From Crux Australis

Unto the wonderful populace of Lochac.

Congratulations to our new heirs, Crown Prince Þorvaldr inn Suðreyski and Crown Princess Amabilia Thexton.

The latest registrations from the College of Arms is as follows.

* *Beatrice Maria Malatesta*. Alternate name Brigiða glaða.

* *Bran spíþra*. Alternate name Peter Turbot and badge.
Bendy sinister sable and Or, a death's head argent. Submitted as Peter Turbo_, commenters raised the question as to whether this name was a reference to Perturabo in the Warhammer 40K game franchise. While the name Peter Turbo appears to be an informal reference to the character, it does not appear as an epithet for him in much of the official media. Thus, this name does not presume upon that fictional character.

Additionally, close examination of the Family Search documents by Iago Wreath, noted that the byname was in fact Turbe, and Turbo was a transcription error, and the name should in fact be Peter Turbe. After consultation with the submitter, they would prefer a spelling with an o as the final vowel sound. Fortunately, the name Peter Turbot is registerable as a late 14th-early 15th century English name, and we have made this change for registration.

* *Katrijn van Delden*. Device change.
Per bend embattled gules and azure, a reremouse and a horse's head coupé argent. The submitter's prior device, Or, a dragon sable and an orle azure, is retained as a badge.

* *Þorgrímr berserkr*. Name change.
From Conrad Sturmere.
Nice 9th-11th century Old Norse name from Iceland! The submitter's prior name, Conrad Sturmere, is retained as an alternate.

* *Thormot Mór*. Name and device.

Per bend sable and azure, two bears passant Or.
Nice device!

From Rapier Marshal

Greetings good gentles of Lochac,

We have two exciting updates for you this month!

Lochac Fencing Combat Handbook Update - October 2025

This update allows for the inclusion of Society Reduced Minimums for limbs and back of head to the Lochac ruleset. Notice of this update is being provided formally here in Pegasus. It will be announced by Crown on 4th October 2025.

8.3 Head

Change to include Society Minimum Update (area not covered by mask/helm changed from penetration-resistant material to abrasion-resistant material)

If you wear a mask, the rest of your head must be covered by at least abrasion-resistant material. This can be worn inside or over the mask.

8.5 Torso

Changed to explicitly include the word groin as part of the torso requiring coverage by penetration-resistant material for all combatants. This is a clarification of an existing rule, not a change.

You must wear penetration-resistant material to protect your torso, including your chest, back and abdomen, groin, and your upper arm extending at least 10cm from the armpit.

8.6 Legs, feet and arms

Change to include Society Minimum Update (changed from abrasion-resistant material on limbs required to optional)

You may wear abrasion-resistant material on your legs and arms if you prefer, but it is not required. Note that the upper arm extending at least 10cm from the armpit must be covered by penetration-resistant material.

8.7 Hands

Change to include Society Minimum Update (changed from abrasion-resistant material on hands required to optional)

It is **recommended** that your hands and fingers be covered by abrasion-resistant material, but is not required.

Lochac Reduced Armour Experiment - Phase Two

Given the success of the original experiment, and after much consultation, approval has been granted from the SCA Ltd Board (Australia) and SCA NZ Inc Committee (New Zealand) for Lochac fencers to participate in an updated version of the reduced fencing armour experiment. Notice of the second phase is being provided formally here in Pegasus. It will be announced by Crown on 4th October 2025.

There is one area of reduced armour that this experiment will be examining:

- Lowering the torso protection from penetration resistant to abrasion resistant. A single layer of cloth will be sufficient; it would not need to be drop tested, and no additional armpit layers will be necessary as long as there is no exposed skin.

Reduced Armour Experiment Melee Update:

A 40 person cap on the number of combatants participating in reduced armour during a melee. If any combatant is utilising reduced armour then the total number of combatants cannot exceed 40. This is an increase from the previous 10 person cap.

Early Judging:

For those who cannot bring or send their entry to the event, there is, as usual, the possibility of early entry. The process has been designed to be as accessible and fair as possible.

Please be aware that judging calls for considerable input of time and energy, and cannot be done at the last minute. If you wish to avail yourself of this method of entering, please contact your local A&S officer as soon as possible, so they know to begin organising judges. Then you will need to bring your entry to them, ready to be judged, **by the end of Sunday 12th October.**

Your local officer will arrange to have your item assessed. They will send the results to the event co-ordinator (or to me) before the event, so your results can be included with the others on the day. You should receive your feedback/entry after the event.

September Results:

Of course, the results from September have not yet been announced - there is still time (until

Wednesday 24th September) for entrants to submit their work for the rescue mission. Once that date has passed, we will finalise Round 2 as soon as practicable. My apologies for the delay, circumstances conspired to prevent this round being completed in the usual way.
