Submission Guidelines

The deadline for the Dragon's Tale is the 25th of the month that is two months before the issue date (e.g., the December issue deadline is 25 October). Submissions for the Dragon's Tale should be sent to chronicler@drachenwald.sca.org. Material should be sent in MS Word, RTF or plain text. Send photographs and artwork as separate files. Note that event announcements will be standardised in format. Original work (articles, photographs, artwork) must be accompanied by a permission form <http://www.drachenwald.sca.org/sites/default/files/permission.pdf> or the equivalent words in an email. Any copyrighted material by others must be accompanied by written permission from the original author(s). Please check the licence/usage terms of any clip-art used. The Dragon's Tale is set using Scribus 1.6.2 with Garamond, Arial, Arial Narrow, Lucida Handwriting and UBW Chancery typefaces in various sizes. The Dragon's Tale logo is in Tyrfing Demo typeface.

Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. This can be done by filling in the calendar event date request form on the Kingdom web page: <https://drachenwald.sca.org/events/calender-add/> Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web form.

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event .
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

Just a quick reminder this month, for local groups that are hosting events (i.e. seneschals & event stewards in particular)...

Per our Society Corpora, official business may only be conducted at events which are published in the kingdom newsletter ("published events"). Neither the online kingdom calendar nor other baronial or principality newsletters suffice in this respect. By "official business" I refer primarily to Courts and Curias, although this also includes Crown & Coronet tournaments as well as Coronations & Investitures. Note this same distinction applies with respect to the participation requirement in order to compete in Crown Lists (i.e. only "published events" count).

Thus I ask that local groups please ensure their events are getting published in the Dragons' Tale, to ensure we do not run afoul of these rules. For more about what information is required for an event to be "published", please see the Chroniclers webpage: <https://drachenwald.sca.org/offices/chronicler/>

Also remember that the submission deadline is the 25th of the month for the newsletter to be released 2 months hence - i.e. the deadline for the April Dragons' Tale is 25 February.

The event will take place at the Kallioipirtti camp center in Kärkölä, Lahti. Kallioipirtti has a main building and a sauna at the same building. The main building can accommodate 40 people in beds, with

crash space for an additional 10 people on the floor.

For accommodation, you will need a fitted sheet, pillowcase and duvet cover. Blankets and pillows are provided by the venue. Those crashing on the floor should also bring their own mattress/camp bed, pillow and blanket/sleeping bag.

The final payment date is 14th of December, 2025, which is also the last cancellation date. Not paying does not count as a cancellation. We will not refund any payments for cancellations made after 14th of December, 2025. A late fee of €5 per person will be added for payments made after this date. International guests are welcome to pay the event fee at the door with cash (EUR).

First-timers and Newcomers:
2 spots are reserved for first-time attendees. The registration form will ask if you are a first-timer, and these spots will be filled based on the order of registration. First-timers are defined as those who have not yet attended any weekend event in Aarnimetsä/SCA. Weekly local meetings do not count. The first-time spots will be held for two weeks after registration opens, after which they will be released to the general pool.

Members of the Guild of the Golden Dove will be present at the event to assist and guide newcomers with any questions about the event, the hobby or Aarnimetsä in general. You can recognize them by the large yellow feather they wear in their attire.

Tippsund Campsite in Taivassalo is a forested youth camp site by the sea. To get there, you will need a car or a ride. We will try to help with rides where possible, but it is worth asking about shared rides in advance. The nearest large city is Turku (approx. 70km).

The address is Kahiluodontie 386, 23310 Taivassalo.

Driving instructions (from Turku):

- From Turku, take Kustavintie for about 60 km to Taivassalo Church
- From the church, turn left onto Hakkeenpäätie
- Drive for about 6 km, turn right to Leikluoto
- 2 km to the Pinonperä bridge and Kahiluoto road to the camp site

Don't believe your navigation system if it

says you have arrived before you see the camp site sign on the left side of the road.

Accommodation is in small cottages (8 cottages) with bunk beds (3 bunk beds for six people) and some also have a sofa bed. The beds are already equipped with mattresses, pillows and blankets – no linen! You must bring your own sheets and pillowcases.

The cottages do not have indoor toilets or running water. There is a maintenance building near the cottages with indoor toilets (and showers), a hall and a kitchen. Five of the cottages are close to the main building, three a little further away.

On the shore near the maintenance building there is a (small) sauna with showers. The sauna only has one changing room, a washroom and a steam room, so some of the saunas are mixed saunas. (Although the sauna has been renovated so I'm not sure how it's set up.)

The site is not completely accessible (the yard/walking paths are wooded, there are a lot of bunk beds, the toilets in the main building are small, etc.), but all buildings have some kind of ramps. We take into account the needs of the participants as much as possible, e.g. lower bed, roommates, diets, gender-neutral toilets and showers, sauna shifts, event materials and instructions, lights, etc. so let us know what you need and we'll try to help.

The Site opens to visitors on Friday at 6:00 PM, but it will be available to the organizers from the morning, so let us know if you want to arrive earlier.


