individual candidates whom They deem worthy.~~ **as a matter of equity, what you waive for one prospective combatant and consort, you must waive for all.**

ARTICLE IX - Lawspeaker of Ealdormere

IX-802 **Under the direction of the Kingdom Seneschal**, the Lawspeaker shall investigate concerns brought before them and mediate disputes as required. ~~In the event of a conflict of interest, the Lawspeaker may appoint a mutually acceptable mediator in their stead.~~

~~IX-803 The Lawspeaker shall administer and chair Courts of Inquiry following the guidelines detailed in the Kingdom Operating Policy, Section Four - Courts of Justice.~~

ARTICLE XIV - Rights of the Subjects

XIV-300 Any subject of Ealdormere may ask the **Kingdom Seneschal Lawspeaker** to investigate and mediate disputes within the Kingdom. **The Kingdom Seneschal can appoint the Lawspeaker to investigate disputes. A subject of Ealdormere has the right to appeal.** ~~If the Lawspeaker cannot mediate the situation, the Crown shall direct the Lawspeaker to appoint a Court of Inquiry. A subject of Ealdormere under banishment retains this right.~~

ARTICLE XV - Courts of Justice - to be removed

ARTICLE XVI - Financial Accounting and Contracts - Should be in Financial policies not laws

V-200 **The Parliament of Ealdormere Change from Baronial Council of Ealdormere**

V-201. **The Parliament of Ealdormere** is neither a legislative nor an executive body but an advisory council to the Crown. The Territorial Baronial Nobles and **Shire or Province Seneschals of Ealdormere** have both the right and responsibility to advise the Crown on important issues affecting the Realm.

V-202. **The Parliament of Ealdormere** shall consist of the Crown, The Heirs of the Kingdom, the Territorial Baronial Nobles of Ealdormere, and **Shire or Province Seneschals of Ealdormere.**

V-203. The Crown shall endeavour to convene a meeting of the **Parliament of Ealdormere** at least once per reign. Any member of the **Parliament** may, if circumstances warrant, request that the Crown schedule additional meetings.

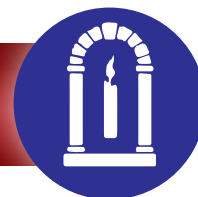
In the void left behind, I am enacting a hostile takeover humbled to attempt to fill such esteemed shoes and ensure everything continues as normal.

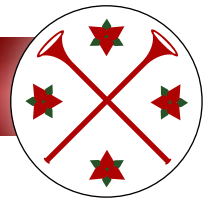
I will provide you with guidance on what has worked best for me, and will be available to assist with running Kingdom A&S.

From the Earl Marshal



Hello from my estates of Hundehugel,

I remind everyone to check your authorizations online (<https://ealdormere.ca/ealdormere-authorizations/>) to be sure that your authorizations are accurate. Take a moment to look at your authorization cards and ensure that you are not expired. If there are issues, please reach out to the MOL (ealdormere.mol@gmail.com) to have those issues corrected.

The new handbook discusses Marshals:

Warranted marshals:

- Have been authorized as a marshal and warranted as an officer of the SCA.
- Can monitor and make decisions about their martial discipline, with designated authorities defined by their kingdom and/or society

Marshal Authorization :

You can only be authorized as a marshal after demonstrating the ability to oversee combat, judge a fighter's authorization, inspect weapons and armor, and showing that you are knowledgeable about the safety and rules of armored combat.

The minimum requirements for passing a marshal's authorization must include the following:

- a. You must have a good working knowledge of the Rules of the Lists, the conventions of armored combat, and any additional kingdom rules or conventions.
- b. You must be willing to enforce the Rules of the Lists, the conventions of armored combat, and any additional kingdom rules or conventions.
- c. You must have a good working knowledge of the Society minimum armor and weapons standards and any additional kingdom armor and weapons standards.
- d. You must demonstrate the ability to conduct an inspection of armor and weapons for use in combat.
- e. You must demonstrate the ability to conduct an inspection of combatants.
- f. You must demonstrate the ability to safely control armored combat, whether this is single combat, team combat, general melee, or battle environment.

You must maintain current knowledge of the Rules of the Lists, the conventions of armored combat, and any additional kingdom rules or conventions, as they change or are updated.

From the Kingdom Target Archery Marshal



Greetings!

In 1987, my brother took up archery at the University of Waterloo and periodically dragged me along. Even-tually this led me to joining the other group that all the archers belonged to.

I have done a great many things in the SCA, but archery has always been a constant. I have never been a "top tier" archer, but I was on the Pennsic champions team once, and I have been an archery marshal since Ealdormere was a principality.

