King Edward I declared war on the Welsh in 1276, focused on reuniting the isle under the crown. The Welsh capitulated in 1284 with the stipulation that they would be directly ruled by a prince that “spoke no language but Welsh.” Ed agreed, and the Welsh surrendered, expecting a local lord to be appointed Prince. Instead, The King’s two month old son, later to be Ed 2, was installed. Since he couldn’t speak any non-Welsh language, he fit the terms. Since then, the heir to the Crown of England has traditionally been given the title The Prince of Wales. And now you know more Random Carp.

King's Road returns for its third year as Artemisia's premier event, a great gathering where we celebrate the myriad of endeavors that bring us together in the spirit of these Current Middle Ages. Full schedules of armored and rapier melees and tournaments, thrown weapons, equestrian, and more archery than you can shake a stick at! There's a Laurel's Prize Tourney, Classes, Merchants, Parties, and Dances. Baronial and Royal Courts. A full suite of youth activities, including social gatherings, construction workshops, archery, thrown weapons, and youth combat. Truly, something for everyone!

This year, we'll be continuing with a full-fledged MENAT area for classes, activities, parties, music, lectures, and more specific to the history of pre-16th C. Middle East, North Africa, and Turkey.

To help folks get to and from all the venues within the site, our golf cart transport system is being continued. Our site is shaded with grass and trees and has a large building we will use for court, classes, and revelry. Above-ground fire pits are welcomed. The days are long but not too hot, and the nights are cool and filled with the scents of summer. The site is damp, and we encourage responsible merrymaking.

Those planning to bring horses should contact the Kingdom Equestrian Deputy at equestrian@artemisia.sca.org to coordinate. Because this is a working ranch, no pets are allowed. Group

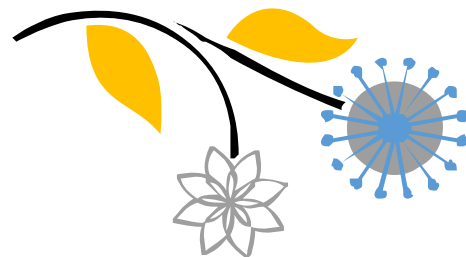

Each team must have one woman and one child aged 17 or younger, no Timmer, this is not you. We are proud to announce the return of His Excellency Master Reynhard Sebastian Von Reutte's FRIDAY NIGHT FIGHTS for another year!! Warriors choose your battle songs now! Those who neglect this important function will have a song chosen for them.

By default, this will be the Chicken Dance Song or some other equally embarrassing musical offering. The annual Thistle and Sage Tournament will be Saturday at 10am. Rapier fighters! Seek out your Baroness sponsors now!! Landed Baronesses may sponsor 3 fighters, Former Landed Baroness may sponsor 2 fighters and Court Baronesses may sponsor 1 fighter. It

Continue on Baxter Lane approximately 3.8 mile

At the large (third) roundabout take the 3rd exit (South) onto Love Lane

Continue South on Love Lane approximately 1 mile

Arrive at 4721 Love Ln (destination will be on the right) just South of the 4-way Stop

From I-90 (Eastbound) – coming from Butte

Travel East on I-90 toward Bozeman. Take Exit 305 (19th Ave / Bozeman). At the end of the ramp, turn right (South) onto N 19th Ave. Continue South approximately 1 mile. Turn right (West) onto Baxter Lane. Continue West on Baxter Lane approximately 3.8 mile. At the large (third) roundabout take the 3rd exit (South) onto Love Lane. Continue South on Love Lane approximately 1 mile. Arrive at 4721 Love Ln destination will be on the West (right) side of the road, just South of the 4-way Stop.

From the Northbound via US-191 / Huffine Ln – coming from Big Sky

Travel North on US-191 toward Bozeman. At the intersection of US-191, Jackrabbit Lane, and Huffine Lane turn East (right) to continue on US-191/Huffine Lane. Continue East on Huffine Lane for approximately 1.9 miles (left lane) *if you pass a mattress store on your right, you've gone too far*. Turn North (left) at the light at Huffine Lane & Love Lane. Continue North on Love Lane for approximately 1 mile, your destination will be on your left, just South of the 4-way stop at Durston Road. Arrive at 4721 Love Ln - destination will be on the West (left) side of the road

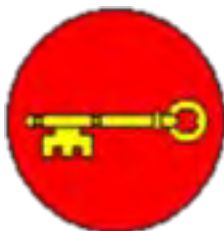
