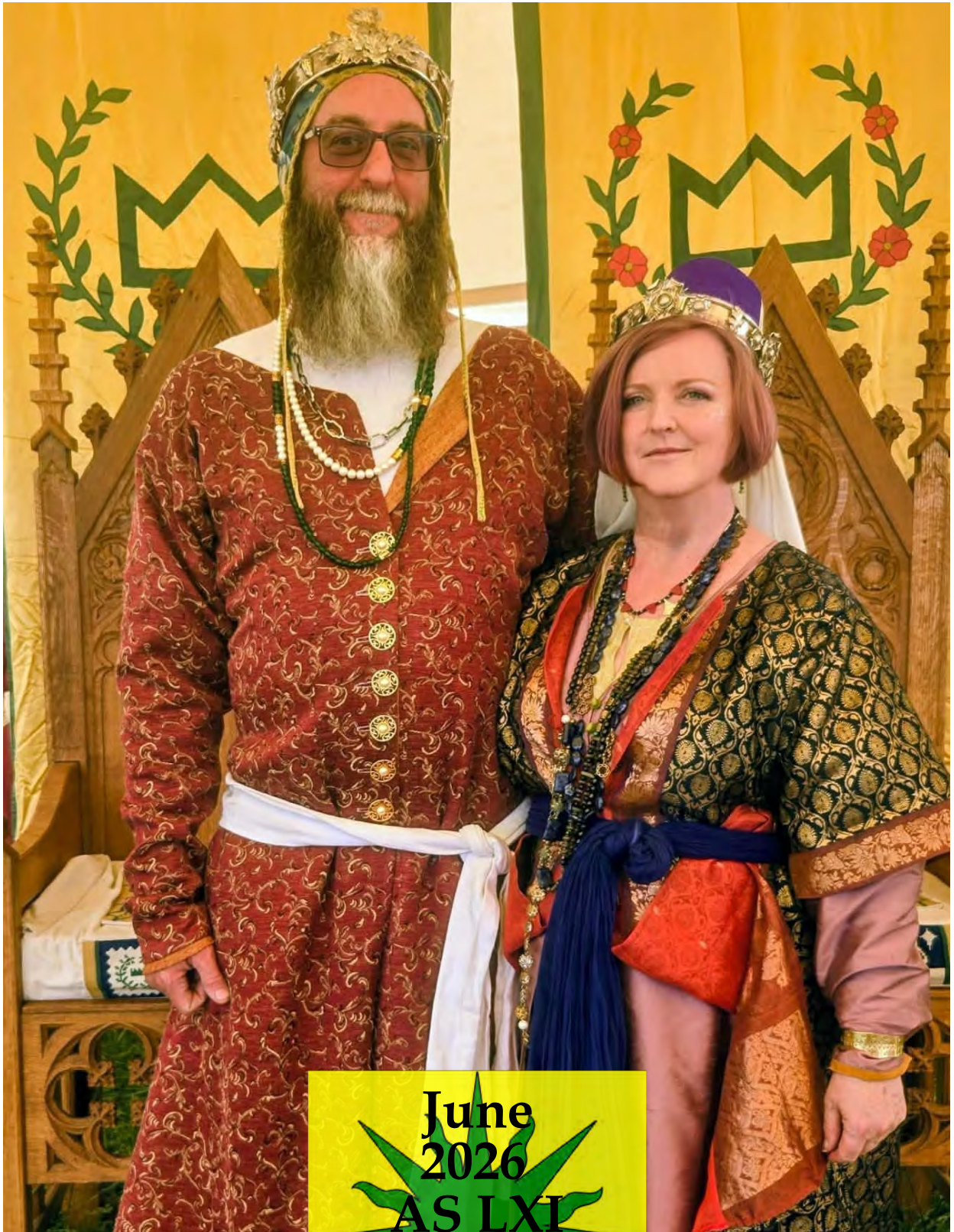

We traveled to Mist Investiture to see our New Prince and Princess of the Mists and the feast that followed was full of shimmer.

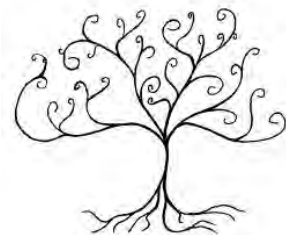
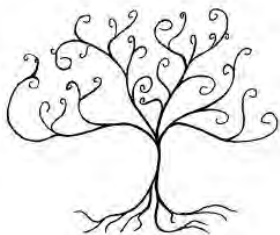
Cynagua Coronet Tournament saw new Heirs, who will continue to lead Their Principality with sparkle.

“On this, the 60th birthday of the SCA, I want to look back to the world when the SCA began. This is not just a game.

The 1960s was a time of transformation, of rebellion and upheaval. The United States stood in the shadow of the Cold War, the turmoil of the Vietnam War, and the tensions of the Civil Rights Movement.

And in the midst of all that uncertainty, a small group in Berkeley chose something remarkable,

They chose not cynicism, but creativity.

