THE SCA PROHIBITS HARASSMENT AND BULYING OF ALL INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS.

The SCA prohibits bullying and harassment of all individuals and groups. Bullying is systematic and unwelcome behavior which involves the use of influence, threat, intimidation, or coercion to cause hurt or harm to another person or group of people. When the bullying behavior is based on a protected class (1), that behavior is defined as harassment.

(1) race, sex, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, or disability.

Bullying and Harassment may be **overt**, as in the following non-inclusive list of examples:

- Verbal abuse, including using racial, homophobic, transphobic, ableist epithets, etc.
- Non-consensual physical contact, violence, or threatening gestures.
- Displaying material that is offensive, degrading, or threatening to a protected class.
- Consistent demeaning remarks or malicious teasing - Stalking or predatory behavior

Covert:

- Spreading rumors or innuendo with malicious intent
- Deliberate exclusion, isolation, or alienation of an individual without just cause
- Using rank, title, or office to intimidate others

Provided that the behavior does not rise to the criteria listed above, bullying and harassment is not:

- Single episodes of social rejection, dislike, tactlessness, or forgetfulness.
- Mutual arguments, disagreements, or fights.
- The termination, mutual or not, of a romantic relationship or friendship.
- Reasonable constructive feedback or critique.

The test for bullying is the reasonableness of the behavior and the impact of that behavior on the recipient. Participants engaging in bullying/harassment are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual believes they have been subjected to or have witnessed harassment, bullying, or retaliation, that person should contact a senechal, the President of the SCA, or that kingdom's Board Ombudsman.

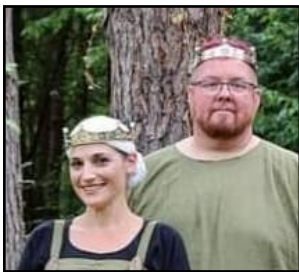

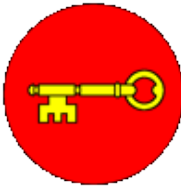
From the Kingdom Seneschal

Important Update from the Event Liaison Office
Beginning September 1, the Kingdom Bid Process will move to a fully online submission system.

This will be a two-part mandatory submission, completed at the same time:

1. Online Bid Form (Google Form)
2. Financial Worksheet (Google Sheet)

Currently, the Kingdom does not have a standardized financial Kingdom Bid form. This new worksheet ensures consistent, complete financial information for every bid and allows for easier comparison when multiple bids are submitted for the same event.

Our goal is to have the new system available for review before September 1, so groups may familiarize themselves with it early. Use before that date is optional but required starting September 1.

Archery!

The main attraction is, of course, archery. We can't wait until Saturday to begin, so the annual Flight Shoot will be on Friday evening. Saturday will see a smorgasbord of options, as we already have slated a bunch of novelty ranges, a couple woods walks, a clout range, and of course the Scarlet Guard Challenge. Speaking of which...

For the tournament itself, archers MUST bring a letter signed by the seneschal declaring them as the chosen representative of that group, as well as a small prize to be added to a gift basket which will be presented to the winner along with the ancestral banner which bears the name of all past winners and

the groups they have represented.

Thrown Weapons!

We already support the flinging of wood and metal through the air, regardless of its shape, but this year brings something special. It has been declared that the Æthelmearc Thrown Weapons Champion will be determined at the Scarlet Guard Inn! Throw for fun! Throw for glory! (Or both, both is good)

Bardic!

Come enjoy the camaraderie and entertainment of our bardic circle tradition. Whether it is under the roof of the big pavilion or gathering around our large fire ring, each night everyone is encouraged to help fill the air with songs and stories.

Camping!

Camping is free! Please feel free to stay Friday and Saturday night. There is plenty of camping space. Some already have regular spots, but it first comes first serve. Shower House

1. Exterior Access

Ramps: Concrete ramps are provided on both sides of the shower house. Ramp height is approximately 6 inches at the upper landing.

Pathways: Sidewalks leading to the en-

trances are standard width.

Entrance Configuration: A wall is positioned immediately adjacent to the doorway, creating a potentially restrictive turning radius for mobility device users. This may impede access for wheelchairs, scooters, and some rollators.

2. Exterior Shower Facilities

Each side of the building includes two outdoor spigot□style showers.

These fixtures are not designed for accessible use and do not include grab bars, privacy accommodations, or accessible controls.

3. Interior Shower Area

Total Stalls: Four indoor shower stalls.

"Accessible" Stall: One stall is slightly larger and labeled as accessible; however, it is not usable by wheelchair or scooter users due to:

Doorway width that does not meet accessibility standards (confirmed by camp maintenance).

Angled shower door that further restricts maneuverability.

Absence of properly installed grab bars (confirmed by camp maintenance).

General Access: The doorway leading into the shower area is too narrow for most mobility devices.

4. Sinks

Three stainless□steel sinks are installed at a lower height, approximately 30 inches from the ground (hip height).

While the height may benefit some users, the sinks do not appear to meet accessibility requirements for knee clearance or approach space.

5. Toilet Stalls

Total Stalls: Three toilet stalls—two standard□size stalls and one slightly larger stall.

Grab Bars: No grab bars are installed in any stall.

Stall Access: The entry to the larger stall is not wide enough to accommodate most mobility devices, limiting its functional accessibility.

In Morning Court...

Their Majesties invited both Their Heirs to join Them in Court as well as the visiting Heirs of the East Kingdom.

Their Majesties, Andreas Morgan and Kallista Morgunova, do make known that They hereby exile from the Kingdom Elliot Evans known in the SCA as Shonagon Ishiyama Gen'tarou Yori'ie for the duration of Their Reign, done this thirteenth day of December, AS LX at Her Majesty's Queen's Rapier Tournament.

In Evening Court...

Following welcoming comments from Her Majesty.. Their Majesties invited those for whom this was their first event/Royal Court.. Whereupon they were gifted goblets to share welcoming beverages..

The youth of the Kingdom were summoned for the customary "Running of the Toybox".

Domina Ophelia Demetria was invited forward to speak as the day's Event Steward, to thank both the event staff and the marshaling staff for such a wonderful day.

Brother Valentine was invited into court to read a poem he had composed in honor of Her Majesty and the Roses of the Kingdom.
