Random Carp that I have learned

A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

When counting and using numbers, we don't consider that right up until the late 15th century we had very separate ways of using numbers in everyday life. What do I mean? Well, WHY do you need numbers? For commerce, you used integers (animals are whole numbers), quantities were measured by weight (pounds, ounces, and grains) or by volume (tun, hogshead, barrel, gallon, quart, pint, etc.). The same with dates; Years, Months, Days are all integers. Coins had fractions, but rarely more than pieces of eight (just get a smaller coin). For Navigation, they had base 60 with degrees, minutes, seconds, like time with hours, minutes, and seconds.

Then came a clever Italian named Giovanni Bianchini (15th century), who was a merchant, a mathematician, and an astronomer. Borrowed (stolen) from Chinese (2nd century BCE), Islamic (9th century) and Persian (15th century) vague concepts with no practical use, Bianchini used decimals to better keep track of his goods, and then ported these base 10 number fractions over to his astronomy work. He even came up with how to operate with negative numbers. But he never saw a point in spreading this far and wide, so it sat mostly ignored for another 100 years.

Christopher Clavius, a German astronomer and mathematician, came across Bianchini's works and published a single table in his book *Astrolabium in 1593 utilizing decimal points in his calculations. He never used it again for the remaining 20 years of his life, but he did correspond about it with another astronomer, mentioning his calculation methods along with his firm view of the geocentric model of the solar system. He was shown great respect by this young astronomer, Galileo coming to visit him at Collegio Romano in Rome in 1611 to discuss new observations through a telescope. The Pisan astronomer made judicious use of the decimal method in his astronomy and general science work, using it as a base of the scientific method to come up with quantitative results. Thanks to Galileo, science is based on numbers, decimal numbers at that. And now you know more Random Carp.*
