And, as at least a few of you learned when you reported, we altered the Quarterly Report forms to make them a little better. This is still not their final evolution, but it's better. (Need help with your evolutions? Contact - [support@pokemon](mailto:support@pokemon) - just kidding.)

The office of the Kingdom Webminister is responsible not only for the website, but also for email addresses attached to the domain. We have created email addresses for each officer across the Kingdom, and each of them should be using those email addresses. ## **Northshield Open Position Descriptions**

### **NORTHWATCH EDITOR - POSITION DESCRIPTION**

The Editor of the *Northwatch*, is a Kingdom Lesser Officer reporting to the Kingdom Chronicler. This individual is responsible for publication of the Kingdom Newsletter, *Northwatch*, on a monthly basis and compliant with Kingdom and Society policies related to publication. This position requires strong communication, teamwork, and time management skills.

Deliverables and Deadlines:

- Communicate deadlines to the Stallari council and the populace
- Prepare a draft of the *Northwatch* for review by the Stallari council and editors each month
- Ensure accuracy of information in the Kingdom newsletter
- Maintain any relevant waiver forms, including artist release forms and video waivers, as needed
- Ensure requisite information is published in a timely manner to remain compliant with Kingdom law. This includes event ads, calendar updates, job descriptions, court reports, and law changes/commentary.
- Submit properly formatted newsletter to the Society by the 10th of the month preceding publication.

Time Commitment:

This position will require about 10 hours per month to prepare, review, and compile information for the newsletter and disseminate to applicable parties.

Requirements:

- Dependable email access
- Reliable computer for word processing and Adobe usage.

The Kingdom uses Adobe InDesign to create the newsletter

- Ability to clearly communicate verbally and in writing, i.e. in person and via email, phone, and in written reports
- Working knowledge of relevant procedures and processes
- Dependable social media access is nice to have but not required

Excellent verbal and written communication skills. Able to respond in a timely fashion to questions and concerns.

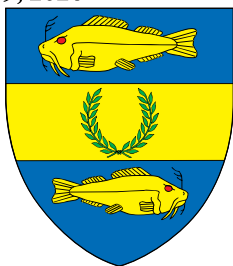

#### **Explanation of odd stuff on the list:**

- **Sharpie, Super glue, Bootstrings, White cotton fabric** – Trust me, these things will come in handy in ways you never fathomed.
- **Electrical tape** – even better than moleskin for blisters! Cover the blister or irritated area with a band-aid, then a layer of electrical tape.
- **Emergen-C** – a powdered multi-vitamin drink – good for dehydration or as a hangover preventative.
- **Vicks Vaporub** – can be used for congestion as intended, or as a muscle rub, or to stop itching from bug bites. Carmex can also help with itchy bug bites.
- **Florajen** – acidophilus – this is a capsule that contains lots of the bacteria found in yogurt. If you take it when traveling, you are less likely to get sick from Pennsic Plague or other gastrointestinal complaints.
- **Disposable cutting boards** – these are a wonderful invention! The cutting boards are essentially heavy wax paper with a plastic lining – use them once and then throw the yuck away! (This is particularly good for chicken and other meats.)
- **Disposable scrubbies** – also a great idea – thick fiber pads with a scrubby size and a soft side and soap on the inside – use them to wash the dishes and wipe down tables, then throw away.
- **Bitty cups/Taster cups** – one of the most dangerous phrases in the SCA is “here, try this!” Having a bitty cup in hand to receive a small taste before offering your ginormous mug can be a lifesaver.

#### **Notes:**

- If you are camping, try to arrange your travel so you arrive in daylight. Do a test set-up of your tent at home before you go – there is nothing worse than setting up a new tent in the dark. If you try to do so, it will rain.

- Do maintenance on the car (oil change, check tires, etc.) BEFORE you leave
- You need a special form for car insurance in Canada. Most insurance plans can provide it at no or little cost but make sure to order it in advance.
- For long events, arrange for pet care, someone to at least check on the house/apartment, and have the mail and newspapers stopped or forwarded.
- You may want to construct a set-up kit that includes all the things you'll need (or may want) as soon as you hit site. Pack it on top or in between the front seats so it stays accessible throughout the trip. A possible list of things (either from above or a second set) to go in this box include:
