From the Kingdom Webwright



Greetings populace of Lochac

This is an unofficial conversation, even though I'm starting it in my role as Lochac Webwright. This will appear on different platforms to reach a wider audience.

Firstly, let's talk about you.

How do you (best) engage in communication with Lochac, its groups, and the SCA in general? Do you go to websites directly? Start on social media? Follow a mailing list? Do you prefer being off-line and mostly find things out at events (I say mostly because clearly, you're reading this ...)? All the above perhaps? How 'in touch' do you feel? How could this be improved? Do you volunteer to help your local group (hold office)? What is it about holding office that interests you, or makes you run away if you're not interested?

Now, let's talk about us.

Which of the following does your local group have? (Chronicler, Webwright, Social Media Officer) Does your group have a mailing list or newsletter separate from the website and/or social media page? Who looks after it? Are calls for volunteers to manage these things (officers) being seen by you, and are these calls enticing or do they make you want to ignore it? How much work does it seem like the Chronicler/ Webwright/Social Media Officer does? How much do you think needs doing to do the role? What about the same for any Guilds or SCA interest groups you might be part of?

Finally, let's talk about the task.

Communication is an interesting beast these days. There are so many ways to get information



out – and they sometimes overlap but also sometimes need a completely different way of thinking. Static webpages don't work the same as a social media post. Social media management is more than just putting out updates (like a newsletter might). Mailing lists ... how often are they used, and by who? This is going out on the Shambles ... but when was the last message there that wasn't just a forward from Announce?

The SCA has been around for 60 years, and Lochac for 40 years. Back then there was no Internet. Newsletters MATTERED if you couldn't get to events, and they were posted in the mail! Going to events MATTERED to be involved. While the Internet gave us better communication methods, it also gave us the ability to be involved without leaving home. A few years ago, we were even forced to learn new ways to stay involved without being in person ... and anecdotally it seems that some have found that's as good as they need, especially when events are getting more expensive while incomes haven't necessarily improved in line.

Now, when we're not reminded often (when we're involved in person) it's easy to forget that we need volunteers to hold the offices that make the Society work. The ubiquity of social media, and the ease of adding our own content personally, can lead to forgetting that managing content and communication for an organisation needs someone to do it. So how do we make the most of the limited resources (active volunteers) we have so that we can ensure that communication happens effectively? Is it still fit-for-purpose to have a Chronicler, Webwright, and Social Media Officer as three separate roles? Yes, they have different skill sets, but they can be learned ... and there are tools available to help a webwright format a news update section, or a chronicler to turn emails into posts that can be forwarded to social media (and vice versa). If we were to suggest combining roles, what should the role be?

The impetus for starting this conversation was a flash of inspiration that communication in the SCA is a bit like the triple-aspects of Fate. Clotho (the young aspect would be Social Media Officer), Lachesis (the middle-aged aspect would be webwright), and Atropos (as the aged aspect would be Chronicler). I mean this in the sense that they each have their distinct roles but operate as one function: fate. In Piers Anthony's Incarnations of Immortality series, they even share one body but take turns in control depending on what role is needed. I trust that the analogy speaks for itself. Is a sisterhood of separate roles still fit-for-purpose, or is a single body (office) more efficient in this case?

I am interested in views. Please email me at webwright@lochac.sca.org with "communications conversation" in the subject. This is not setting policy – I can and may eventually recommend changes if that seems to be the prevailing opinion, but Corpora and Kingdom Law do not bend to my will (and neither should it). Please share your thoughts, feelings, and opinions on communication in Lochac – using the above as stimulus, not a prescriptive list of questions. This kingdom – and it's wide (geographic) stretches – needs to give time and attention to communication more than most groups, I would suggest. Thank you in advance if you do reply.

Greetings!

Now that A.S. LX is behind us, I am delighted to be able to announce the A.S. LXI Arts and Sciences Champion for Lochac.

Each year, the championship is awarded to the person with the highest cumulative score across the four competitions of the previous year. If they enter a competition more than once, their highest score for that round is counted. Thus, the championship rewards both excellence and enthusiasm.

The token of the Championship is a blue pouch, embroidered with the insignia of the Arts and Sciences. Each Champion is encouraged to obtain a pouch suitable to their needs and persona.

Before we get to the announcement, however, I would like to mention some of the many entrants who lit up the competitions in A.S. 60.

Our judging rubric is designed to challenge even Laurels in their areas of expertise, so a score above seventy (out of one hundred) is always worthy of acclaim. An honourable mention must go to Master Crispin Sexi, who entered every round and earned a total of 306 points. This was more than thirty points above any of the remaining entrants, but not enough to earn a placing... The third-highest total score, this past year, was achieved by Mestrez Ysabeau Chanteuse, who gained 348 points across all four rounds. The second-highest achievement was THL Adeline de Montfort, who earned 364 points, also entering every round.

...and now we come to the Arts and Sciences Champion for A.S 61. The next-highest scores are not many points behind, so it has been a hard-fought challenge again this year.

The incoming Champion has entered every competition round held in the last twelve months, and most of them from a great distance - a mighty effort. With a score totalling 369 points, **our new Champion is THL Melissa Wijffels, of Ildhafn**, in the Crescent Isles!

