

THE SCA PROHIBITS HARASSMANT AND BULYING OF ALL INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS.

The SCA prohibits bullying and harassment of all individuals and groups. Bullying is systematic and unwelcome behavior which involves the use of influence, threat, intimidation, or coercion to cause hurt or harm to another person or group of people. When the bullying behavior is based on a protected class (1), that behavior is defined as harassment.

(1) race, sex, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, or disability.

Bullying and Harassment may be **overt**, as in the following non-inclusive list of examples:

- Verbal abuse, including using racial, homophobic, transphobic, ableist epithets, etc.
- Non-consensual physical contact, violence, or threatening gestures.
- Displaying material that is offensive, degrading, or threatening to a protected class.
- Consistent demeaning remarks or malicious teasing -Stalking or predatory behavior

Covert:

- Spreading rumors or innuendo with malicious intent
- Deliberate exclusion, isolation, or alienation of an individual without just cause
- Using rank, title, or office to intimidate others

Provided that the behavior does not rise to the criteria listed above, bullying and harassment is not:

- Single episodes of social rejection, dislike, tactlessness, or forgetfulness.
- Mutual arguments, disagreements, or fights.
- The termination, mutual or not, of a romantic relationship or friendship.
- Reasonable constructive feedback or critique.

The test for bullying is the reasonableness of the behavior and the impact of that behavior on the recipient. Participants engaging in bullying/harassment are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual believes they have been subjected to or have witnessed harassment, bullying, or retaliation, that person should contact a seneschal, the President of the SCA, or that kingdom's Board Ombudsman.



Æthelmearc Moneyers Guild

"Weighty is the hammer, swift and melodic the strike!" - Some Guy in a Hat

It's Pennsic 52, Tuesday of war week. The heat is starting to surge again after a cool weekend brought to us by the grace of rainstorms late in peace week. Æthelmearc Royal Court is underway. I can't be there, but I'm watching the stream online. I had an idea of what was going to happen, but not exactly when or how. Then Their Majesties called forth the Æthelmearc Moneyers Guild. This was it.

"We've been talking with your guildmistress," King Murdoch began, "and we'd like to request a commission: ten thousand coins for next Pennsic."Ten thousand!

As it turns out, we wouldn't be the first to attempt such a huge endeavor. Four thousand were struck for the Middle Kingdom's 50th anniversary, and twelve thousand for SCA 50 Year. But even these were small compared to the last Pennsic coin made by a kingdom. "I did a similar project for Pennsic where we made 13.5k ish," Master Derian le Breton estimates.

"We were doing 1/2" Anglo-Saxon coins and the obverse design was a dragon. Derian and Rütger were the best engravers at the time which is why they did those and they would

have a pretty consistent look," Meister Konrad Mailander adds. "The reverse design was simpler so more of the newer moneyers were confident they could do it."

Derian and Konrad were both involved in several large moneying projects, but they were hardly the only ones. "In that case we had something like seven moneyers around the kingdom. Some did as little as a pound while others did thousands," Derian says. In other kingdoms, moneying had been around for a while. Not so much in Æthelmearc. Our Guild was chartered just in AS 52, a mere 8 years ago. Despite being such a young group with so few members, we were doing our best to make as many coins as we could at every opportunity. But this would be a whole new level.

Praetoria Aurelia Argentina Prima and Master Clewin Kupferhelbelinc were the only two moneyers present when the crown called them forth. "When his majesty said he'd been talking to our guild mistress about a big project my first thought was 'Oohhh no. What has she done?!" says Prima. "And when he told me what it was, I was relieved. I knew the Guild was more than capable of pulling that off." Master Clewin's reaction was a bit more to the point. "My first thought: 'Wow, that is a lot of coins.' I also thought His Majes-

ty suddenly just put the Moneyers Guild in front and center, and we had to work as a group to do this." And he wasn't wrong.

Rüdiger the Moneyer has been involved with most of the big moneying projects in the Known

World. In his opinion, ten thousand isn't unachievable. "If you've got the population absolutely," he says. Even if the core group is small, people can contribute easily and many hands makes for light work. "Midrealm only had 3 or 4 main moneyers at the time, lots of people who wanted to swing a hammer, and a few people who wanted to start dies. So, sending an obverse and blank coin die with a pile of coin blanks is totally a reasonable expectation." When possible, they got the populace involved. "I think we had 5 major strikers in the project, and the rest was farmed help from classes and events."

The Æthelmearc Moneyers Guild has been centralized in the Barony-Marche of the Debatable Lands, largely by coincidence. We happened to have everything we needed here, which made producing coins easy. But the Guild has always looked to involve more people around the Kingdom. Two years ago, the Guild put together kits for each barony to make their own coins. The kits were popular, but lacked certain equipment that makes striking the coins especially quick, easy, and with good results. Specifically, the bolster.

Bolsters, a sort of anvil made to hold the coin dies, can be made from tree stumps. Unfortunately, the tremendous force involved with striking coins can eventually split the stump. Ideally the bolsters are metal, which is significantly more difficult to acquire than a tree stump. The bolster we use in BMDL is a whopping 80lbs, with holes bored in it to take two different sizes of coin dies. For this project, the Guild decided to make more bolsters that we can distribute around the Kingdom.

But while the logistics of tools, materials, and time are all important factors, what's really important are the people. At that same court that King Murdoch asked us to take on this challenge, Their Majesties inducted the Guild into the Order of the Keystone. One line of the scroll read "But of far greater worth are the guilds people themselves as they rise up to meet each fresh challenge, truly they and their ceaseless Service are the real prize beyond measure."

In the next many months, the Guild will need people. People to house the bolsters we've made, to host monthly striking parties, and to swing hammers. "I struck 6k in four weeks once. It was tough but it is doable," Rüdiger comments. Derian also did a big solo project.

"Before I left the SCA I did a bigger project for my local barony; 15k coins over two years. I had one bottom die and two top dies (also hardened 8620) and did all of the striking myself with various helpers," he says. But Rüdiger emphasizes the value of having lots of people helping with the 13,500 coins they made for Pennsic. "We started the project with plenty of time to the deadline. I definitely wasn't striking the day before to meet the goal, we knew before we left for Pennsic we had it." He continues, "Looking at old posts we started it in January

for August delivery (pennsic war week) by posting the directions first and by the beginning of June we had about 5k. By the

time we posted instructions on where to deliver the coins we knew we were done. So, some rush at the end but nothing crazy."

In some ways, this project is bringing the Guild full circle. The first coin we made for Pennsic.

way back in AS 53, was the memorial coin for Prince Titus. Then, it was about the people, too.

Remembering together, grieving together, and bringing our community together. We hope that

this next Pennsic project will help bring our community together again, just a little more, in our shared pursuit of The Dream.

Because weighty is the hammer, but swift and melodic is the strike!
