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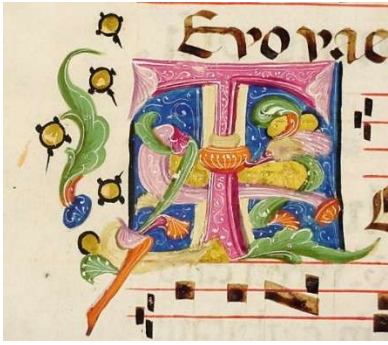

Contents: This special issue contains revisions to what is now called Division B—Recognitions and Titles, and Division C—Appendices. Division B contains the following Titles: Precedence, Symbols of Rank, and Oaths of Fealty; Armory Awards, and Orders. Division C contains Appendix A—Kingdom Events.

Notes: I have tried to note where substantive changes were made and explain the reasoning. In the event of a conflict of content or punctuation between the Comparison of Changes section and the laws in their entirety, the latter is correct.

Commentary timeframe: The commentary on this section will be open for two months from the date of publication of this issue (August 1).

What's next: After the commentary period has passed, Stallari will determine if any necessary changes are considered substantive or non-substantive. If a change is considered substantive, the change will be put out for another commentary period. If the change is considered non-substantive, no additional commentary will be solicited. Once there is no further commentary, Stallari will vote to adopt the new laws and a law court will be held to read the laws in. The law court will be scheduled once the commentary period has elapsed.

The branch may, with notice to the Stallari Council, donate the funds to an IRS-approved charitable institution. b. PENALTY.—Failure to do one of the two above will result in the last known funds being reported to the IRS as personal income for the last reported Branch Chancellor of the Exchequer and Seneschal.	SEC. 720. DISSOLUTION OF BRANCHES. a. FINANCIAL DISGORGEMENT.—Any branch that disbands or is dissolved by the Board of Directors must turn over all remaining funds to the Kingdom Chancellor of the Exchequer.	This is a change from the edition which was published 23 June, 2026. The change was made after review by the Kingdom Exchequer. Current modern guidelines prohibit donations from a 501(c)(3) to a non-qualified organization. A simple error could cause problems with the SCA's non-profit status. Therefore, that option was removed. A dissolving group may petition Stallari to have their funds transferred from their account into the account of another group. The penalty was removed as the SCA does not have the ability to enforce it. We do not maintain sufficient records to report misused funds as income. The Kingdom may still do this if directed by the Society Exchequer or BoD.

TITLE X—PRECEDENCE, SYMBOLS OF RANK, AND OATHS OF FEALTY

SEC. 1000. THE ORDER OF PRECEDENCE.

- a. THE ORDER OF PRECEDENCE.—The Order of Precedence within Northshield is as follows—
 1. Sovereign and Sovereign Consort.
 2. Heir Combatant and Heir Consort.
 3. Dukes and Duchesses.
 4. Counts and Countesses.
 5. Viscounts and Viscountesses.
 6. Peers of the Realm.
 7. Territorial Baronage.
 8. Court Barons and Baronesses, even if given by a Kingdom where the Court Barony does not confer precedence.
 9. Awards and Orders which confer Grants of Arms, including awards from other Kingdoms.
 10. Awards and Orders which confer Awards of Arms, including awards from other Kingdoms.
 11. Awards and Orders which do not convey precedence.
- b. PRECEDENCE OF GROUP AWARDS.—Awards granted to a branch, guild, household, or other organized collective of the Society will not convey individual precedence to the members of that group.
- c. PRECEDENCE ACCORDING TO SENORITY.—Except for Royalty, all placements within the different classifications of the Order of Precedence will be done according to seniority in that title.
- d. PRECEDENCE OF THE TERRITORIAL BARONAGE.—

 - ii. Jararvellir (May A.S. 6 / 1971 CE)
 - iii. Caer Antherth Mawr (September A.S. 14 / 1979 CE)
 - iv. Nordskogen (December A.S. 14 / 1979 CE)
 - v. Windhaven (March A.S. 33 / 1999 CE)
 3. PRECEDENCE OF NON-NORTHSHIELD TERRITORIAL BARONAGE.—The precedence of any non-Northshield Territorial Baronage, while within Northshield, is determined by the date of the founding of the Barony.
- e. NON-KINGDOM HONORS AND AWARDS.—Honors given by organizations below Kingdom level may appear in the Kingdom Order of Precedence, and they may also be used in their appropriate Orders of Precedence, (e.g. Baronial awards may be employed in order to define a Baronial Order of Precedence).

