Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. This can be done by filling in the calendar event date request form on the Kingdom web page: <https://drachenwald.sca.org/events/calendar-add/>. Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web form.

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event.
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

Greetings from the Seneschal

Greetings and salutations, good gentles of Drachenwald!

As many of you know, my initial focus has been "cleaning up" our data on current & former branches in Drachenwald. That included looking at which former branches still had names and heraldry registered with the College of Heraldry. This can be beneficial, if there is a hope the branch may someday be resurrected, but otherwise it just increases the conflict possibilities for future registrations.

After consultation with Their Majesties, Schwarzdrachen Herald, and the appropriate seneschals, we propose the College of Heraldry release the registrations for the below former branches. If anyone has any objections to this proposal, please reach out to me no later than the end of February 2026. We all appreciate this can be a sensitive subject, if someone has a significant personal interest in one of these registrations, and so wanted to ensure this step would not cause undue distress before proceeding further.

Nordmark

- Gawaklint, Shire (Mälardalen) -> territory has been inactive for ~20 years
- Fjathrundaland, Canton (Mälardalen) -> territory was absorbed into Gawaklint
- Liunga, Canton (Linköping) -> territory has been inactive for 25+ years

Insulae Draconis

- Egail, Shire (Edzell, Scotland) -> territory was absorbed into Harpelstane

Knights Crossing

- Emerald Glen, Shire (Augsberg) -> territory was absorbed into Isengau
- Tolling Bells, Canton (Stuttgart) -> name was superseded by "Blauwasser"
- Nebelwald, Stronghold (Grafenwoehr/Vilseck/Hohenfels US military garrisons) -> territory was absorbed into Turmstadt
- Schwarzloch, Stronghold (Ansbach and Illesheim US military garrisons) -> territory was absorbed into Turmstadt

- From the church, turn left onto Hakkeenpääntie
- Drive for about 6 km, turn right to Leikluoto
- 2 km to the Pinonperä bridge and Kahiluoto road to the camp site

Don't believe your navigation system if it says you have arrived before you see the camp site sign on the left side of the road.

Accommodation is in small cottages (8 cottages) with bunk beds (3 bunk beds for six people) and some also have a sofa bed. The beds are already equipped with mattresses, pillows and blankets – no linen! You must bring your own sheets and pillowcases.

The cottages do not have indoor toilets or running water. There is a maintenance building near the cottages with indoor toilets (and showers), a hall and a kitchen. Five of the cottages are close to the main building, three a little further away.

On the shore near the maintenance building there is a (small) sauna with showers. The sauna only has one changing room, a washroom and a steam room, so some of the saunas are mixed saunas. (Although the sauna has been renovated so I'm not sure how it's set up.)

The site is not completely accessible (the yard/walking paths are wooded, there are a lot of bunk beds, the toilets in the main building are small, etc.), but all buildings have some kind of ramps. We take into account the needs of the participants as much as possible, e.g. lower bed, roommates, diets, gender-neutral toilets and showers, sauna shifts, event materials and instructions, lights, etc. so let us know what you need and we'll try to help.

The Site opens to visitors on Friday at 6:00 PM, but it will be available to the organizers from the morning, so let us know if you want to arrive earlier. The site opens at 18:00 and closes at 12:00

