THE SCA PROHIBITS HARASSMANT AND BULYING OF ALL INDIVIDUALS AND GROUPS.

The SCA prohibits bullying and harassment of all individuals and groups. Bullying is systematic and unwelcome behavior which involves the use of influence, threat, intimidation, or coercion to cause hurt or harm to another person or group of people. When the bullying behavior is based on a protected class (1), that behavior is defined as harassment.

(1) race, sex, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, or disability.

Bullying and Harassment may be **overt**, as in the following non-inclusive list of examples:

- Verbal abuse, including using racial, homophobic, transphobic, ableist epithets, etc.
- Non-consensual physical contact, violence, or threatening gestures.
- Displaying material that is offensive, degrading, or threatening to a protected class.
- Consistent demeaning remarks or malicious teasing -Stalking or predatory behavior

Covert:

- Spreading rumors or innuendo with malicious intent
- Deliberate exclusion, isolation, or alienation of an individual without just cause
- Using rank, title, or office to intimidate others

Provided that the behavior does not rise to the criteria listed above, bullying and harassment is not:

- Single episodes of social rejection, dislike, tactlessness, or forgetfulness.
- Mutual arguments, disagreements, or fights.
- The termination, mutual or not, of a romantic relationship or friendship.
- Reasonable constructive feedback or critique.

The test for bullying is the reasonableness of the behavior and the impact of that behavior on the recipient. Participants engaging in bullying/harassment are subject to appropriate sanctions. If an individual believes they have been subjected to or have witnessed harassment, bullying, or retaliation, that person should contact a seneschal, the President of the SCA, or that kingdom's Board Ombudsman.





Court Reports

Court of Murcoch and Rioghnach at A+S Faire + Queens Prize Tourney July 5th, 2025

Documented from the Rolls and Files of the Coram Regibus of Murdoch II Rex and Ríoghnách II Regina, King and Queen of Æthelmearc: Being a True Record of the Business of Their Royal Court at the Arts & Sciences Faire, 5 July, AS LX, in the Shire of Abhainn Ciach Ghlais. As recorded by Gwendolyn the Graceful, Meistr-y-gân, Jewel of Æthelmearc Herald, assisted by Mistress Gytha Oggsdottir, Silver Sycamore Herald.

In the morning, Their Majesties granted Master Friderich Schwarzwalder, Event Steward, leave to make some brief announcements.

Their Majesties then called for Mistress Irene von Schmetterling and inquired if everything was prepared for her. They then invited Master Aeron Harper to take her red collar so that she might face unencumbered choice, whether to be inducted into the Most Noble Order of Defense. It was also announced that new Chancellors of the Æcademy had been invested: The Honorable Lady Elinor Walden and Oyama-jū shichi-i Michiharu.

Their Majesties next requested the presence of Lady Lartia Cerva. Her Majesty shared how happy They were to finally have her before the Throne, since word had reached the Crown generations past, and that They had wished to recognize her during the reign of Murdoch I and Ríoghnach I. Her Majesty recounted that this event was the anniversary of their meeting, and that in the year since, They have come to appreciate her artistry, her knowledge, and her friendship. Further, They were pleased to have heard Their own opinions echoed by others with a high level of discernment. So it was that They invited the Noble Order of the Fleur d'Æthelmearc to join Them and Granted her Arms to name her their Companion. Their Majesties also requested that Baroness Anastasie de Lamoure come forth before releasing the Noble Order of the Fleur d'Æthelmearc, whereupon They spoke with Her Excellency of the many years and many cloaks, capes, hoods, and other object adorned with her embroidery, and deemed with the Order's assent that it was time Her Excellency be numbered among them. At this time, Their Majesties recalled Mistress Irene von Schmetterling, and inquired if she had reached her decision. She runs workshops, book clubs, and hosts historical sword seminars featuring some of the best teachers in the Known World. In short, William gave ample evidence that there is hardly an accomplishment within the rapier community that she had not achieved. Finally, Their Majesties heard words from two of her students: Brehyres Muirgheal inghen Dubhghaill shared Irene's wisdom, that everyone has something to teach and everyone has something to learn, saying that if Irene could turn her

into a passable fencer, she could train anyone, and that she brings everything she is to the field. Lady Sionnan de la Ronde spoke of how fortunate she has been to have encountered Irene almost immediately in her brief time in the Society. She related with passion the challenges that Irene explained continue to face women and gender minorities in martial specialties, and Irene's unfailing persistence, claiming space without apology. She concluded by saying that although she sometimes feels the intimidation of those challenges, Irene has been both motivator and inspiration. and she imparted her teacher's advice to find out what works, delegate, advocate for herself, push for the time and training she needs, and refuse to compromise when it comes to her goals. Pleased by these words of support, Their Majesties declared it most proper to proceed and invited the Most Noble Order of the Masters of Defence to join them. Irene was then bedecked with garters, a cote, a hood, the ancestral collar of Æthelmearc, and personal collars. Thus adorned, she drew her own sword with which to swear fealty to the Crown. Thus Her Ladyship received the Queen's token of Inspiration for the day.

Their Majesties then called all scribes and wordsmiths who had contributed to the Court to accept charms against the demon Titivillus, along with book charms for each scroll that had been presented that day.

Their Majesties once more gave leave to His Grace, Duke Timothy, to make an announcement about a demo, organized by Maîtres Elyse le Bref that the Shire was holding that coming Tuesday, at Camp Victory, a camp for children with cancer, and request that anyone who was at all available that evening to please assist with the demo.

There being no further business, Court was closed.
