

Greetings from the Kingdom Exchequer We have two deputy openings coming up that we

need to fill

The first one is the Lilies War Exchequer. This will be an immediate need for LW 2026.

The job of the Lilies War Exchequer involves managing the war's finances, including keeping detailed financial records and updating them quarterly. Key duties include ensuring financial policies are followed, handling receipts, disbursements, and contributions; ensuring all funds are separated from personal accounts; providing financial reports; collaborating with other department heads to manage expenses, and maintaining the accuracy of the war's financial records. This role is central to ensuring the event operates fiscally responsibly and according to SCA rules.

If you have experience as an exchequer, please send a letter of interest to myself at exchequer@calontir.org and the Lilies Chair at Lilieschair@calontir.org. Letters are due by January 10th, 2026.

The second position is the NMR deputy. This person is responsible for collecting NMR from local groups after events. This deputy will step into training in early 2026 and assume the role in 3rd quarter 2026. Please send letter of interest to exchequer@calontir.org by January 10th, 2026.

Society has updated their financial policy. Please note the critical dates and impacts for reporting.

4th Quarter reporting (for 2025)—4th Quarter reports for each entity must be reported to the direct superior officer by **January 31** of the next fiscal year for all branch levels. (for immediate implementation, this means Jan 31, 2026). 4th quarter reports include financial statements equivalent to a general ledger, balance sheet, and income statement, as well as bank statements and reconciliations for October – December.

Kingdom Exchequers will provide all local groups, and entity reports to the Society Chancellor of the Exchequer by February 28. (for immediate implementation, this means Feb 28, 2026). Consolidated reports will be completed and forwarded with all requested supplementary materials by Kingdom Exchequers or their designated deputies to the Corporate Treasurer by the announced deadline, generally **April 1**. (for immediate implementation, this means Apr 1, 2026)

What does this mean for local groups? Typically in the past, it has been hard for the Kingdom to get resolution on outstanding issues once the 4th quarter has been submitted or to even get a full 4th quarter that includes quarterly report, ledger and bank statement.

Society has clearly laid out that the full 4th quarter report with all supporting materials is due by Jan 31st, the Kingdom must be able to final by Feb 28th. This means groups need to be responsive to any and all requests during the month of February from the Kingdom Exchequer and or the Regional.

This will allow the Kingdom Exchequer to complete the consolidated report by April 1 as requested by Society.

Failure to file required reports within 30 days after the end of the reporting deadline may be grounds for suspension or financial probation of the branch/ entity and/or replacement of the Chancellor of the Exchequer.

Local branch exchequers, please make sure your reporting is current and we should be able to meet all reporting deadlines with no consequences to local groups.

Event Flyer Guidelines

For Their Majesties to hold Court and for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in The Mews. Failure to do so means that the Crown cannot hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer, confirm your event with the Reeve. The Mews WILL NOT publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: https://www.calontir.org/calendar/

Editable: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. Work with the Social Media Officer for flyers that may be posted on social media.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1st of the month THREE MONTHS PRIOR to your event. *For Example:* If the event is in November, the flyer must be received by August 1st for the September Mews. Refer to the Calendar at the front of the Mews.

If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period. The deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!

Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

- 1. Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- 2. Day, month, and year of the event
- 3. Site open & close times for populace
- 4. Location of the event—the name of the event site, and full address.
- 5. Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event Steward, including contact phone and email (Needed for emergencies or issues arise)
- 6. Details of Registration—Do NOT use "FEE" as a describer for registration cost.

For Example:

Adult Event Registration: \$25 Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20 Youth (6-17) \$5 Children 5 & Under: FREE
