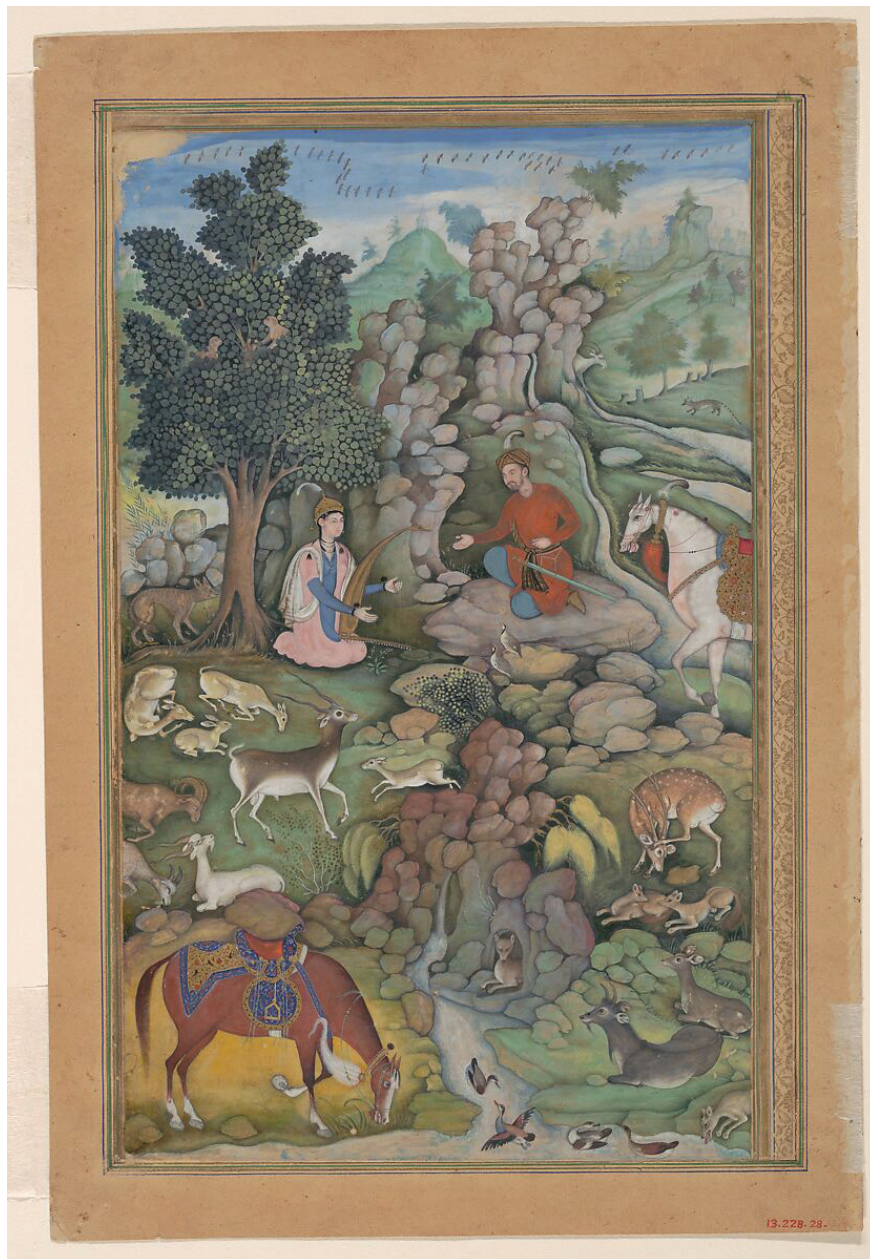

Greetings,

My name is Katerinka and I am the Law Clerk for the Kingdom. Part of my job is to ensure that Kingdom Law is maintained and updated.