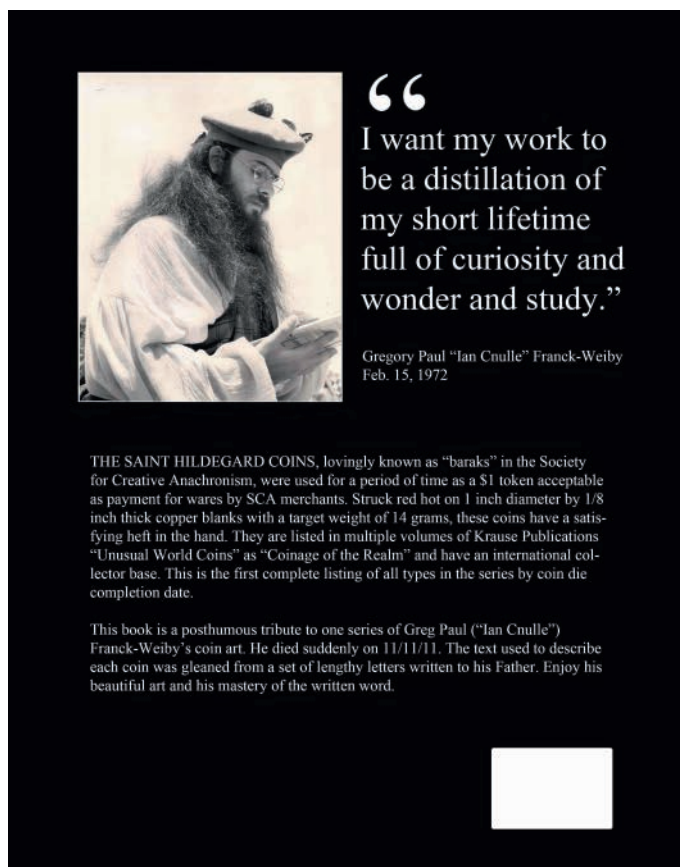
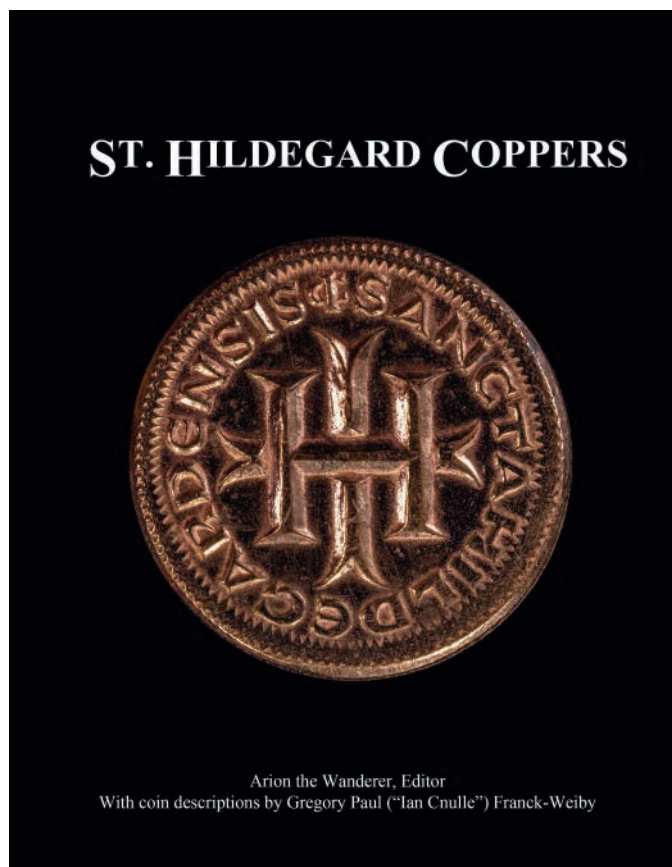
St. Hildegard Coppers

Gregory Paul Franck-Weiby didn't know it was February of A.S. 6 (1972) when he wrote in a letter to his then future in-laws what he wanted his life and art to be. "I want my work to be a distillation of my short lifetime full of curiosity and wonder and study," he said in that letter. He knew he wanted to make coins but for years had to settle for hand drawing and carved linoart imitations. That was the state of his numismatic art until AS 24 (1989), when he walked up to a moneyer at an event somewhere in the U.S. Pacific Northwest Kingdom of An Tir and asked, "How do you do that?"

That first question led to years of study, perfecting his numismatic art, founding the Moneyer's Guild of An Tir and creating an amazing number of tokens, war commemoratives and other SCAdian coins, in addition to adopting his persona of Ian Cnulle. Many called him, simply enough, "the moneyer dude." Of all his work, Cnulle probably is best known in the SCA for the 1-inch diameter, 3/32-inch thick copper trade tokens called the St. Hildegard coppers but there has never been a single source of information about those coppers. Until now.

