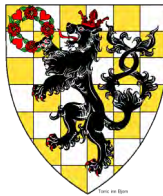

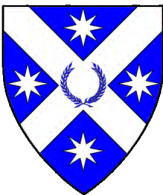

12th Night Peers Silent Auction

The 12th Night Peers Auction, *formerly known as the Twelfth Knight Auction*, started approximately in 2001. It takes place at the Twelfth Night Coronation event. This auction was originally a live auction run by the Knights to benefit a chosen charity. Due to lack of auctioneers and time crunches for Court business, the live auction was turned into a silent auction in 2016.

In 2017 for the 2018 auction, Duke Styrkarr Jarlskald lobbied to change the auction from only allowing Knights to sponsor donated items to allowing all Peers to sponsor donors. Peers are encouraged to work with the Populace to encourage their submissions by sponsoring. Sponsorship looks different to different Peers, so they are also encouraged to help other Peers discover people to sponsor!

Each year, the outgoing Crown is asked to choose a charity to donate the Auctions Proceeds to. This year, Their Most Royal Majesties Achaxe and Octamasades have determined that we should aid the mighty mission to fight for human rights across our Nation. The American Civil Liberties Union is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization (tax ID #13-6213516) that "dares to create a more perfect union — beyond one person, party, or side. Our mission is to realize this promise of the United States Constitution for all and expand the reach of its guarantees." (www.ACLU.org)

All donations must be sponsored by a Peer. Royal Peers, Knights, Masters of Arms, Laurels, Pelicans, Members of the Order of Defense, and Members of the Order of the Mark are all encouraged to sponsor a populace member's donation or to donate themselves. How Sponsorship works is up to the Peer and Donor. Each Peer sees Sponsorship differently and is encouraged to help Donors find a Sponsor that fits the Donors needs, so if you are considering submitting, but unsure how to proceed - please don't hesitate to approach the Nearest Peer and ask!

SCA Canada Working Group

This is an introduction to the SCA Canada Working Group, a Canadian-led initiative. Canada is a different legal jurisdiction from the US, and our group is investigating the SCA's compliance with Federal and Provincial requirements.

To do this work, Canadian representatives from the six Kingdoms with branches in Canada have been deputized by their Crowns and Kingdom Seneschals. Over the next year, we will be consulting Canadian lawyers and other experts to answer our guiding question: What is the best way for the SCA to operate in the Canadian jurisdiction? We are only looking at modern legal issues, not at the game side of the SCA for Canadian groups.

Once we have recommendations, a report will be given to the Kingdoms and the President of the SCA. Further steps will depend on the options open to us.

Right now, we are in fact-finding mode. We will provide updates as we have them. Stay tuned.

The Crier Editor is a deputy to the Kingdom Chroniclers office and is responsible for publishing the Kingdom newsletter, the Crier. It is important that there be a deputy in this role - the Crier being late to Society is not an option! So if the Editor cannot publish, the Chronicler can cover for them, but only if there is two-deep.

The skills needed for this job are:

Ability to meet a deadline. The Crier is published monthly by the Society and this must be done on time, every time without fail.

Ability to use word processing equipment - the Crier is currently formatted in MS Publisher, however we need to establish a new program as MS is discontinuing MSPub support.

Access to email, Facebook and Discord. Especially near the end of the month checking email every day - and multiple times a day - is very important as the Crown and Kingdom officers may have last minute additions that must be published.

Skill at layout and design - some things must be in the Crier, and some things are at the editors discretion. You have a bit of leeway for creative content that showcases the brilliance of An Tir.

This job has NO travel requirements. The Kingdom Chronicler must attend Kingdom events, but the Crier Editor is a deputy and does not have to. There is also no equipment to manage, this office is 100% online with it's own Kingdom account. You will need a computer.

The Kingdom Missile Combat Deputy is the officer responsible for overseeing missile combat reporting and activities in the marshallate. Applicants for this position must have at least two years of experience as a Senior Missile Combat Marshal.

Duties include:

- Reviewing new Senior Missile Marshal authorization promotions for concurrence
- Quarterly reporting to the Kingdom Armored Marshal
- Quarterly reporting to the Society Deputy Marshal for Combat Archery
- Collection, review, and archival of Missile Combat MIC reports
- Working with the Armored Combat Marshal to review and update the missile combat portion of the An Tir Book of Combat (ABC's) as appropriate

IMPORTANT PROCESS CHANGE from the Office of the Kingdom Largesse Coordinator:

It is with sadness that we announce we are pausing the international movement of largesse within the Kingdom.

Due to the unfortunate times we are in regarding tariffs and border inspection issues, the question of whether it is responsible to attempt to transport quantities of largesse into the United States from our Canadian populace was raised. In consultation with the Crown and Heirs, consensus has been reached that at this time we will be pausing the official transfer of donated largesse south into the U.S. Individuals can of course still make the choice for themselves to transport items across to donate to the Crown and therefore address any duties personally if inspected but neither the Crown nor official Kingdom couriers will be doing so until mundane trade policy changes.

We deeply regret that this is the situation we find ourselves in and are incredibly sorrowed that we will be unable to continue to facilitate the physical sharing of the amazing and generous contributions of our Tir Righ makers with the rest of the Kingdom. We hope this will change in the near future but must proceed under the current mundane reality for now.

Some ways to expand the visibility of our amazing donors throughout the Kingdom was already in the works before this decision, and we hope this upcoming boost will help compensate for the decrease our generous Tir Righ artisans face but we know it's not the same. Spreading your word fame is still of utmost importance to us, please stay tuned for this update!

How will this change in procedure affect donation to Kingdom and Kingdom use of largesse within Tir Righ?