MAJOR LAW REVISION COMING SOON

Last year, Kingdom Law turned 20. With age comes inconsistencies in formatting, layout, and structure. As part of a larger modernization effort, Northshield's laws will be adopting the United States House of Representatives House Legislative Counsel's Manual on Drafting Style. It is a freely available resource which is regularly updated. This was discussed and approved by Stallari last year, and the revision is actively in progress.

TIMELINE

Stallari is taking this opportunity to modernize, standardize, and streamline the law so that it can continue to guide the Kingdom for years to come. This revision will touch virtually every part of the law. Due to the volume of changes, the revisions will be posted for commentary in special editions of the Northwatch and will be open for commentary for at least one month. While a timeline has not been set in stone, it is my intention to have all of the revisions published for commentary by the end of 2026, with the goal of holding a law court in early-to-mid 2027.

Please continue to refer to the current version of Kingdom Law (published January 2026) until further notice.

HOW THE POPULACE MAY CONTRIBUTE

While changes to the structure of the law are themselves considered a substantive change, please note that there will also be substantive changes within the law itself. Some of these are changes which were identified by the Law Clerk, while others were suggested by members of Stallari and the populace. I will do my best to include a summary of major structural or process changes. I encourage all

members of the populace (yes, even you) to carefully review the changes as they're published and submit commentary to lawclerk@northshield.org and seneschal@northshield.org.

CLOSING

The Kingdom relies on the contributions of the populace to ensure future prosperity. This is a complicated and ambitious endeavor, yet very necessary. I look forward to hearing from the populace. Many hands make light work.

Greetings! People have told us that it's too difficult to find the place to edit their profiles, or to submit award recommendations, or to fill out model release forms, because the interface to find those buttons is too confusing or too difficult or just plain dumb. So we made some changes.

When you log in to the website, you should see a button in the top left corner (in the black bar) labelled 'SCA Kingdom of Northshield'. If you click that, it should take you to 'Northshield Tools'. In the center of the screen you should then see the buttons to Manage Persona Information, Submit an Award Recommendation, and Submit a Release Form. Ta daa!

If you don't see this option, please contact support (support@northshield.org).

AWARD RECOMMENDATIONS

Individuals being recommended for an award do not need to have a profile on the website in order to have an award recommendation submitted for them. The system tries to auto-fill based on the profiles on the website, but recommenders are still able to type the person's name if that person does not have a profile auto-populate. The recommendation should still submit.

org). Some peoples' logins are disconnected from their profiles. We think we've identified and corrected all of those, but it's always possible that we've missed one.

To return to the regular website, click on SCA Kingdom of Northshield at the top left again. Depending on what device you're using, that should return you to the website or show you a button to take you back to the website.

I mention this, because we'd really like you all to fill out your profiles. And, in particular, we'd like you to fill out your membership number (if you have one).

If you are an officer or a marshal, you are required to have a membership number. The SCA corporate office sends us a list of expiration dates matched to those membership numbers, and we can run a simple operation to update everyone's expiration dates, but matching people to their membership numbers is a very long process that, as it turns out, I don't like. So please, update your membership numbers.

As long as you're filling out your membership number, you can also update the rest of your profile - persona information, pronoun preferences, dreams, aspirations - whatever you'd like. As always, if you need help with that process, please contact support (support@northshield.org). We're happy to help! Side note: you can still reach the Edit Persona / User Tools, Submit Award Recommendations, and Release Forms functions from the Resources -> For Members menu.

About those release forms - if you'd like your artistic talents to be displayed on the website, please fill out that form even if you believe you already have a release form on file. We do still have the release forms from the old website, but they were submitted via a google form which is owned by an individual in the Kingdom and not an officer account. We're working on transferring that information over, but we don't want to strain that individual's patience.