"St. Hildegard Coppers," produced and edited by Arion the Wanderer (Dave Peters), Minister of the Moneyers Guild of An Tir and once apprentice to Cnulle, reveals that history and provides high quality images of each copper type. Under each copper image in "St. Hildegard Coppers" is a lightly edited description written by Cnulle himself. The outer world ultimately recognized the uniqueness of the St. Hildegard coppers, which feature in multiple volumes of Krause Publications' "Unusual World Coins" as "Coinage of the Realm." The St. Hildegard coppers' collector base today is international, including in Drachenwald, pointing up the need for a resource like "St. Hildegard Coppers."

Cnulle, together with Watt Kidman (Walt Patrick), produced the first St. Hildegard coppers in November AS 27 (1992), a project that continued for the next 13 years. Hot-struck on copper blanks, each copper weighed about 14 grams, giving a period heft and jingle in the hand and pouch. The \$1 copper trade token quickly became informally popular among populace and merchants, a way to more forsoothly shop, trade and wager. The coppers' circulation quickly spread throughout the kingdoms and they regularly turned up at the society's larger events such as Pennsic and Gulf War.

The obverse of each copper bears the emblem of the University of St. Hildegard, named for the 12th Century German Abbess Hildegard of Bingen, with its highly recognizable “+H” surrounded by inscription “SANCTA HILDEGARDENSIS.” The University of St. Hildegard was an educational institution, organized in the SCA as a household, dedicated to the studying the arts and sciences of medieval life.

The reverse of each copper was struck in honor of kingdoms, royals, households, merchants and, on occasion, organizations outside the SCA. More than just trade tokens, the coppers tell much of the SCA's history and, when they were being minted, they told that history in real time. The populace gave the coppers their popular name of “baraks” in honor of Barak Ravensfuri, the Lion of An Tir - as well as a Knight, Pelican and Royal Peer, one of the 11 Ravensfuri siblings - for whom the first coppers were struck.

Additional types were regularly minted thereafter, including type No. 3, the “Skepti-Barak,” minted for the July Coronation of Skepti I and Onore in AS 31 (1996); No. 18, the “Artemesia Kingdom Badge Type” struck for that kingdom in AS 34 (1999); and No. 20, also struck in AS 34, “Pillaged Village,” and No. 43, “Lynn the Weaver Lucets,” minted in AS 38 (2003) in honor of well-known SCA merchants.