They chose not fear, but fellowship.

They chose not the world as it was, but the world as it could be.

When they founded the SCA in 1966, they did so not despite the turmoil around them, but because of it. They set out to build a community grounded not in fear, but in virtue, honor, courtesy, courage, and joy.

Changes to the Laws of the Principality of Cynagua

April 2026

ARTICLE III, Section 4 [current]

F. The Keeper of the Regalia, who shall store, maintain, inventory, and transport the regalia of the Principality.

ARTICLE III, Section 4 [amended]

F. The Regalia Minister, who shall maintain and inventory the regalia of the Principality. The Regalia Minister shall work in conjunction with the Coronets and the Principality Teamster to arrange the transport of the regalia of the Principality.

G. The Principality Teamster, warranted by the Principality Exchequer and reporting to the Coronet, and is responsible for the maintenance, safekeeping, and transportation of the Principality trailer.

Changes to the Laws of the Kingdom of the West

May 2026

ARTICLE IV, Section 18.4 [new]

Section 8.14 - Prince/ess Royale

The child(ren) of the Crown may be styled as "Prince Royale", "Princess Royal", or "Heir Royale" for the duration of Their reign. The appropriate honorific for a Royale is "Highness" (whereas "Royal Highness" refers to the Heirs to the Crown).

Section 8.14.1

Child(ren) of the Crown are defined as the biological, step, or adopted offspring, or other minors for whom the Sovereign and/or Consort have legal guardianship during Their reign.

Section 8.14.2

Upon completion of the reign, the child(ren) of the Crown are recognized with an augmentation of arms and return to their previous honorific. The augmentation shall be an acorn proper.

Principality of the Mists Arts and Sciences



The Silver Muse Award

The Principality of the Mists has a special award given to 1 person each year who qualifies, called the Silver Muse. There are 3 parts to this –

- (1) entering and obtaining 50% of the points in 5 of the Mists Principality Arts and Sciences competitions during 1 calendar year
- (2) (2) one of the entries must have teaching component – this may be a “how to” set of instructions with the goal to share the fun, and
- (3) (3) the winner is encouraged to submit an item for largesse to assist the Royals in showing off the work of the Mists artisans.

The law for the Silver Muse has recently been amended. The amended language is as follows:

Article IV: Honors, Awards and Orders

Section 1: Honors

Section 1.6: Silver Muse

There shall be in the Mists an annual Arts and Sciences competition which begins at Spring Coronet. The Arts and Sciences Minister, in consultation with the Coronet, shall be responsible for conducting this competition.

The victor of this competition shall be known as the Silver Muse. The regalia of this office is the Silver Muse token, and the honor and regalia shall pass from the current holder to the winner of the competition at Fall Investiture or the next possible event thereafter. Criteria for winning the competition is as follows:

- Participation in at least 5 Mists A&S competitions. To qualify, the entry must receive at least 50% of the available points for that competition. This component recognizes the individual’s excellence in A&S skills.
- • At least one entry must include a “teaching” component – a Do It Yourself handout or some other form of “how to do what I did” instruction. This information, with the permission of the entrant, will be published via the Mists Web site to further the shared knowledge within the Principality. This component recognizes the individual’s willingness to give back to the Principality by teaching their skills to others.
- • The competitor shall be encouraged only to provide a donation to the Principality gift basket. The contribution does not have to be one of the A&S entries, but should be an item made by the contributor. This component allows the Coronet to proudly display the skills of its artisans by providing gifts for the Coronet to give to worthy recipients that can enrich the Principality.

Competition One ~ Iberian Peninsula 722-1492 The Iberian Peninsula, place of wonder, place of cultures, center of art and science. Starting with the Battle of Covandanga, 722, until the Reconquista, 1492.

You are invited to explore the Arts and Sciences of the myriad cultures, time periods, and the societies that interacted with the Iberian Peninsula during this time to bring more Beauty and Knowledge to the Principality of the Mists.

Competition Two ~ African Kingdoms 756-1031 Explore the African Kingdoms, their trade routes and connections with the Caliphate of Cordoba, and the rest of the known world of the time, 756-1031. Delve into the arts and sciences of varied Kingdoms and cultures using research and creativity to bring Beauty and Knowledge to the Mists.

Spring Investiture

Competition Three ~ Silk Road: From its origins to India This ranges from China to the midpoint of the Silk Road in the Indian Subcontinent. Peruse kingdoms, cultures, trade goods, and all their interconnections. Bring fabulous art and science creations to the populace. Use your creativity and ingenuity to craft entries that will help make the Mists a more Beautiful and Knowledgeable principality.

Competition Four ~ Hanseatic League 13th to 16th Centuries From the Baltic States to Northern Europe explore the art, science, and trade goods of the League Members and its interconnecting trade partners. What were the effects of the League on trade? How were other societies of the time affected? Create an entry for this that makes the Mists more Knowledgeable and Beautiful.