Northshield Open Position Descriptions

KINGDOM ARMORED COMBAT MARSHAL - POSITION DESCRIPTION

Kingdom Armored Combat Marshal

The Kingdom Armored Combat Marshal (KACM) is responsible for overseeing the Rattan Combat in Northshield. The KACM is a Kingdom Level Officer that reports to, and works with the Kingdom Earl Marshal (KEM) to administer the rules of Armored Combat - Rattan. Job duties include:

Appointed and warranted by the Kingdom Earl Marshal and the Crown as the Deputy Earl Marshal for Armored Combat

All the duties and responsibilities of an armored combat marshal level 3.

Will promote the safe and orderly conduct of armored combat in the Kingdom.

Compile all reports from their regional marshals into one report and submit to the Kingdom Earl Marshal quarterly, within twelve (12) days of the report due date for group marshals.

Compile all reports from their regional Marshals and submit a summary report to the Society Armored Combat Marshal on a Quarterly basis.

Adjudicate issues that may come up from time to time, and potentially administer sanctions in consultation with the KEM.

The workload will vary but expect to put in an average of 4-6 hours a week, with occasional spikes in activity where it will be more.

Requirements:

Currently a member of the SCA, Inc.

Currently a Level 2 marshal for a minimum of 4 years, a Level 3 marshal is preferred. Ability to clearly communicate verbally and in writing, i.e. in person and via email, phone, and in written reports

Working knowledge of relevant Armored Combat - Rattan rules, procedures, and processes.

Strong skills in remotely coordinating a volunteer team with diverse skill-sets.

Dependable email access

Dependable social media access is nice to have but not required

Moderate proficiency with data management

Moderate proficiency with Google Sheets and similar spreadsheet applications

Moderate proficiency with Google Docs and similar word processing applications

REGIONAL THROWN WEAPON MARSHALS - POSITION DESCRIPTION

Regional Thrown Weapon Marshals must be currently warranted Thrown Weapons Marshals of the Field. Their responsibilities include:

Compiling and coordinating quarterly reports from Thrown Weapons Group Marshals and Marshals-In-Training in their Region.

Compiling and coordinating yearly reports from all Thrown Weapons Marshals of the field in their Region.

Compiling and coordinating Event reports for events in their Region.

Maintaining a roster of active Thrown Weapons Marshals and Martials-In-Training within their Region.

Administering the verbal test for Marshals-In-Training for initial warranting as Marshals of the Field and recertification of Marshals of the Field.

Assisting the Kingdom Thrown Weapons Marshal in administration of the Thrown Weapons program.

Serving as emergency deputy, stepping up to fulfill the Kingdom Thrown Weapons Marshal role, if needed.

Advising local officers within the Region about thrown weapons-related issues such as interpretation of rules and marshal coverage for events.

Assisting the Kingdom Thrown Weapons Marshal and the Kingdom Earl Marshal with any incident investigations or accident reports.

The expected start date for the Plains Regional TW Marshal is August 1, 2026. The term of office for a Regional Thrown Weapons officer is 2 years, with the option to extend to 3 years

If you're in the Plains (western) Region and are interested in stepping up your service to the Regional level, please send a letter of interest to thrown-weapons@northshield.org by July 1, 2026. Your letter should include why you're interested in serving as the Plains Regional TW Marshal and provide a summary of your experience as a Thrown Weapons marshal.

MINISTER OF PROTOCOL - POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Minister of Protocol (MoP) is responsible for the maintenance of the Boke of Ceremony. The MoP reports to Polaris Principal Herald. This is primarily an administrative role. The MoP is responsible for delivering and meeting deadlines for the following:

Ensure consistent and up-to-date documentation in the Boke of Ceremony

Ensure consistent and reliable records of prior versions of the Boke of Ceremony are maintained

Ensure that the Boke of Ceremony complies with any new guidance or requirements from society, Stallari, and Polaris

Draft new ceremonies for review by Polaris and Stallari and update existing ceremonies as requested

Provide advice and guidance to anyone seeking assistance with the Boke of Ceremony

Provide advice and guidance regarding matters of protocol

Compile quarterly reports for Polaris

Maintain any relevant email lists and social media groups

Maintain any relevant handbooks, resources, and other forms.