I have enjoyed working on the youth tournament at Pennsic, and many specialty shoots closer to home (ask me sometime about the Monadh Yule shoot featuring the labours of Hercules including a 15 yard "clout", a charging lion, centaurs with snowballs, and a Medusa shoot where you couldn't look at the target -- only at its reflection in a mirror). I've also enjoyed playing with the atlatl since Mistress Etaoin first introduced them to the principality and hope to bring back her Atlatl battles.

Archery has been less prominent in Ealdormere since the pandemic, but with the continued efforts of the Yeomen of the Wolf, the new Order of the Mark, and Their Majesties making Royal Rounds part of their Grand Tournament, I have high hopes in reaching new targets for archery.

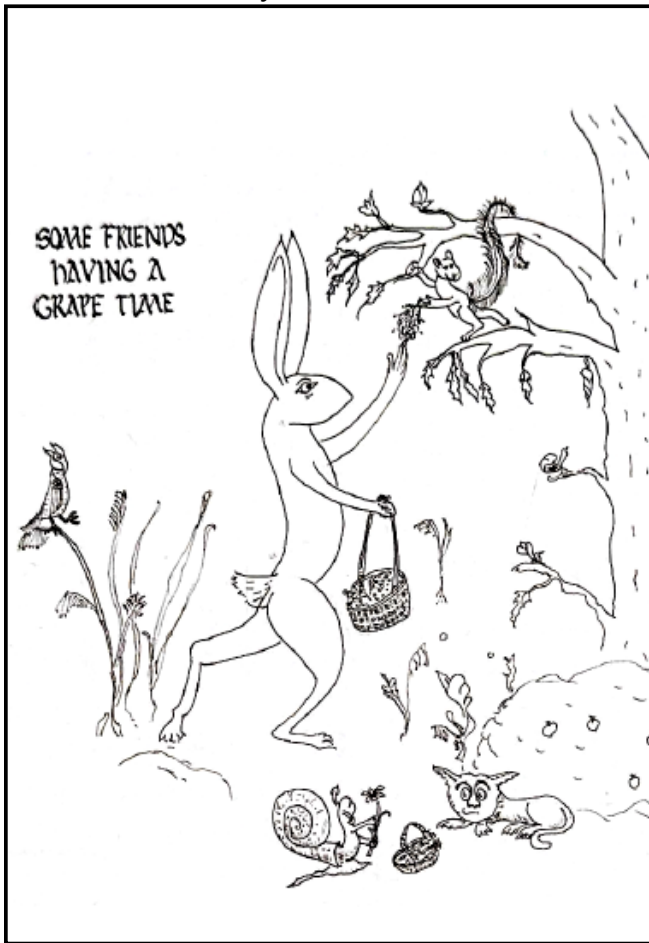

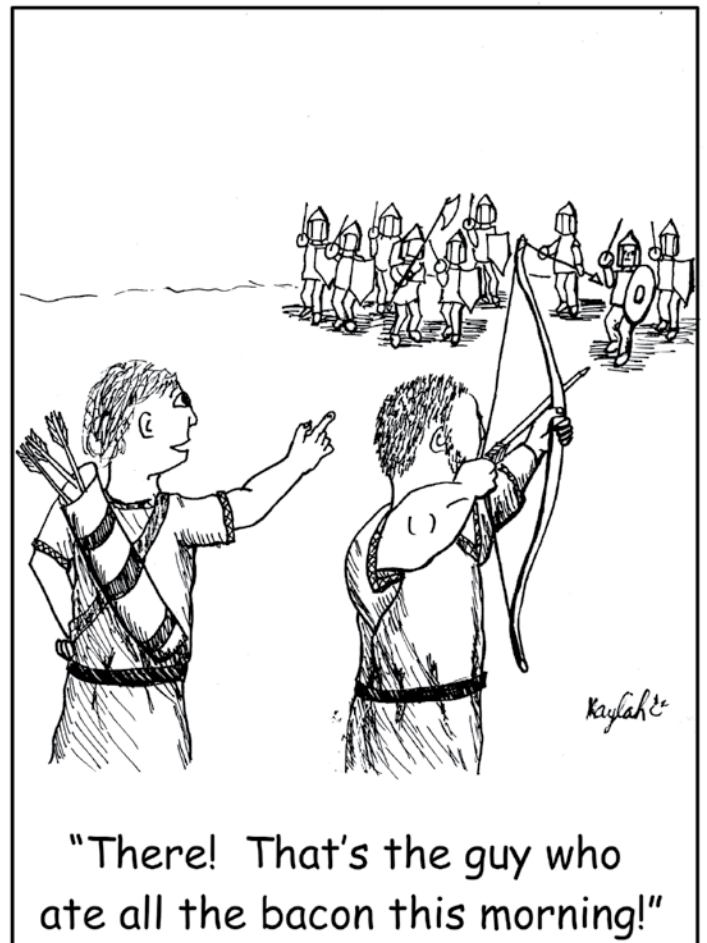
