

Random Carp that I have learned

A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

Back in 16th century England, spirits were taxed based on their potency. The easiest, not quite unscientific way of determining this was first to try liquid alone or to mix the liquid with gunpowder and try to light it. If it lit, it was proof that it was alcoholic enough, with a value of 100 (technically, the gunpowder combustion required about 114 proof). If it did not light, it was under-proof, and taxed accordingly. The main problems with this is that flammability of the liquid by itself was very dependent on temperature, and the gunpowder added would stabilize that issue, but the grain and composition could adjust the results as well.

Since then, we have more definitive ways of determining the alcohol content, on a scale of 0-200, though it is physically very difficult to distill beyond 195 proof. And now you know more random carp.