Fall Coronet

Competition Five ~ Ancient Mediterranean to the Fall of Rome What was the Ancient Mediterranean like? How powerful was Rome? Minoan, Greek, Phoenician, Mycenaean and so many other cultures to explore. Who were the states that dominated trade? Who were the Sea Peoples? Explore the region and help illuminate through art, science, and culture to bring Knowledge and Beauty to the Mists.

Competition Six ~ India and the Dragon States 6th-16th Centuries Explore the Medieval Indian subcontinent, (modern day Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka) or the The Dragon States (modern day South East Asia; Myanmar, Thailand, Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam, Malaysia, Brunei, Indonesia, Philippines, and Papua). Just imagine all the medieval cultures and kingdoms one can study and find fabulous ideas in art or science to promote Knowledge and Beauty in the Mists!

Use your creativity, and ingenuity to craft entries in A&S that will help make the Mists a more Beautiful and Knowledgeable Principality.

Competition Eight ~ Ring of Fire 7th to 16th Centuries What medieval wonders can you discover in the Ring of Fire (modern day: New Zealand, Polynesia, Papua New Guinea, Indonesia, Philippines, Japan, parts of Russia, Alaska and the West Coast of the Americas)? Contemplate kingdoms and cultures from the 600s to the Age of Exploration and help to share the historic arts and sciences of this incredible region to bring to light more Beauty and Knowledge to the Mists.



Principality of Cynagua Arts and Sciences

The Lumen Cynagua



There is an annual Arts & Sciences Championship competition that is only open to Cynaguans.

The competition begins with Spring Coronet and concludes with Winter Investiture. The Lumen Cynagua Medallion is then presented to the A&S Champion at the following Spring Coronet.

There are 8 Arts and Sciences competitions (4 arts and 4 sciences) held throughout this year-long period. A competitor must enter a minimum of four of these to be eligible. Multiple items may be entered in each category, however, only the highest score will count towards the Championship overall score.

The Arts & Sciences Champion is known as the "Lumen Cynagua," representing the light of art and learning in the Principality. The Champion's responsibility is to encourage participation in and an appreciation of the arts and sciences in Cynagua.

Please send me your name and type of art you will be entering for the Lumen competition no later than 2 weeks before a scheduled competition so I have time to find suitable judges.

Cynagua Coronet, May 22-25

Courtly Love ~ As bright sunshine of Spring melts the frigid heart of winter, so comes the renewal of Courtly and Chivalric Love.

Art ~ Fans, handkerchiefs and jewelry were a few things used in the art of conveying interest in someone. Create an object to be given to your person of "special interest" during pre 16th century court.

Science ~ Several cultures had talisman, songs, or specific deeds that were relevant to finding that "special someone". Create and document your best interpretation of one of these and define why it was believed to successful.

Summer Investiture, July 11

Beasty Bugs ~ Summertime often brings out wanted and unwanted crawling, flying and buzzing creatures. From the beautiful to the stuff of nightmares we take a look at the little, and sometimes not so little things we share summer months with.

Art ~ Create a wearable piece depicting one or several bugs. Some examples are jewelry, head coverings, trim.

Science ~ Don't bite me! Create something that warded off bug bites and or was used as a mobile barrier to keep bugs away.

Fall Coronet, Oct 30- Nov 1

The Wild Hunt ~ The Wild Hunt Some mythology tells us The Wild Hunt rode eternal chasing elusive prey as atonement for wrong doings in life. For competition we will look at what monsters may have lurked and how it was believed one could be protected from such thing

Art ~ Using period techniques create something that represents a folklore monster documentable pre 16th century. Example: needle felted snakes on a hat, (Medusa) three distinct but unmatched dog collars (Cerberus) .

Science ~ Define and describe why and how certain charms, rituals and behaviors were believed to ward off monsters and evils spirits.

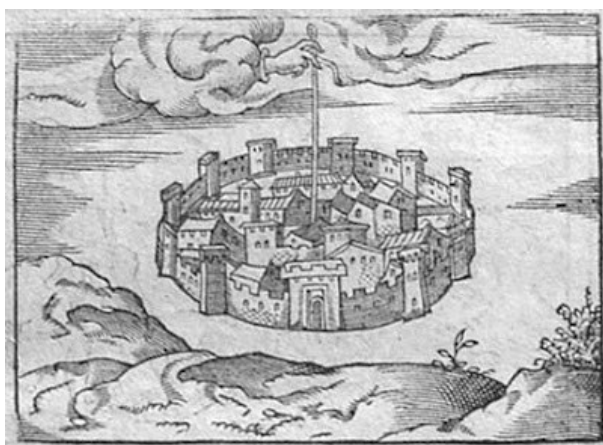

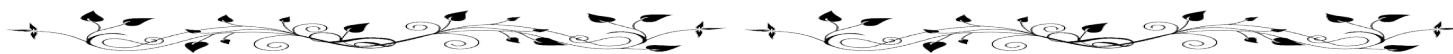
