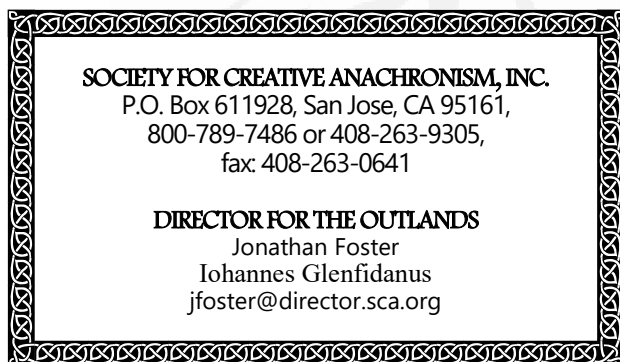

To Our Amazing Populace,

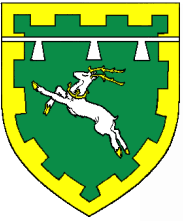

Greetings Fair Outlands,

The season of change is upon us, bringing the icy embrace of winter tempered by the warm promise of new growth to come. With this season of change comes also change to the throne of the Outlands.

The celebration and ceremony surrounding the Coronation of a new Crown is a fundamental part of Our Kingdom's culture. Twice a year the populace is brought together to bear witness to the Coronation of the Outlands' new Crown and to thank the previous Crown for the care and service given to the Kingdom. Though the Coronation ceremony is a grand display of pageantry and tradition, the purpose is not simply to place the Crown on a pedestal before the populace. Swords will clash in epic duels, presenting a dazzling display of skill, valor, and above all else -- honor. At day's end, Their Majesties will present Royal Heirs seated by Their side.

## A BIT OF HISTORY

Among the St. Hildegard coppers, a trade token popular in the SCA from AS 27 (1992) and for decades after, is what collectors today call No. 15, the “Outlands Kingdom Badge Type.”

Ian Cnulle, a moneyer in the Kingdom of An Tir who engraved the dies for all the St. Hildegard copper types, said in a letter to his father that he drew inspiration for the “Outlands Kingdom Badge Type” from multiple period coins. “Although the highly abstracted style of the rendition of the design bears affinity to early Anglo-Saxon coin design, the primary inspiration was the extraordinarily bold artistic expression of the base silver staters of Armorica - a Celtic tribal issue of the first century BCE,” Cnulle (Gregory Paul Franck-Weiby outside the SCA) said.

...The original Armorican staters showed an explosive horse facing right, with degenerate remnants of other design elements, including a boar between the horse's legs and possibly a chariot and driver behind the horse. The abstracted forms and extremely high relief of this design give it a feeling of elemental power.

The story of the “Outlands Kingdom Badge Type” is one of dozens included in a newly published book of SCAdian history, “St. Hildegard Coppers.”

“St. Hildegard Coppers,” produced and edited by Arion the Wanderer (Dave Peters), Minister of the Moneyers Guild of An Tir and once apprentice to Cnulle, details for the first time anywhere the history of the coppers and how they came to be.

Cnulle, together with Watt Kidman (Walt Patrick), produced the first St. Hildegard coppers in November AS 27, a project that continued for the next 13 years. Hot-struck on 1-inch diameter, 3/32-inch-thick copper blanks, each copper weighed in at about 14 grams. Their size gave a delightful period heft and jingle in the hand and pouch. Traded at \$1 face value, the coppers quickly became informally popular among populace and merchants, a way to shop, trade and wager forsoothly at events and outside the society.

The front of each copper bears the emblem of the University of St. Hildegard, named for the 12<sup>th</sup> Century German Abbess Hildegard of Bingen, with its highly recognizable “+H” surrounded by inscription “SANCTA HILDEGARDENSIS.” The University of St. Hildegard was an educational institution, organized in the SCA as a household, dedicated to the studying the arts and sciences of medieval life.

The back of each copper type is unique, minted for kingdoms, royals, households, merchants and, on occasion, organizations outside the SCA.

The coppers were more than just tokens. They tell much of the SCA's history and, when they were being minted, they told that history in real time.

The coppers picked up their popular name of “baraks” in honor of Barak Ravensfuri, the Lion of An Tir - as well as a Knight, Pelican and Royal Peer, one of the 11 Ravensfuri siblings - for whom the first coppers were struck.

Additional types were regularly minted thereafter, including type No. 3, the “Skeпти-Barak,” minted for the July Coronation of Skeпти I and Onore in AS 31 (1996); No. 16, “The Caravan of the High Silk Road,” minted in AS 33 (1998), based on a Norman trifollaro, for an association of merchants trading in the lands east of the Mississippi river; and No. 43, “Lynn the Weaver Lucets,” minted in AS 38 (2003) in honor of a well-know, SCA merchant.

For the “Outlands Kingdom Badge Type,” Cnulle altered the Armorican staters’ “explosive horse facing right” and rendered it into the kingdom's stag leaping upward. “The curve of the animal's body is like a tightly drawn bow poised to shoot its being forward and upward,” Cnulle told his father. “The crescent of the buck's body and the main line of the antlers echo the curve of the moon in the middle to suggest reflection of essences within nature.”



It took Cnulle more than 14 total hours to create the die for the “Outlands Kingdom Badge Type,” completing it on 10 December AS 33 (1998). The type was struck with both low and high relief obverse dies.

The Outlands copper was a relatively early type of the series. The final St. Hildegard copper, No. 45, the “Mjolnir Heatherlands/Thor's Hammer” type, was minted in AS 40 (2005).

By the time the last St. Hildegard copper was struck, the price of copper had spiked to the point that the metal content in each copper attained a worth of more than its redeemable value of \$1. That outer-world development helped along a desire by both Cnulle and Kidman to move onto other projects. Those included Cnulle producing dies and tokens for Arkansas-based Shirepost Mint, such as for the HBO series “Game of Thrones.” Those include “The Faceless Man” token, still used in gaming today, and Cnulle’s “Daler of New Dale.”

The outer world also recognized the uniqueness of the St. Hildegard coppers, which feature in multiple volumes of Krause Publications’ “Unusual World Coins” as “Coinage of the Realm.” The St. Hildegard coppers’ collector base today is international.

Cnulle continued moneying in the SCA and also redeemed the St. Hildegard coppers at their \$1 face value up until his final event, An Tir September Crown AS 43 (2011) in the Barony of Glymm Mere. Cnulle died unexpectedly the following November and the coppers quickly fell into SCAdian memory, hoarded out of any further circulation by collectors and table-top gamers. Over the years, little has been available to explain where the coppers came from, who designed them and what part they played in SCAdian history.

Until now.

“St. Hildegard Coppers” provides history of the coppers, written those who knew Cnulle, and also provides high-quality photos of each type, along with lightly edited descriptions written by Cnulle himself.
