- **Registration**• Member & non-Member for event, with deadlines (for pre-registration as necessary. If there is a Registration for the event, the following statement must be included beneath the \$ amounts: "Make checks payable to SCA, Inc./(group name)." If the event is free, say so!
- **Activities**• Brief synopsis of event—fighting, arts & sciences, merchants, et cetera.
- **Site Restrictions**—wet or dry, no animals, no smoking, et cetera.
- **Accessibility**—handicap parking & entrance/exit ramps, uneven terrain, et cetera.
- **Duration**• Start and stop time of the event.





Turn right on Harmony Road / Rte 16. Go to Detour Rd. about 1.5 miles and turn left onto Detour Rd. The 4-H park is well marked and on the right.


