## Submission Guidelines

**ARTICLES** on period topics, history, art, puzzles, SCA life, bardic stories and the like are welcome additions to *The Pale*. A 500- to 1000-word article will usually fit in one issue; longer articles will be split into multiple parts to appear in successive issues. Submit the file in MS Word .doc format along with an SCA Creative Release form. Send the images used in the article as separate files using the format described below.

You must cite all references, quotations and sources in your article using the Chicago Manual of Style format. Sample citations are located here: [www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools\\_citationguide.html](http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html). Citing sources is very important to avoid accusations of plagiarism and legal action for copyright violation.

**IMAGES**, such as line art, calligraphy, illumination and photographs are also welcome. Scan any artwork at 300 dpi and save it at the highest quality JPG setting. Photos should also be 300 dpi, high quality JPGs. All images will appear in print as black and white, but the online version of *The Pale* is in color. Images can also be submitted as high quality TIF or PDF files. Any artwork or photography submitted to *The Pale* must have a signed SCA Creative Release or SCA Photographer Release form from the artist sent in with the work. Any person identifiable in an image must submit a signed SCA Model Release form with the art work. This is a requirement of SCA Inc. for print publication. All release forms are available at [www.midrealm.org/chronicler](http://www.midrealm.org/chronicler) under "Documents and Forms for Chroniclers".

**EVENT PREVIEWS:** A free event preview of 50 words is available to all events. **The listing MUST include the name of the event, sponsoring group, site address, date, times and event steward contact information.**

**EVENT NOTICES** (ads) must be published in *The Pale* for events at which any of the following occur: Crown and Coronet tournaments, coronations and investitures, appointment of Kingdom or Principality officers, presentation of awards and titles, proclamation of law, establishment or advancement of branches. **These activities cannot take place unless a complete event notice appears in *The Pale*, the Middle Kingdom newsletter, at least once before the date of the event.** The publication requirement may only be waived in extraordinary circumstances, such as a natural disaster.

Events must **already** be listed on the Middle Kingdom Calendar prior to advertising in *The Pale*, but an event listing on the Middle Kingdom Calendar does **NOT** constitute "official publication". Incipient groups must submit a scan of the sponsorship form to the Editor. **Event submissions to the Kingdom Calendar should be submitted through the online form available on the calendar page.** Contact the Middle Kingdom Calendar Secretary at [calendar@midrealm.org](mailto:calendar@midrealm.org) with any issues. **Middle Kingdom events receive free event ads** that run in the next issue unless otherwise specified. Out-of-Kingdom events and merchants pay the listed rates.

Ad templates for the quarter and half page ads are available at <https://midrealm.org/chronicler/thepale/>. All ads must be submitted to *The Pale* via e-mail attachment in DOC, PDF, JPG, or TIF format.

**WITHOUT EXCEPTION, EVENT NOTICES MUST INCLUDE event name, sponsoring group, dates, times, site address, site registration, website URL, name (SCA & modern) of the event steward, and a contact email address of the event steward.** Simple driving directions to the event site are useful but not required. All images in event notices must have a source listed and be used in accordance with the terms of use. **Original artwork MUST include an SCA Creative Release form from the author(s) or artist(s). SCA Model Releases are required for identifiable persons in any image.** Submissions are edited for grammar, spelling, space constraints, inflammatory or explicit language and compliance with Middle Kingdom Law. Editorial decisions are final. "Letters to the Editor" are not permitted per SCA Inc. regulations.

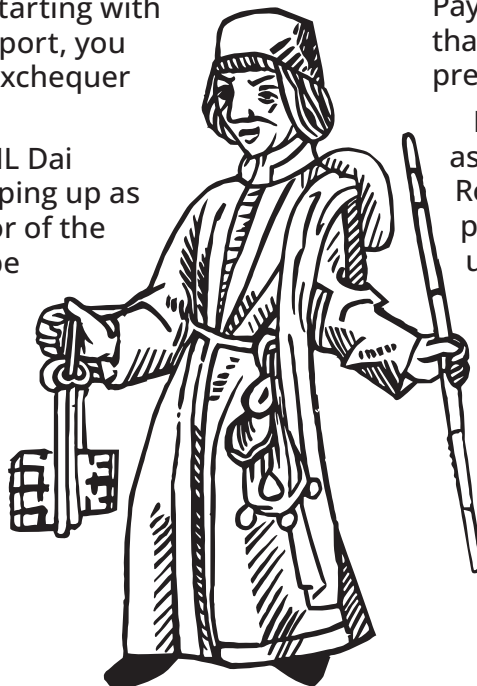
**Hi, all!**

## Opinicus Pursuivant (Notifications)

### Reports to Middle Kingdom Dragon Herald

The Opinicus Pursuivant is the notifications deputy for the Middle Kingdom. They notify submitters of Kingdom and Society-level decisions on their name and armory submissions. This role is a good fit for someone who is interested in the heraldic submissions process and would like to get more involved. Some familiarity with the OSCAR system is encouraged but not required.

