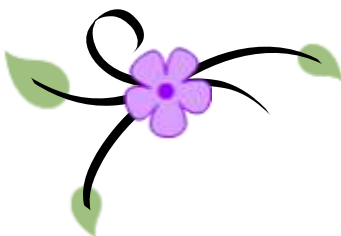

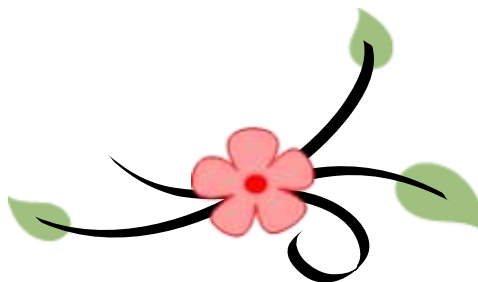

## Random Carp that I have learned

A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

Once upon a time, you could not just get more paper by swinging by Staple Mart and get 500 sheets. Parchment production takes a while. As such, every bit of space matters, and you'd best not leave big blank areas just because you are starting a new thought. The Greeks first used a horizontal line *parágraphos* or "written in the margin" to the left of the main text. Eventually it evolved into using the letter Gamma (Γ) and later into the well known *litterae notabiliores*, a larger, frequently decorated or illuminated first letter to start a new section. But scribes sometimes have better things to do than to make a big fancy letter. In Latin, the notation became the letter K for *caput* or "head" for a new thesis. For a less formal break, a *capitulum* or little head, letter c marked a new section.

By the Middle ages, the c was simply stylized with vertical bars:  $\mathbb{C}$ , which quickly evolved into a symbol we are all familiar with (though not its name) the pilcrow: ¶. Scribes would leave a space for a hand-drawn pretty pilcrow or first letter, but it wasn't always done by a deadline, so maybe they put in a simple pilcrow, or they just left that space blank, leaving an indent. Indents were faster and cheaper, so now the beginning of a new paragraph is denoted by an indentation. And now you know more Random Carp.