SEC. 1010. SYMBOLS OF RANK.

- a. CROWNS, CORONETS, AND CIRCLETS.—
 1. CROWNS OF GOLD.—Only the Sovereign and Consort may wear crowns of gold, ornamented as they see fit.
 2. CROWNS OF SILVER.—Only the Heir Combatant and Heir Consort may wear crowns of silver,

ornamented as they see fit.

3. CORONETS WITH STRAWBERRY LEAVES.—Only Dukes and Duchesses may wear coronets with strawberry leaves, ornamented as they see fit.
 4. EMBATTLED GOLD CORONETS.—Only Counts and Countesses may wear coronets embattled, all gold, ornamented as they see fit.
 5. GOLD CORONETS WITH SIX PEARLS.—Only Territorial Baronage may wear coronets of gold with six pearls (spheroids), ornamented as they see fit.
 6. SILVER CORONETS WITH SIX PEARLS.—Only Court Barons and Baronesses may wear coronets of silver with six pearls (spheroids), ornamented as they see fit.
 7. METAL CIRCLET.—Members of the populace with Awards of Arms may wear a simple metal circlet, ornamented as they see fit, with no more than one protrusion. The overall height of the circlet may not exceed one inch, including the protrusion. The circlet may not resemble any of the coronets listed above.
- b. AWARD, ORDER, AND OFFICER REGALIA.—
1. RESTRICTIONS.—Only members of officially recognized Awards and Orders (as defined by Corpora) may wear the badges of their respective Awards and Orders.
 2. PEERAGE REGALIA.—Only Peers of the Realm may wear the badges and symbols of their respective Orders.
 3. BADGES OF OFFICE.—Officers may wear the badges of their respective offices.
 4. POPULACE BADGES.—It is the right of all subjects of the Kingdom to display the populace badges of the Kingdom as described in SEC. 1110.a.

SEC. 1020. TITLES.

a. TITLES.—

1. PEERAGES, BARONAGE, AND SIMILAR.—Please refer to “The List of Alternate Titles” maintained by the Society College of Arms.
2. GRANTS OF ARMS.—Holders of Grants of Arms may be styled and announced as—
 - A. Recipients of Grants of Arms.
 - B. The Honorable Armiger or The Honorable Noble
 - C. The Honorable Lord or The Honorable Lady
 - D. His Lordship or Her Ladyship.
 - E. An equivalent title in the “The List of Alternate Titles” maintained by the Society College of Arms.
3. AWARDS OF ARMS.—Holders of Awards of Arms may be styled and announced as—
 - A. Recipients of Awards of Arms.
 - B. Armiger or Noble
 - C. Lord or Lady
 - D. An equivalent title in the “The List of Alternate Titles” maintained by the Society College of Arms.

SEC. 1030. OATHS OF FEALTY AND PLEDGES OF SERVICE.

- a. NO RESTRICTION.—The Crown may not allow oaths of fealty to restrict the populace from full participation in the Society.
- b. ALTERNATE PLEDGE OF SERVICE.—If, for reasons of conscience, a subject of the Kingdom is unable to pledge an oath of fealty as found in the applicable “Standard Texts for Oaths of Fealty” in the Kingdom Boke of Ceremony, the Crown will allow an alternate but equal pledge of service which respects the integrity of the individual and enhances the pageantry and flavor of the Society.

TITLE XI—ARMORY, AWARDS, AND ORDERS

SEC. 1100. ARMORY OF THE ROYALTY.

