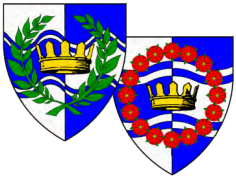

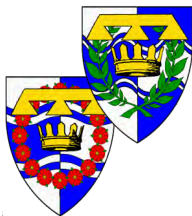

From the South: Use Highway 17 North. Take exit to Highway 58 North. Travel about 8 miles. The Jones County Civic Center is on the left.

From the East: Use Highway 70 West. Take the exit to Highway 17 South. Turn onto Highway 58 North. Travel about 8 miles. The Jones County Civic Center is on the left. (Google maps wants to route onto County Line Road from Have-lock. Beware. I believe that road is a dirt road.)

Directions: From the 21st Century: Use your GPS like the proper Creative Anachronist that you are and enter "3681 Girl Scout Rd, Bennettsville, SC"
From the South: Take your best route to Highway 52 south of Society Hill. Take Hwy. 52 North into Society Hill. In Society Hill, follow Highway 401, NOT Hwy. 52, which bears left. Follow Hwy. 401 straight through Society Hill (Gailey and Lord plant will be on the left as you leave Society Hill). Go 7 miles, look for Hwy. 912. Turn LEFT onto Hwy. 912. Follow Hwy. 912 for 8 miles until it ends at Hwy. 9. Turn LEFT onto Hwy. 9 and then turn RIGHT onto Ebenezer Rd. (You will see a church and a water tower). Follow Ebenezer Rd. for 3 1/2 miles. Sandy Ridge will be on the RIGHT.

From North of Bennettsville: Take your best route to Hwy. 9 near Pageland/Cheraw. Take Hwy. 9 East towards Bennettsville. Look for the water tower on the LEFT of the highway before Bennettsville. Turn LEFT onto Ebenezer Rd (You will see a water tower). Ebenezer United Methodist Church will be on your RIGHT after you turn onto Ebenezer Rd. Follow Ebenezer Rd. for 3 1/2 miles. Sandy Ridge will be on your RIGHT.



24 January 2026 *Highland Hearthglow* *Barony of Highlande Foorde*

Ahlan wa sahan! Highland Hearthglow will return to ThorpeWood on January 24th, 2026. This year we will celebrate the culture of the Golden Age of al-Andalus, taking us to the city of Córdoba around the year 900 CE. This event will focus on the music, poetry, fashion, and of course food, in the context of shared culture among Muslims of both Arab and Amazigh origin, Jews, and Christians living in the Umayyad Caliphate. We will immerse ourselves in two aspects of social culture, both celebrating Id Yanayyir, also called Nayruz, the formerly Roman New Year which was celebrated by everyone in the city. We will be celebrating the Great Minds of al-Andalus throughout the event, especially Ziryab, the great taste-maker of the time.

We will hold a formal Banquet to mark the occasion in our *سلاطون افراح* *Salaat Afrah* – “Hall of Celebrations”) located on the upper floor of the lodge, and the lower floor will be set as our *ساحة السلام* *ahn al-Salām* – “Courtyard of Peace”) which will feature this year’s portrait opportunity and the wide variety of Arts, Sciences, and Diversions Mu’allimah Tala and her team are preparing. Our halls will be filled with performances celebrating al-Andalus, and we will have a full-feature stream for the event with both live content from the event and digital displays from those participating remotely. Use the menus above to explore the content for this event as it develops.

We look forward to welcoming all of the Known World into our hall, in one fashion or another. Until then, *ma’a salama!*

GENERAL ACTIVITIES

A&S: We will present a variety of A&S opportunities, all matching our theme of the Golden Age of al-Andalus including performances, poetry, philosophy, and fashion. More details to follow.

Feast: This year's Highland Hearthglow will feature an expansive, fully documented, all-day feast, which is the primary focus of our event.

Directions: GPS WARNING: The default routes suggested by GPS navigation apps are neither the safest nor easiest ways to get to ThorpeWood. We strongly suggest you follow our detailed directions below. If you do choose to follow your GPS, for your safety please ignore any instruction to make a U-turn from US15 northbound to US15 southbound. Instead, just continue heading north for 3–5 miles. Your GPS will recalculate and direct you to Route 77, a much safer and easier choice.

Directions from Frederick/Baltimore/DC (points South and East): Take Route 15 North towards Gettysburg and Thurmont (from Washington, I-270, this is not truly an exit; continue straight on I-270, which blends into 15 North). Thurmont is about 15 miles northwest of Frederick. There are three Thurmont exits; take the second exit, for Route 77. The exit ramp is a very sharp curve and the deceleration lane is short, so take care here. At the stop sign turn RIGHT onto Route 77 West, towards Hagerstown and Smithsburg. Stay on this windy, climbing road for approximately 2.9 miles, and just after Park Central Road on the right, turn LEFT onto Catocin Hollow Road. At this point, you are entering Cunningham Falls State Park (William Houck Picnic Area) and you will see the lake on your right, through the trees. Continue on Catocin Hollow Road approximately 2.8 miles, pass Wigville Road, and turn RIGHT onto **Mink Farm Road**, a gravel road.

Directions from Harrisburg/Gettysburg (points North): Take Route 15 South to Thurmont. There are three Thurmont exits; take the second exit, for Route 77. At the stop sign at the bottom of the ramp turn Left onto Route 77 West towards Hagerstown and Smithsburg. Stay on this windy, climbing road for approximately 2.9 miles, and just after Park Central Road on the right, turn LEFT onto Catocin Hollow Road. At this point, you are entering Cunningham Falls State Park (William Houck Area) and you will see the lake on your right through the trees. Continue on Catocin Hollow Road approximately 2.8 miles, pass Wigville Road, and turn RIGHT onto **Mink Farm Road**, a gravel road.

Directions from Hagerstown (points West): Travel I-70 East toward Frederick and take Exit 42, turning LEFT at the end of the ramp onto MD Rte 17 North towards Myersville. Follow 0.8 miles and turn right to continue of Rte 17; continue straight at traffic light (Alt. 40). Stay on 17 North for the next approximately 6 miles, turning RIGHT onto Middlepoint Road. Continue up this steep, steep road (1.8 miles) to where it TEES with Tower Road, where you will turn LEFT, traveling for approximately 1/2 mile. Tower makes a hard left BUT you leave Tower at this point by going STRAIGHT which becomes **Milk Farm Road**, a gravel road.

From the clothes they wore to the bags they carried and beyond, fiber arts in all forms played an integral role in a pilgrim's journey. 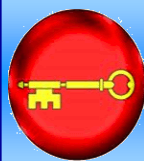
