## Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web form.

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event.
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

The Shire of Holmrike welcomes all of Drachenwald to find warmth and inspiration at this year's Midwinter event or in Swedish - Midvinter!

Come join us and walk to the ancient castle ruins Gäseborg, listen to the story of Nordmark and Holmrike's beginning by the firelight and join the torchlight procession home in the dark ending in an evening with a potluck feast in central Stockholm.

We start 12:30 at Dragspelsvägen bus stop in Järfälla to walk through the forest to Gäseborg.  
We reassemble after Gäseborg at 18:00 in Holmrike's temporary feasthall at Stagneliusvägen 25 for a potluck bring your shared food for a feast together and a cosy relaxing evening ending at 22:00. No sleepover available it is just a one-day event.

We usually spend about 3 hours outdoors having sausages by the firepit and warm glögg, enjoying the fantastic view and welcoming the return of the sun and remembering the beginnings of Nordmark until sundown

when we start towards the city and warmth.

The evening potluck takes place in Holmrike's temporary feasthall at Stagneliusvägen 25, Stockholm. Closest subway station is Thorildsplan, closest bus stop is Viktor Rydbergs gata with bus 61 from Kristineberg or Fridhemsplan. The site opens at 12:30 and closes at 22:00

The cottages do not have indoor toilets or running water. There is a maintenance building near the cottages with indoor toilets (and showers), a hall and a kitchen. Five of the cottages are close to the main building, three a little further away.

On the shore near the maintenance building there is a (small) sauna with showers. The sauna only has one changing room, a washroom and a steam room, so some of the saunas are mixed saunas. (Although the sauna has been renovated so I'm not sure how it's set up.)

The site is not completely accessible (the yard/walking paths are wooded, there are a lot of bunk beds, the toilets in the main building are small, etc.), but all buildings have some kind of ramps. We take into account the needs of the participants as much as possible, e.g. lower bed, roommates, diets, gender-neutral toilets and showers, sauna shifts, event materials and instructions, lights, etc. so let us know what you need and we'll try to help.

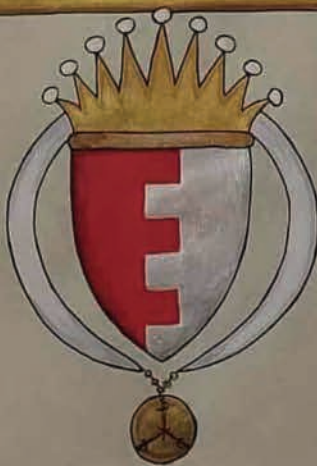

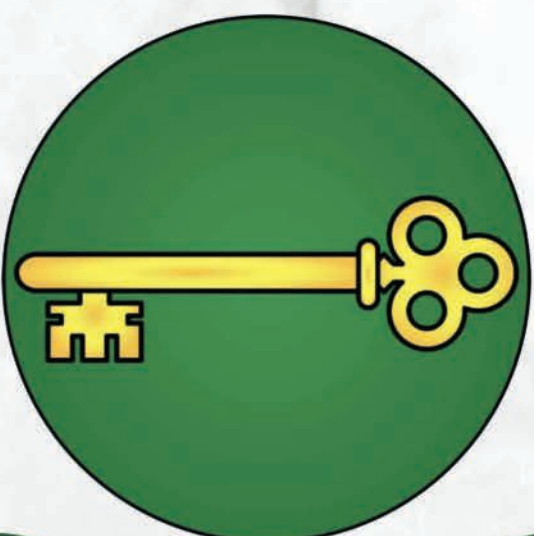