The workload will vary but expect to put in an average of 1 hour a month with occasional commitments of up to 10 hours for meetings, Boke overhauls, and updates

Demonstratable experience in heraldry, ceremonies, and protocol

Moderate proficiency with data management

KEYTHONG HERALD (SUBMISSIONS) - POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Keythong Herald (submissions) is responsible for the processing of heraldic submissions from the populace of Northshield. Keythong reports to Polaris Principal Herald. This is primarily an administrative role. Keythong is responsible for delivering and meeting deadlines for the following:

Ensure timely processing of submissions for names and devices, including financial transactions related to the submissions

Ensure monthly submissions of Internal and External Letters of Intent on OSCAR. This includes but is not limited to: inputting submissions into OSCAR; transferring submissions forward from Kingdom to External review; returning submissions which do not meet requirements or need additional work; communicating with submitters; scanning and uploading forms and packets to Society-level OSCAR

Monitor OSCAR commentary at a Kingdom level and facilitate additional information requests

Review submissions paperwork to ensure all necessary requirements are met

Respond to Pelican and Wreath Sovereigns at Arms about the Kingdom's submissions

Prepare and send a monthly report of submission fees received

Assist with staffing heraldic consultation tables at events.

Coordinate with the Isendun Herald (submission notifications) about heraldry which has completed the Society-level review

The workload will vary but expect to put in an average of 2-3 hours per month with occasional commitments of up to 5 hours for large Letters of Intent.

Adept in name and device heraldry

Northshield Substantive Law Changes for Commentary

The following substantive law changes are open for commentary until **20 June 2026**.

Pursuant to Kingdom Law I-700, "Should the majority of the quorum of the Stallari Council believe a change to statutory law to be substantive, the Crown must publish the proposed law change in the Northwatch and allow one month from publication for comment before proceeding."

These changes were determined to be substantive by Stallari on 4/15/2026.

A note about the name of the award: an award name can only be assigned once it has been registered with the Society College of Arms. This process typically takes 9-12 months - longer than a reign. Additionally, an award can only be given out once it has been put into Kingdom Law. This is typically a substantive change. By using a placeholder name, the Crown may give out a new award during their reign. Once the award name has passed, the law will be updated with the new name. This is not typically a substantive change. Some may remember this happening when the Ordo Circini Vitruvii was created.

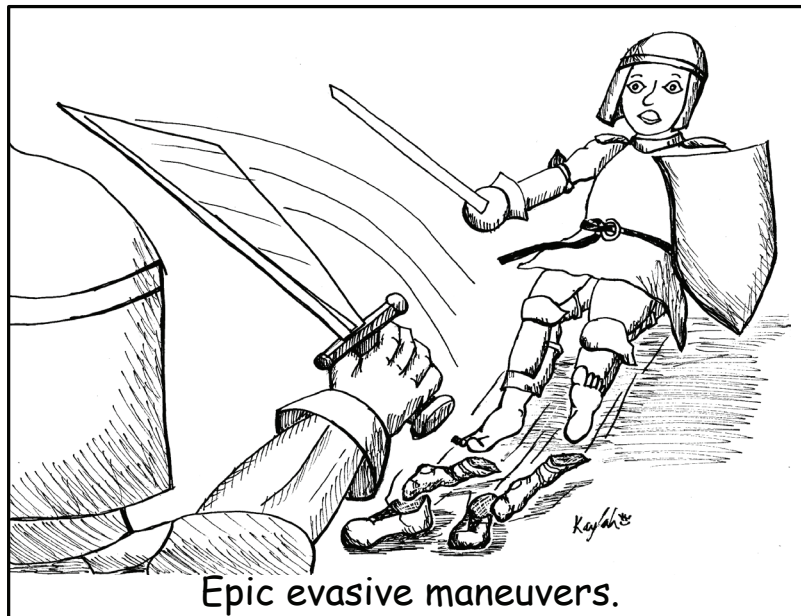
