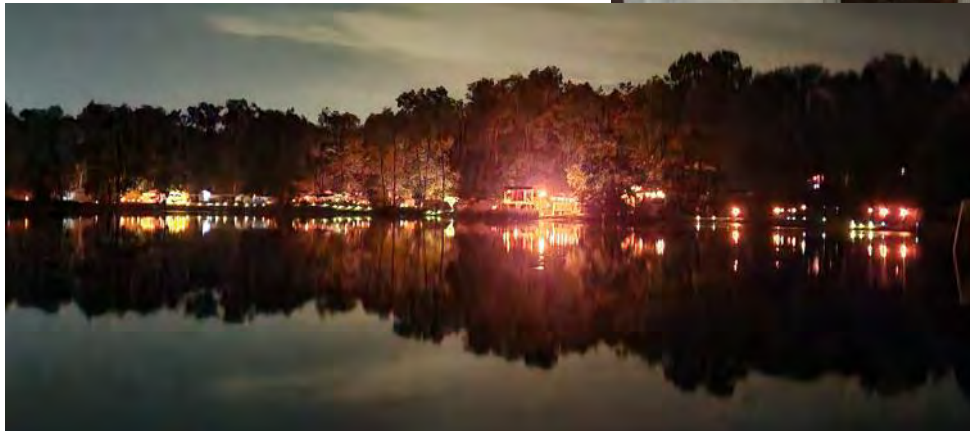

A full suite of youth activities, including social gatherings, construction workshops, archery, thrown weapons, and youth combat. Truly, something for everyone!

This year, we'll be continuing with a full-fledged MENAT area for classes, activities, parties, music, lectures, and more specific to the history of pre-16th C. Middle East, North Africa, and Turkey.

To help folks get to and from all the venues within the site, our golf cart transport system is being continued. Our site is shaded with grass and trees and has a large building we will use for court, classes, and revelry.

Random Carp that I have learned

A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

Muhammad ibn Musa al-Khwarizmi, thanks for nothing. No, seriously. Al-Khwarizmi (c. 780- c. 850) was a mathematician in the Abbasid Caliphate, working in Baghdad. His treatise compiled between 813-833, Al-Jabr (see where Algebra came from?) looked at linear and quadratic equations, and was the first text to give Algebra its own independent discipline with reducing and balancing equations, and his name, al-Khwarizmi led to the term algorithm. One important discussion in al-Jabr, was explaining that if no number appears in the place of tens in a calculation, a little circle should be used “to keep the rows.” This circle was called *şifr*. This circle signifying a holding place reached Western Europe in the 11th century, starting the migration from using Roman numerals to using Arabic numerals for scientific and mathematical study. So the *şifr*, or zero came into use for technical needs, though dates would continue to use the Roman method for hundreds of years more. While East Asia used it in text before, we can thank al-Khwarizmi for *şifr*, aka zero, or nothing. And now you know more Random Carp.