While our Crown is US based, any official visits made to Tir Righ will only involve gifting to the Event Steward and all other gifting between the Crown and dignitaries will pause. However, if our Crown is Canadian based gifting between the Crown and dignitaries at events in Tir Righ will likely resume (at the Crown's discretion). This means that having a Canadian stockpile of Kingdom Largesse is still desired, however items may see long lags between donation and use unless the situation changes. We very much understand this may change donation habits!

If you are a Canadian An Tirian who has largesse in holding with the Kingdom Regional Deputy there Sine Gunnsdottir (Janis James) and would like your items reallocated to the Principality please reach out and let us know, we will be happy to arrange that. We can also get them back to you or hold on to them in the hopes that things change in the near future or we have a Canadian based Crown! With this shift the previous position of Kingdom Largesse Regional Deputy for Tir Righ will become a hybrid position, becoming Regional/Storage Deputy Tir Righ.

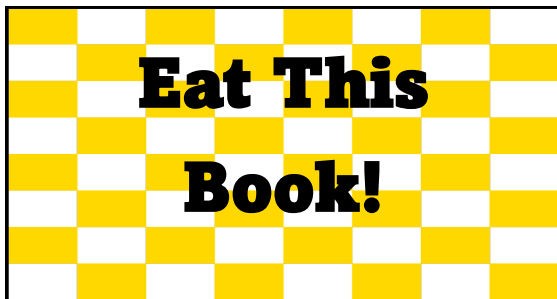

Storing a Canvas Tent for Winter



Camping season is over for many of us and now it is time to store that medieval pavilion away for the winter. It is good to follow a care and maintenance plan for what is likely a significant investment in gear.

If you're storing your tent away for the season or simply need a place to keep it out of the way for a while, here are some good rules to follow – even if it's not a canvas tent.

Keep it Dry

If you're returning from a camping trip and your tent is damp, (from either from rain, dew, or snow) OR you're using a non-breathable synthetic tent, you should set up your tent in your yard to dry it out when you get home. If you don't have the space to do this, some people hang, or lay the tent out in their garage or other large outdoor space. Try to get as much ventilation as possible and add a fan if you can

Store your tent OFF the floor.

The floor materials in a typical storage area (garage, shed, basement) are often at risk of flooding or other moisture related accidents. Keeping your tent from contacting these materials will reduce the risk of damage.

*Sometimes the canvas or tent material is dry, but the vinyl/PVC groundsheet is wet. This should be toweled off and dried before being wrapped up.

Rodent Proof Your Storage

Consider a Rubbermaid tote or even a large sealable trash can. Keeping your tent and gear protected from rodents and other pests is an added bonus!

Extra Help Won't Hurt

You can stash a moisture absorber dehumidifier with your tent and camping gear. Look for one with a color scale indicator to help determine when they are saturated. Some people use these in their bathrooms to avoid moisture buildup, but they are great to put in with your tent and gear. If you're looking for a DIY option, some homesteaders will use a double set of wool socks filled with talcum powder

Clean Your Tent

Make sure that your tent is as clean as possible, before storing. Even if it looks clean, it can never hurt to at least give it a good wipedown (remember to let it dry!). Mold spores are often unseen in the early stages of growth. Remember, the nutrients in dirt can be food for MOLD!

How Long CAN You Store a Wet Tent?

As little time as possible. Sometimes you don't have a choice but to pack up a wet tent. What then? We've often packed up 100+ tents after a music festival, like Bonnaroo, and had to move on to the next location. In these cases, we dry the floors as well as possible, pack them up, then re-open and set them all up 4-5 days later and things are still okay. You can usually smell a little musty smell, but with a healthy dose of warm sun, ventilation, and freshening up, they're all just fine once they've dried. This said, there is always a chance that we'll have a particularly nasty mold strain at a site that could cause major issues for us upon re-opening. If we have tents that have to be cleaned and re-treated, we have the team to do that maintenance and get them back on the road.

Cold Versus Warm

A wet COLD tent will have a slower mold growth than a wet WARM tent. We've heard of people putting their wet tents in a chest freezer until they can set them up to dry! Note: cold does not STOP the growth of mold, only slows it down. Plan ahead!

With a bit of care and following some simple steps that canvas tent can last for a lifetime.

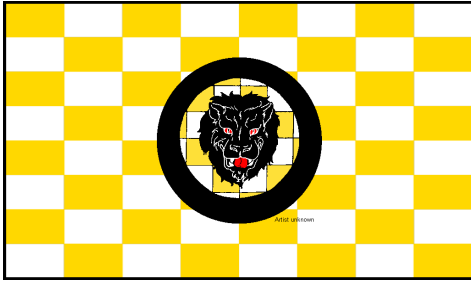

Notice About Submitting Event Copy

Why events must be published – Kingdom Law: *"for an event to be considered official, event copy needs to be published in the Crier at minimum once in the issue of the month in which the event occurs."* An event must be official if Royals are present (this includes branch Coronets) so that any business conducted in Court can be recorded and published. All Branches in An Tir must have at least one official event per year in the Crier to maintain their status. All event copy should be sent to CrierEditor@antir.org and needs to follow a specific format, please ask for a copy of the format if you do not already have one. In order for copy to be published you must email the Crier Editor. No other method ie: calendar links, forms, etc should be used - *they will NOT work*. **Remember: The deadline is the first of the month PRIOR to your event!**

Nothing will get you in the Crier except an email to the Crier Editor.

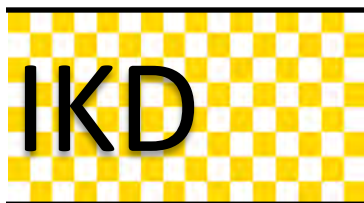

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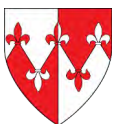