- a. ARMORY OF THE SOVEREIGN.—The arms of the Sovereign are—
 - 1. Sable, a compass rose argent within a laurel wreath, in chief an ancient crown Or.
- b. ARMORY OF THE SOVEREIGN CONSORT.—The arms of the Consort are—
 - 1. Sable, a compass rose argent within a wreath of roses, in chief an ancient crown Or.
- c. ARMORY OF THE HEIR COMBATANT.—The arms of the Heir Combatant are—
 - 1. Sable, a compass rose argent within a laurel wreath, in chief an ancient crown Or, charged overall with a label of cadency Argent.
 - A. Per the Society College of Arms December 2003 cover letter, the armory of the Heir Combatant does not need to be registered.
- d. ARMORY OF THE HEIR CONSORT.—The arms of the Heir Consort are—
 - 1. Sable, a compass rose argent within a wreath of roses, in chief an ancient crown Or, charged overall with a label of cadency Argent.
 - A. Per the Society College of Arms December 2003 cover letter, the armory of the Heir Consort does not need to be registered.

SEC. 1110. POPULACE BADGES AND STANDARD AUGMENTATIONS.

- a. POPULACE BADGES.—
 - 1. POPULACE BADGES.—The populace badges of the Kingdom are—
 - A. Sable, a compass rose argent, a bordure Or; and
 - B. (Fieldless) A griffin passant Or.
 - 2. RESTRICTIONS.—Any member of the populace of the Kingdom of Northshield may bear the populace badge(s) at any time.
- b. AUGMENTATIONS.—
 - 1. STANDARD AUGMENTATIONS.—The standard augmentations for the Kingdom of Northshield are—
 - A. (Fieldless) A Compass rose per pale sable and Or; and
 - B. (Fieldless) On a Griffon Or, a compass rose sable.
 - 2. RESTRICTIONS.—Only those who have received an Augmentation of Arms may use the Standard Augmentations on their personal armory.

SEC. 1120. AWARDS, ORDERS, AND RECOGNITIONS.

- a. AWARD RECOMMENDATIONS.—It is the right of everyone in the Kingdom to recommend to the Crown anyone who, in their estimation, is deserving of an Order or Award of any level.
- b. NON-ARMIGEROUS AWARDS AND ORDERS.—
 - 1. PRECEDENCE FOR NON-ARMIGEROUS AWARDS.—Non-Armigerous Awards and Orders convey no standing in the Order of Precedence.
 - 2. NON-ARMIGEROUS YOUTH AWARDS.—
 - A. THE AWARD OF THE BELLEROPHON.—The Award of Bellerophon may be given to youths in the Kingdom of Northshield who have displayed prowess and courtesy in any of the Arts Martial.
 - i. BADGE.—There is no registered badge for this award.
 - B. THE AWARD OF THE COMPASS.—The Award of the Compass may be given to youths in the Kingdom of Northshield who have distinguished themselves by exemplary service to the Kingdom.
 - i. BADGE.—The Badge of the Award is: (Fieldless) A pair of compasses Or.
 - C. THE AWARD OF THE GOLD LAMP.—The Award of the Gold Lamp may be given to youths in the Kingdom of Northshield who have distinguished themselves by

achievement in an Art and/or Science.

i. BADGE.—There is no registered badge for this award.

D. THE AWARD OF THE WHITE OWL.—The Award of the White Owl may be given to youths in the Kingdom of Northshield who have demonstrated initiative in teaching.

i. BADGE.—There is no registered badge for this award.

