

Greetings! It's been a few months since we launched the shiny new website. As a general reminder, please log in and edit your profile (Resources -> For Members -> Edit Persona) to make the scribes happy. When you're editing your profile you should see options to change things like your Group and Pronouns and the like. If you see options to change site colors and a profile, you're in the WordPress Profile editor, and that information doesn't display on the website. The WordPress Profile also says 'WordPress Profile' at the top of the page. Please contact us at support@ northshield.org if you can't find the place to edit your profile, or can't log in. (We are aware that there are still people who haven't been able to log in for technical reasons, and we're still working with them on it; most people who have contacted us are now able to log in.) Believe me, we are trying to make it all less confusing without breaking anything in the process.

My deputies and I have been writing documentation and how-to guides, and hope to record some videos soon. We have been leading sessions (usually labelled as classes) at events and will continue to do so, during which we show off various features and answer questions. And lately we have also set up tables at events to provide on-site assistance and adhoc sessions. If you run into us there and have questions or suggestions or complaints or problems, please let us know and we will work with you to get them addressed. (You can also send us email any time.)

We continue to add and activate back-end tools and features. Some areas of the website are visible but not populated yet - most of those are waiting for a Kingdom Officer to make a decision about precisely who is going to populate that content. (Yes, the Web team is capable of populating things like the registered names and devices for all of Northshield, but there are other things we should be working on instead.) If you see an area which appears to be empty and you don't think it should be, go ahead and ask us about it.

If you come across content which you think we've put in the wrong place, please let us know. Our team of librarians provided us with a menu structure, but we're willing to discuss changes.

And as we add pages, we usually make decisions amongst ourselves about where something belongs. And we don't always make good choices. Email support@northshield.org and set us straight!

As of the time I'm writing this, Domesday reports for almost every officer are due. For reference sake and for the future, all of the reports can be found at https://northshield. org/reports/ . We will be making changes to all of the reports as the site progresses, but we will keep this page up to date. In addition, each of the Kingdom Officers should be able to log in and view the reports for their area of expertise and region. For instance, the Kingdom Armored Combat Marshal can view the Armored Combat report results, and the Central Regional Deputy Armored Combat Marshal can view the Armored Combat reports from the central region. The Kingdom Seneschal can view all of the Seneschal reports, and the Eastern Regional Seneschal can view the Seneschal reports from the Eastern region. And so on. If you're an officer who should be seeing reports and you're not, let us

This new Rapier handbook is part of the modernization effort, which is updating ALL the marshal handbooks along with the marshal related sections in Corpora, to better reflect the current structure, culture, and safety best practices we use today in our SCA martial activities.

One of the most significant changes is the modernized format, designed for easy online access and usability. With clearer layout, improved navigation, and consistency across all marshal handbooks, this new format makes it easier for both newcomers and experienced participants to find the information they need quickly and confidently.

Nov 20 thru Feb 20th: Rapier Handbook is open for commentary. This version has been approved by the BoD for commentary for 3 months.

Feb 20 thru March 30: Updates to the handbook will be developed based on the commentary.

April 1: New handbook with updates from feedback will be submitted to the BoD for final review and approval.

May 20: New handbook will be in effect (if approved during the April BoD meeting).

The Cut & Thrust Handbook is in progress, and will be added to this timeline.

Recent Publication

It isn't every day that a book of SCAdian history is published. That happened recently with publication of "St. Hildegard Coppers," produced and edited by Arion the Wanderer (Dave Peters), Minister of the Moneyers Guild of An Tir and once apprentice to the late Ian Cnulle (Gregory Paul Franck-Weiby) who created the dies from which the coppers were struck.

Cnulle, together with Watt Kidman (Walt Patrick), produced the first St. Hildegard coppers in November AS 27 (1992), a project that continued for the next 13 years. Hot-struck on 1-inch diameter, 3/32-inch thick copper blanks, each copper weighed in at about 14 grams. Their size gave a delightful period heft and jingle in the hand and pouch. Traded at \$1 face value, the coppers quickly became informally popular among populace and merchants, a way to shop, trade and wager forsoothly.

The front of each copper bears the emblem of the University of St. Hildegard, an SCA household named for the 12th Century German Abbess Hildegard of Bingen, with its highly recognizable "+H" surrounded by inscription "SANCTA HILDEGARDENSIS."

The back of each copper type is unique, minted for kingdoms, royals, households, merchants and, on occasion, organizations outside the SCA.

The coppers were popularly known as "baraks" in honor of Barak Ravensfuri, any early King of An Tir for whom the first coppers were struck.

Additional types were regularly minted thereafter, including type No. 43, "Lynn the Weaver Lucets," minted in in AS 38 (2003) in honor of a well-know, SCA merchant.

The final St. Hildegard copper, No. 45, the "Mjolnir Heatherlands/Thor's Hammer" type, was minted in AS 40 (2005).

The outer world also recognized the uniqueness of the St. Hildegard coppers, which feature in multiple volumes of Krause Publications' "Unusual World Coins." The St. Hildegard coppers' collector base today is international.



Another recommendation is to serve Hypocras and Wafers to the guests. Hypocras is a spiced wine, and while there are many variations described in French and English cooking and medicine treatises from the 12th to 16th centuries, references to similar beverages date back to the Romans and Pliny the Elder. Similarly, recipes for sweetened wafers were found as early as 11th century France. Both of these dishes can be made in advance to take the pressure off of the host. There are many variations on these recipes (and their spellings) that can be found across Europe during the middle ages.

[If you don't have] sugir, take a potel of honey.

- I BOTTLE (750 MLL) OF AN INEXPENSIVE, SWEET WINE
- 1 1 1/2 CUPS SUGAR (OR: 1 2 CUPS HONEY)
- I TBS. EACH OF GINGER, CINNAMON, GRAINS OF PARADISE, PEPPERCORNS, GALYANGAL, CLOVE, NUTMEG, & CARAWAY SEED*

In a sealable decantor, add the wine and sugar. Adjust sweetness as needed. Add the spices to the wine. Allow it to macerate covered for 24 hours. After resting, decant the wine and filter through a funnel lined with cheesecloth. add to bottles with an air tight seal and store in a cool place. It should keep for about a month.

*substitutions: grains of paradise are similar to cardamom pods. Long pepper is difficult to find so peppercorns are listed. Galangal can be found at some asian grocery stores. Spikenard in the original is very hard to source food grade.

WAFERS

"To make wafers: to make the best wafers, take the finest wheat-flowers you can get, and mix it with cream, the yelks of eggs, rose-water, sugar, and cinamon, till it be a little thicker than pancake-batter, and then warming your wafter irons on a charcoal-fire, anoint them first with sweet butter, and than lay on your batter, and press it, and bake it white or brown at your pleasure."