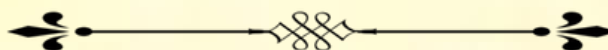

The Australian Board of Directors is pleased to advertise the position of Deputy Youth Compliance Officer.

Position Description:

Deputy Youth Compliance Officer (Deputy to the Kingdom Youth Officer – Lochac)
Purpose of the Role-The Deputy Youth Compliance Officer supports the Kingdom Youth Officer and/or Kingdom Seneschal by overseeing youth-related compliance matters within Lochac, with a particular focus on Australian (Terra Rosa) legal and regulatory requirements. The role exists to ensure that youth activities within the Society comply with both SCA policy and relevant state and territory child protection laws. This is an administrative and advisory role. It does not involve direct supervision of youth at events.

Key Responsibilities:

Youth Authorisation Administration Process

and maintain Youth Authorisation Cards for members in accordance with Kingdom Youth and Child Protection policies. Review submitted documentation for completeness, accuracy, and compliance. Maintain secure and confidential records relating to youth authorisations. Provide guidance to local officers and members on the Youth Authorisation process when required.

Working With Children Check:

(WWCC) Compliance Monitor Working With Children Check (WWCC) requirements across Australian states and territories. Maintain records of WWCC numbers, expiry dates, and applicable jurisdictions for relevant officers and volunteers. Ensure WWCCs are registered or verified with the appropriate state or territory government departments, where required. Provide reminders and guidance regarding renewals and ongoing compliance obligations. Legislative and Regulatory Monitoring Monitor changes to state and territory child protection legislation relevant to SCA activities in

Australian (Terra Rosa). Advise the Kingdom Seneschal, Kingdom Youth Officer, and/or Kingdom Officers of any changes that may impact policy or practice. Assist in interpreting how legislative changes intersect with SCA policies and procedures.

Provide compliance advice to Kingdom and Baronial officers on youth-related matters. Escalate any compliance concerns or identified risks promptly to the appropriate Kingdom officer. Assist with periodic reporting as required by Kingdom Youth or Seneschalate structures.

Skills and Attributes:

Strong attention to detail and record-keeping skills Ability to handle confidential and sensitive information appropriately Familiarity with Australian child protection frameworks (or willingness to learn) Clear written

communication skills Ability to work collaboratively with Kingdom and local officers Comfortable working within policy-driven and compliance-focused environments

Eligibility Requirements -Current member in good standing Holds (or is willing to obtain) a valid Working With Children Check for their state or territory Willingness to comply with SCA Youth and Child Protection policies Ability to commit to the administrative workload of the role

Time Commitment- Low to moderate, variable throughout the year Peaks around event seasons, officer changes, and policy updates Reporting Line Reports to the Kingdom Youth Officer and/or Kingdom Seneschal, as determined by Kingdom structure.

The Board signed off on the Affiliation agreement with SCA Inc in America in July. Many thanks to the previous Board Chair, Tam Hovenga, for all their hard work preparing this. I had many fruitful emails with the President of SCA Inc, as it made its way through the US BoD.

The Board ratified a Grant Fact sheet- <https://sca.org.au/documents/policy/grantfactsheet/> for groups looking for applying to community grants. This is available on the Board website (sca.org.au/board).

Our Child Protection Policy was updated and improved. Many thanks to Lady Thalia Brasse for her very hard work compiling updated Child Protection policies (<https://sca.org.au/documents/policy/children/>). These will be available on the Board website (sca.org.au/board) for anyone who wishes to read them. This has been a significant effort, as our policy has to fit in with different legislative requirements for every state. The Board has recently advertised to fill the role of Youth Authorisation Officer.

My gratitude also goes to the hard working folk on the Alternate Crown Working Group, who have accomplished miracles.

The Board is in the process of revising the Companion Card Policy after consultation with the Populace.

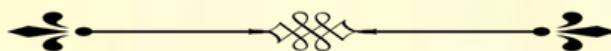
The Social Media policy has seen significant revision thanks to our Kingdom Social Media Officer, Isabella Miller. Once again we sought input from the Populace.

Craig (Yevan) Hutchinson has been working to bring the possibility of using Siege Legal weapons to the shores of Terra Rosa. The main hurdle to overcome is Insurance. The Siege book is written for US laws, which are more lax than Australian laws. Another problem is different laws for different states. The process continues.

In January 2026, Section VII.A.2 of Corpora was amended to include Chatelaine and DEIB as Kingdom Great Offices. The Kingdom of Lochac is bound by our corporate agreements to follow the requirements of Corpora. The Board of SCA Limited Australia (SCA Ltd Australia) has been working on our DEIB policy and procedures for some time. Our preferred option involves the establishment of an Australian Office of Inclusive Programs, reporting directly to SCA Ltd Australia. We believe that having a corporate Australian group will achieve better results than having a single "game-facing" person attempting to straddle the legal responsibilities and requirements of two separate countries. I have recently written to the President of SCA Inc putting forward this representation.

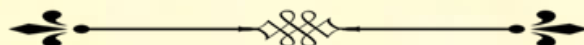

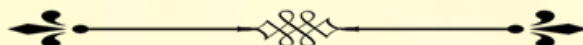

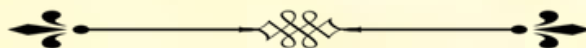