3. NON-ARMIGEROUS AWARDS FOR ALL MEMBERS OF THE POPULACE.—

A. SPECIAL RECOGNITIONS.—

i. AUGMENTATIONS OF ARMS.—An Augmentation of Arms may be given to specially honor a person for service to the Kingdom above and beyond the call of duty. Each augmentation is a specific charge determined by the individual pursuant to the rules of the College of Arms that can be added to the individual's heraldic arms once approved.

a. BADGE.—

i. STANDARD AUGMENTATIONS.—An individual may choose to utilize a “standard augmentation” as defined by the Society College of Arms. See also: Sec. 1110.b.

ii. OTHER AUGMENTATIONS.—An augmentation which is not one of the standard augmentations must follow the rules for augmentations of honor as defined by the Society College of Heralds.

ii. CYPHERS.—

a. THE SOVEREIGN'S CYPHER AND SOVEREIGN CONSORT'S CYPHER.—The Sovereign's Cypher and the Sovereign Consort's Cypher may be given to those who have distinguished themselves through personal service to the Crown.

i. This Cypher may be given as a joint award (“Sovereign and Sovereign Consort's Joint Cypher”) or individually (“Sovereign's Cypher” and “Sovereign Consort's Cypher”).

b. THE HEIR COMBATANT'S CYPHER AND HEIR CONSORT'S CYPHER.—The Heir Combatant's Cypher and the Heir Consort's Cypher may be given to those who have distinguished themselves through personal service to the Heir and/or the Heir Consort.

i. The Heirs are allowed to bestow the award at their own discretion.

ii. This Cypher may be given as a joint award (“Heir's Joint Cypher”) or individually (“Heir Combatant's Cypher” and “Heir Consort's Cypher”).

iii. THE SCROLL OF HONOR.—The Scroll of Honor is a record of the worthy deeds of the people of Northshield and its friends. Names are entered at the discretion of the Crown.

a. BADGE.—There is no registered badge for this Award.

b. DELEGATION OF RESPONSIBILITY.—The Principal Herald or a deputy shall care for the Scroll.

B. NON-ARMIGEROUS AWARDS AND ORDERS

i. THE ORDER OF THE BEARE OF NORTHSHIELD.—The Order of the Beare of Northshield may be given to those who embody the spirit of the Kingdom of Northshield.

a. BADGE.—There is no registered badge for this Order.

b. LIMITATION.—No more than one person may be admitted into this Order during any reign.

c. TITLE.—Members of this Order may style themselves “Beares of Northshield.”

d. PRIVILEGES OF RANK.—A Beare of Northshield shall have the right to enter a Northshield court unbidden by the Crown.

ii. AWARD OF THE BRAVURA.—The Award of the Bravura may be given to those

who achieves a heroic and specific deed of valor, courtesy, or prowess in the Arts Martial which has increased the renown and reputation of Northshield.

