From The Kingdom Carl Marshal

Hello from my estates of Hundehugel.

Today, I would like to talk about Marshals in Charge (MiC) of Events

As the Society Handbook tells us about Marshalling: There are three near-equal priorities in marshaling; safety, fair witness, and showmanship.

Briefly, what the Marshal in Charge is responsible for:

- 1. Organizing the marshaling.
- Checking that the field can be safely fought upon,
- 3. Arranging for equipment inspection.
- 4. Arranging for marshals for all of the combat.

Reporting on the event, including any incidents

Marshaling Single Combat. This is a high level list. All Marshals should read the Society Handbook for full discussions of each point

- 1. At minimum, there should be one marshal for single combat. Two or three will be able to see more of the fight. Four or more will get in each other's way and block the view from the sidelines without providing noticeably better marshaling.
- 2. As the fighters come onto the field, take a quick look to see if they have their full armor, especially elbow, neck, and hand armor. These are the likeliest to be removed and then forgotten.

- 3. Once the fight has started, watch particularly for broken armor, lost tempers, injuries, and unauthorized people/pets/objects on the field. (Outsiders, especially small children and pets, do not always realize that they are supposed to stay off of the field during combat.)
- 4. If the first cry of "Hold!" does not cause the fighters to stop, get in between the fighters (or between the fighters and whoever or whatever has wandered onto the field) and block the weapons with your staff until the fighting stops. Keep yelling "Hold!" while you do so that eventually they may notice
- 5. You are expected to be an impartial witness to exactly what happens during a fight. Ideally, you should be able to describe the last 3 4 blows on your side of the fight: where they started, their angle of approach, how they were blocked or where they landed.

In order to be able to answer as accurately as possible, you need as clear a view as possible. This means being close to the fight. You need to strike a balance between getting closer to see better and staying back out of range of the blows.

In order to be a fair witness, a Marshal should not have a stake in the outcome of the tournament. They should not be fighting in the tournament.

I-406 The Royal Badges may be displayed by the Crown; used to identify the Crown's property; or worn by men-at-arms, ladies-in-waiting, retainers and entourage, heralds, Kingdom officers, or other servants of the Crown.

XI-605 There shall exist an Award of the Crown's Favour, which the Crown may bestow as they see fit. Should the Crown style themselves with an alternate title as approved by Society, they may present the Award with that alternate title, and shall be noted on the Order of Precedence.

Duties of Officer of State

VII-106 (remove Calendar Secretary - responsible for maintaining the Kingdom calendar of events,)
VII-104 The Seneschal shall be responsible for soliciting bids for Kingdom events as defined in Article IV and for the maintenance ensuring they appear on the Kingdom Calendar of Events.

Add the following

VII-900 The **Kingdom Chatelaine** shall be responsible for promoting and fostering recruitment and retention of members of the Society within the Kingdom.

VII-901 The Kingdom Chatelaine shall be responsible for the conduct of any kingdom level demonstrations or recruiting events.

VII-902 The Kingdom Chatelaine shall appoint deputies as necessary to fulfill the requirements of the office.

VII-903 The Kingdom Chatelaine shall adhere to the laws governing financial accounting and contracts (Article XVI) and the Kingdom Operating Policies, Section One – Financial, when administering the financial aspects of the office. The Kingdom Chatelaine shall report to the Kingdom Exchequer regarding all financial matters pertaining to the office.

VII-904 The Kingdom Chatelaine and all subordinate officers will provide to the appropriate branch seneschal a copy of those reports necessary to maintain branch status by a date mutually acceptable to the officer and the branch seneschal.

VII-1000 The Kingdom DEIB Officer shall be responsible for promoting an equitable, open and welcoming environment in the Kingdom to cultivate a climate in which all members are treated fairly and able to thrive.

VII-1001 The Kingdom DEIB Officer shall appoint deputies as necessary to fulfill the requirements of the office.

VII-1002 The Kingdom DEIB Officer will refer any inquiries, concerns or incidents involving violations of the Society's inclusivity policies to the Kingdom Seneschal or Kingdom Lawspeaker as appropriate.

IX-101 Due to the nature of the work required of the Lawspeaker, the position of Lawspeaker will be a warranted deputy of the Kingdom Seneschal, for the purposes of Legal and Insurance coverage. This warrant is to be enacted by the Crown, and Kingdom Seneschal when the Lawspeaker takes office, to be renewed for the entire term of office of the Lawspeaker. The only process by which this warrant can be revoked is outlined in section IX-600. It is hereby noted that while the Lawspeaker is a warranted deputy of the Kingdom Seneschal, the Lawspeaker shall not report any confidential mediation, arbitration or consultation issues to the Kingdom Seneschal, unless all involved parties request it. the Lawspeaker

is not a Seneschal and does not report to the Kingdom Seneschal, nor does the Kingdom Seneschal have any influence on the Office of Lawspeaker. The Lawspeaker stands outside the-formal reporting structure of the Kingdom, the better to act as a mediator, ombudsman and-councilor to the Crown and people of Ealdormere.

IX-400 The term of office for the Lawspeaker shall be three years. The outgoing Lawspeaker may be considered an eligible candidate assuming they receive the required nominations and is confirmed by the Kingdom Seneschal, Sovereign, Consort, or either of the Crown Heirs.

IX-500 In the event the Lawspeaker is unable to fulfill their duties; they shall appoint an interim replacement subject to ratification by the Crown and Kingdom Seneschal. The Kingdom Seneschal and Crown may choose to allow the interim replacement to act for a stated period of time. At the end of this period, the Lawspeaker may resume their duties. The period of absence shall be included as part of the Lawspeaker's term in office. Or the Crown may choose to ask the Kingdom Seneschal to proceed with the selection process upon ratification of the interim replacement. The selection procedure as outlined in IX-300 shall be initiated immediately.


Add

IX-804 The Lawspeaker shall not be responsible for any investigations requested by the Society Board of Directors or Society Officers, deferring to the Kingdom Seneschal in such matters. The Kingdom Seneschal may involve the Lawspeaker as a deputy or appointed representative at their discretion.

X-203 There is a slate of local officers consisting, at minimum, of a Seneschal and an Exchequer and either a Pursuivant, a Marshal, a Minister of Arts and Sciences, or a Chatelaine.

X-303 There is a full slate of local officers consisting at minimum of a Seneschal, Pursuivant, Exchequer, a Chronicler, and either a Marshal, Minister of Arts & Sciences, Clerk-Register, or a Chatelaine.

XIV-300 Any subject of Ealdormere may ask the Lawspeaker to investigate and mediate disputes within the Kingdom. If the Lawspeaker cannot mediate the situation, the Crown shall direct the Lawspeaker to appoint a Court of Inquiry. A subject of Ealdormere under banishment retains this right.




