Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. This can be done by filling in the calendar event date request form on the Kingdom web page: https://drachenvald.sea.org/events/calendar-add/ Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web form.

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event .
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- · Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

Midvinter 20 - 20 December 2025 Holmrike - Sweden

The Shire of Holmrike welcomes all of Drachenwald to find warmth and inspiration at this year's Midwinter event or in Swedish - Midvinter!

Come join us and walk to the ancient castle ruins Gåseborg, listen to the story of Nordmark and Holmrike's beginning by the firelight and join the torchlight procession home in the dark ending in an evening with a potluck feast in central Stockholm.

We start 12:30 at Dragspelsvägen bus stop in Järfälla to walk through the forest to Gåseborg.

We reassemble after Gåseborg at 18:00 in Holmrike's temporary feasthall at Stagneliusvägen 25 for a potluck bring your shared food for a feast together and a cosy relaxing evening ending at 22:00. No sleepover available it is just a one-day event.

The Midwinter celebration is held at Gåseborg fornborg (no street address). Meetup at the busstop 12:30 at Dragspelsvägen (adres is near Hummelmoravägen 13 in Järfälla), where also street parking is available at Trumpetvägen close by the entrance to the path through the woods.

For those using public transport, the local bus starts at Jakobsberg Pendeltåg station then bus 553V to Viksjö bus stop is Dragspelsvägen (in Järfälla-Stockholm).

The walk to Gåseborg is a walk through the woods and up the mountain on often slippery steps at the end of the walk so dress accordingly to the weather and the perhaps muddy or frozen snowy ground that day. It is OK to have extra modern layers underneath the period clothing and suitable outdoor hiking shoes. We usually spend about 3 hours outdoors having sausages by the firepit and warm glögg, enjoying the fantastic view and welcoming the return of the sun and remembering the beginnings of Nordmark until sundown

when we start towards the city and warmth.