- a. BADGE.—There is no registered badge for this Award.
 - b. CONTINUATION.—This award shall be a continuation of the former Kingdom Award called Nordbandr and of the Award of Nordbandr from the days of the Principality, and all recipients of the Principality Award shall be considered equal with recipients of this Award.
 - c. REGALIA.—Recipients of this Award are traditionally allowed to wear an armband of any color, ornamented as they see fit. This is not reserved regalia.
- iii. THE ORDER OF COURTESY OF NORTHSHIELD.—The Order of Courtesy of Northshield may be given to those who have, over time and with consistency, shown exemplary courtesy. Members are expected to continue conspicuous acts of courtesy, and to encourage others to that same standard of excellence.
 - a. BADGE.—There is no registered badge for this Order.
 - iv. THE ORDER OF THE CRWTH.—The Order of the Crwth may be given to those who have distinguished themselves by their proficiency in the performing arts.
 - a. BADGE.—The Badge of the Order is: (Fieldless) A crwth argent.
 - b. CONTINUATION.—This order is a continuation of the Order of the same name from the days of the Principality, and all companions of the Principality's Order shall be considered companions of this.
 - v. THE ORDER OF THE GEMS OF NORTHSHIELD.—The Order of the Gems of Northshield may be given to honor groups who have, as a group, given outstanding service to the Kingdom.
 - a. BADGE.—The Badge of the Order is: Sable, in cross four hexagonal gems argent.
 - b. b. ELIGIBILITY.—Eligible groups include SCA branches and any body of people acting as a group, such as a household, martial group, etc.
 - vi. THE ORDER OF THE GOLDEN PEACOCK.—The Order of the Golden Peacock may be given to those who maintain a period appearance while participating in any martial activity.
 - a. BADGE.—The Badge of the Order is: Sable, a peacock in its pride within a bordure embattled Or.
 - vii. THE ORDER OF THE GRIFFIN OF NORTHSHIELD.—The Order of the Griffin of Northshield may be given to those who have had at least 25 years of continuous participation in a martial activity.
 - a. BADGE.—There is no registered badge for this Order.
 - b. TITLE.—Members of this Order may style themselves Venerable Griffins.
 - viii. THE AWARD OF THE HEARTHSTEAD.—The Award of the Hearthstead may be given to those groups which excel at showing hospitality and hosting events.
 - a. BADGE.—The Badge of the Order is: Sable, a brazier Or enflamed proper within a bordure Or masoned sable.
 - b. ELIGIBILITY.—Eligible groups include SCA branches and any body of people acting as a group, such as a household, martial group, etc.
 - ix. THE AWARD OF THE PANTHEON OF NORTHSHIELD.—The Award of the Pantheon of Northshield may be given to those who achieve a heroic and specific deed of valor or prowess in the areas of service or non-martial arts. This deed shall be one which increases the renown and reputation of Northshield.
 - a. BADGE.—There is no registered badge for this Award.
 - x. THE ORDER OF THE PYXIS.—The Order of the Pyxis may be given to those who have distinguished themselves by putting forth great effort at researching, creating and maintaining a period persona and atmosphere.
 - a. BADGE.—The Badge of the Order is: (Fieldless) A cross clechy Or within and conjoined to an annulet argent.

- reserved regalia.
- E. THE AWARD OF THE GRIFFIN AND SWORD.—The Award of the Griffin and Sword may be given to those who demonstrate prowess and chivalric behavior in armored combat, including a level of participation beyond their own personal endeavors.
 - i. BADGE.—The Badge for the Award is: (Fieldless) A griffin Or sustaining a sword argent.
 - F. THE AWARD OF THE PALFREY.—The Award of the Palfrey may be given to those who demonstrate prowess and chivalry in equestrian activities, including a level of participation beyond their own personal endeavors.
 - i. BADGE.—The Badge of the Award is: (Fieldless) A horse passant sable charged on the shoulder with a compass rose argent.
3. AWARDS CONVEYING A GRANT OF ARMS.—The following awards convey a Grant of Arms if the recipient does not yet hold one.
- A. THE ESTATE OF COURT BARONY.—The Estate of Court Barony may be bestowed by the Crown to those who have, over time, demonstrated exceptional and continual service to the Crown.
 - i. BADGE.—There is no badge registered for this honor.
 - ii. HERALDRY.—Pursuant to the rules of the Society College of Arms, a recipient of a Court Barony may use a baronial coronet in their personal arms.
 - iii. REGALIA.—Recipients may wear a coronet of silver or white adorned with six pearls and ornamented as they see fit.
 - iv. TITLES.—They may be addressed as “Your Excellency”, and styled Baron, Baroness, or an equivalent title.
 - v. PRECEDENCE.—A Court Barony ranks ahead of other Grants of Arms in the Order of Precedence. A subject of Northshield who was bestowed with the Estate of Court Barony in a Kingdom where the award does not convey precedence or conveys an Award of Arms will not automatically be conveyed a Grant of Arms in Northshield. However, their precedence within Northshield for the purposes of tournaments, grand marches, etc. will be calculated as if their Court Barony was given by the Kingdom of Northshield.
 - B. THE ORDER OF THE AQUILA ET FULMEN.—The Order of the Aquila et Fulmen may be given to those who have, over time, demonstrated great prowess, chivalry, and leadership in one or more of the Artillery Arts. Members will be responsible for continued, conspicuous activity in Artillery and for helping others become involved and proficient.
 - i. BADGE.—The Badge of the Order is: An eagle per pale Or and sable maintaining a lightning bolt sable and a lightning bolt Or.
 - ii. REGALIA.—Recipients of this Award are traditionally given a black hood with white and gold trim which bears the armory of the Order. This is not reserved regalia.
 - C. THE ORDER OF THE BLACK GRIFFIN.—The Order of the Black Griffin may be given to those who have, over time, demonstrated great prowess, chivalry, and leadership in Armored Combat. Members will be responsible for continued, conspicuous activity in Armored Combat and for helping others become involved and proficient.
 - i. BADGE.—The Badge of the Order is: (Fieldless) A griffin Or sustaining a sword sable.
 - ii. REGALIA.—Recipients of this Award are traditionally given a black hood which bears the armory of the Order. This is not reserved regalia.
 - D. THE ORDER OF BRIGITS FLAME.—The Order of Brigits Flame may be given to those who have shown over time that they enthusiastically strive for mastery in the Arts and/or Sciences, endeavoring to provide leadership and displaying courtesy. Members are expected to continue their pursuits in the Arts and/or Sciences and for helping others find their own opportunities for enrichment therein.
 - i. BADGE.—The Badge of the Order is: (Fieldless) A torch argent enflamed proper.