### Job Responsibilities

- Notify submitters of Kingdom-level decisions regarding their submissions
- Notify submitters of Society-level decisions regarding their submissions
- Updating kingdom office records to reflect the status of submissions

- Respond to email communications in a timely manner
- Work with the submissions team as needed.

### Requirements

- Paid SCA membership
- Reliable and responsive access to email
- Strong written communication skills
- General internet/computer literacy skills
- Comfort with using social media, including Facebook and Discord

## Deputy for Group Transitions

The Middle Kingdom Deputy for Group Transitions is responsible for managing Baronial and group transition opinion polls for the populace. This person should be a steadfast communicator who is comfortable working in a variety of communication platforms — including email, social media, virtual meetings (Zoom), and by telephone as needed. The individual should be comfortable reaching out to the populace and Crown. Role is primarily performed at home, outside of events.

### Requirements:

- Proficiency with Google Workspace (Drive, Forms, Sheets, Docs)
- Reliable internet access via computer and smartphone
- Timely communication (response time within ~4 hours preferred) across email,

social media, phone, and virtual platforms (e.g., Zoom)

- Professional, confident communication with individuals at all levels (including the Crown, Barons, and Baronesses)
- Ability to maintain strict confidentiality and responsibly handle sensitive information, including use of AI-assisted tools for processing commentary
- Strong organizational skills with accurate recordkeeping
- Commitment to fairness, respect, and due process

## Middle Kingdom A&S Faire for Non-Artists

Every year, the familiar posts begin. “Participate in the A&S Faire! Sign-ups are starting now! Let us help you with your documentation!” For many artists, it’s a siren call. They feel the excitement, bring out the work they’ve been perfecting, and spend hours writing and editing their documentation.

But what if you don’t consider yourself an artist? What if you are an artist, but competition just isn’t your thing? What’s in it for you to come to the Faire? Quite a lot actually.

For those who enter the Faire, they are putting forward the closest they can get to period work. Be it a beer with a hint of sourness from wild yeast, an experiment on garden-grown dyes on wool, a rendition of Beowulf in Old English, or a 13th century dagger forged in coal, every artist has done

something special. They have developed – through dogged research and trial and error – a unique view into the medieval world.

There are few other venues in the Kingdom that rewards this level of period accuracy. That makes it an extraordinary opportunity for everyone else: a chance to learn directly from the hard work of others and to get as close as we can to museum level artifacts, techniques, and knowledge—without ever leaving the Kingdom. Sitting with them, asking questions, listening to their stories, and offering encouragement is one of the most meaningful ways we can support them.

And learning is only part of it. Simply showing up matters. Even if you never enter, the Faire is still for you. Come to learn. Come to support. Come to celebrate the curiosity, dedication, and creativity that make our Kingdom what it is.

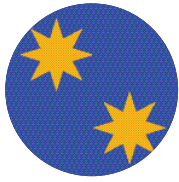

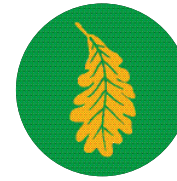

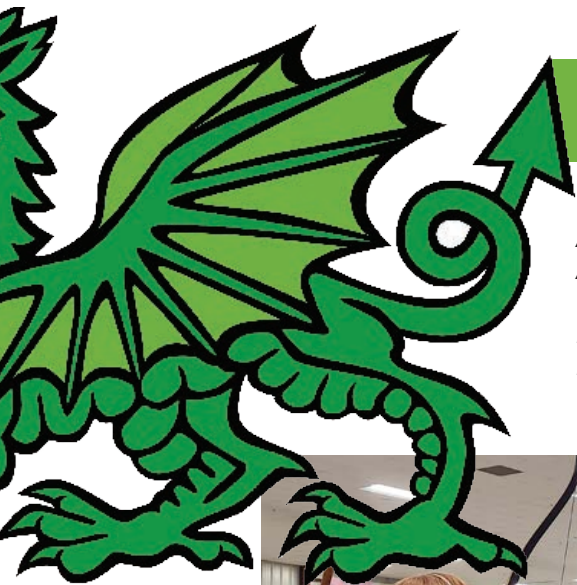