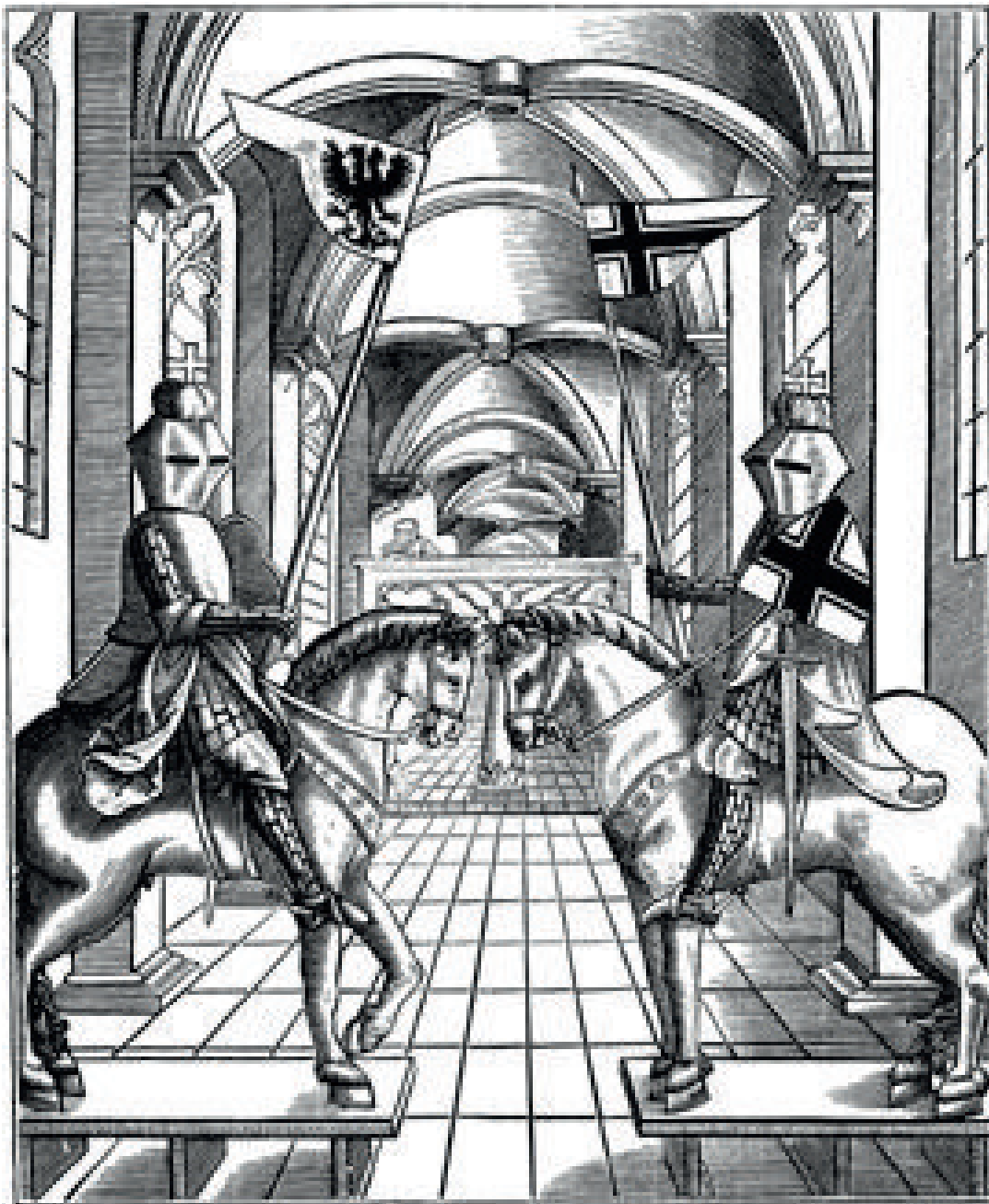
Among the most poignant of the coppers was struck for the Middle Kingdom in AS 33 (1998) to commemorate “Count Sir Jafar al Safah,” who won that kingdom's Crown Tournament in the Fall of AS 32 (1997). The kingdom looked forward to Jafar's coronation, his second, the following spring but he died unexpectedly that December after a brief illness. The kingdom grieved and Jafar's Consort, Kenna, was crowned and she reigned alone in his memory. For this copper, Cnulle said he attempted “a real portrait” of Jafar, inspired by a late Roman/early Romanion solidus, and incorporated the kingdom's badge, a dragon, into the shield on Jafar's shoulder.

The final St. Hildegard copper, No. 45, the “Mjolnir Heatherlands/Thor's Hammer” type, a memorial copper struck in memory of a Seattle Knights member, was minted in AS 40 (2005). By that time, the price of copper had spiked to the point that the metal content in each copper was worth more than its redeemable value of \$1. That outer-world development helped along a desire by both Cnulle and Kidman to move onto other projects. Those included Cnulle producing dies and tokens for Arkansas-based Shirepost Mint, such as for the HBO series “Game of Thrones.” Those include “The Faceless Man” token, still used in gaming today, and Cnulle's “Daler of New Dale.” Cnulle also continued to produce tokens for SCA events and his “mint” became a must-stop-by place for many SCAdians.

Cnulle continued moneying in the SCA and also redeemed the St. Hildegard coppers at their \$1 face value up until his final event, An Tir September Crown AS 43 (2011) in the Barony of Glymm Mere. Cnulle died unexpectedly the following November and the coppers quickly fell into SCAdian memory, hoarded out of any further circulation by collectors and table-top gamers.

It was only a matter of time before the first source book of the St. Hildegard Coppers was produced.

“St. Hildegard Coppers” provides history written those who knew Cnulle and answers for those who ever wondered where the coppers came from.
