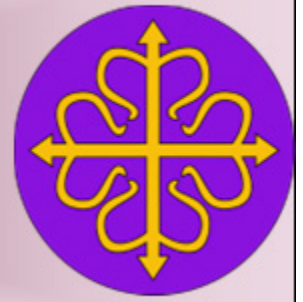

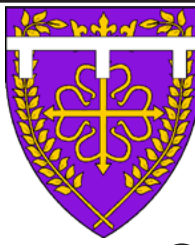

Changes to Kingdom Law

Law Changes for Their Majesties Caius Equitius Rectus Xerxis and Andromir Vukovic read into court May 9, 2026 at St George and the Dragon.

Old:

VIII.200 - All Kingdom officers shall send copies of their regular reports to the Crown, the Crown Prince and Princess on the dates appropriate to the schedules set by their Corporate level superiors.

New:

VIII.200 - All Kingdom officers shall send copies of their regular reports to the Crown, the Royal Heir and Heir Consort on the dates appropriate to the schedules set by their Corporate level superiors.

Managing against all the changes in policy and reporting requirements is no small feat and the populace should keep them hydrated and full of sustenance to keep them happy and attending to their tasks.

Fourth Company

Fourth Company is the service branch of the Calontir Army. We provide food and water for the Army's survival. We're mobilized when Their Royal Majesties call the Army to muster for a foreign war. These days this primarily includes Gulf War and Pennsic.

It consists of two branches working together to coordinate essential fighter support both on and off the field, the Waterbearers and Soup Kitchen. Waterbearing provides water and electrolyte replenishment while the fighters are on the field. The Soup Kitchen provides a meal including chicken noodle soup, beef jerky, peanut butter and jam sandwiches, cookies, and snack cakes for the recovery of our fighters after the battles.

Both branches of Fourth Company have a long and glorious history in Calontir. The need for waterbearing was recognized very early. Finola O'Clary and Jenna of Southwind brought milk jugs filled with water to the battle field as they watched the fighting. They began passing around the jug, and soon it was obvious there was a need. Waterbearing caught on quickly and became an official Kingdom office. In 2008, however, the SCA eliminated waterbearing as an official SCA activity yet Calontir and many kingdoms continue waterbearing as an unofficial volunteer activity.

The Soup Kitchen was born shortly after waterbearing activities began and was also started by Finola and Jenna. They decided to feed the fighters after a long day of war play. In an interview, Jenna said.

"Mom brought Knorr's chicken noodle soup mix, a pot, some foam cups, sliced meat, and snacks.

Next thing you know, a legend was born." This occurred sometime around 1989.

Finola was the first leader of what would become Fourth Company but many others have helped lead these volunteers. The leader of the Fourth Company is a Royal Appointment. It is their job then to gather volunteers and make preparation necessary for war activities. The leaders I know, in no specific order include Jenna, Alvira MacDonald, Charles and Margaret of Westermark, Bele Anna de Rugé, Gertrude of Three Rivers, Idonea de Clare, Antonia Stefani, Elasaith ingen Diarmata, Kolfinna Halvgrimsdottir, Catalina de Arazuri, Selene of Lesbos, and myself. I apologize if I have left someone off the list, if anyone knows of others who helped lead either the Waterbearers or the Soup Kitchen, I'd love to know who they are.

It is believed that Duke Fernando, when he was General in charge of the Calontir Army, coined the phrase "Fourth Company" to describe the service branch of the army and for the first time grouped waterbearing and the Soup Kitchen together. Later, when Fernando and Lyriel were on the Throne, they awarded Waterbearers and the Soup Kitchen each separately the Falcon's Heart in February of 2001. This is a special award given to Kingdom groups who have provided service to the kingdom above that which is normally expected.

Many thanks to Mistress Jenna, Mistress Elasaith, Countess Bele Anna, and Baroness Antonia for helping me gather information and histories here in.

Event Flyer Guidelines

For Their Majesties to hold Court and for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in The Mews. Failure to do so means that the Crown cannot hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer, confirm your event with the Reeve. The Mews WILL NOT publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: <https://www.calontir.org/calendar/>

Editable: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. Work with the Social Media Officer for flyers that may be posted on social media.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1st of the month THREE MONTHS PRIOR to your event. *For Example:* If the event is in November, the flyer must be received by August 1st for the September Mews. Refer to the Calendar at the front of the Mews.

If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period. The deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!

Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

1. Name of the sponsoring group or groups
2. Day, month, and year of the event
3. Site open & close times for populace
4. Location of the event—the name of the event site, and full address.
5. Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event Steward, including contact phone and email (Needed for emergencies or issues arise)
6. Details of Registration—Do NOT use “FEE” as a descriptor for registration cost.

For Example:

Adult Event Registration: \$25
Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20
Youth 17 & Under: FREE