- E. THE ORDER OF THE DESTREER.—The Order of the Destrer may be given to those who have, over time, demonstrated great prowess, chivalry, and leadership in Equestrian Arts. Members are expected to continue conspicuous activity in Equestrian arts, and to encourage others to become involved and proficient.
 - i. BADGE.— The Badge of the Order is: (Fieldless) A horse rampant Or sustaining a compass rose argent.
 - ii. REGALIA.—Recipients of this Award are traditionally given a gold hood with black and white trim which bears the armory of the Order. This is not reserved regalia.
- F. THE ORDER OF THE HAND OF TYR.—The Order of the Hand of Tyr may be given to those who have distinguished themselves over time by performing, with all due courtesy, outstanding service on behalf of the kingdom. Members are expected to continue conspicuous service and to help others find their own opportunities for service.
 - i. BADGE.—The Badge of the Order is: (Fieldless) On a hand fesswise sable a Tyr rune argent.
- G. THE ORDO CIRCINI VITRUVII.—The Ordo Circini Vitruvii (Order of Vitruvius's Caliper) may be given to those who, over time, have demonstrated great prowess, chivalry, and leadership in rapier and/or cut-and-thrust combat. Members will be responsible for continued, conspicuous activity in rapier and/or cut-and-thrust combat and for helping others become involved and proficient in one or both.
 - i. BADGE.—The Badge of the Order is: Sable, a keythong maintaining a rapier in chief a caliper fesswise reversed argent.
 - ii. REGALIA.—Recipients of this Award are traditionally given a gold or yellow sash. This is not reserved regalia.
- d. CLOSED ORDERS.—
 - 1. THE ORDER OF PERSEPHONE'S CIRCLE.—The Order of Persephone's Circle consists of Royal Consorts from the days of the Principality. It is closed to any new companions, but remains in law and custom as a place of high regard and honor.
 - A. PRECEDENCE.—This award conveyed no precedence.
 - 2. THE ORDER OF THE WHITE SCARF OF NORTHSHIELD.—The Order of the White Scarf of Northshield was given to those who, over time, demonstrated great prowess, chivalry, and leadership in Rapier Combat. Members will be responsible for continued, conspicuous activity in Rapier Combat and for helping others become involved and proficient. It is closed to any new companions, but remains in law and custom as a place of high regard and honor.
 - A. BADGE.—The badge of the Order is: Sable, on a pale Or between two compass roses argent, a rapier sable.
 - B. REGALIA.—Companions of the Order shall be entitled to wear a white scarf emblazoned with the badge of the order. The scarf may also bear the populace badge(s) of the Kingdom of Northshield, or the populace badge of the Kingdom which bestowed the honor.
 - C. PRECEDENCE.—This award conveyed a Grant of Arms.
